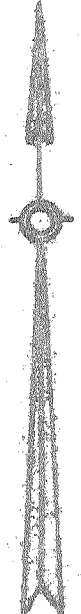


WATERS HEIRS



It is interesting to note that here 107 years ago, (1866) the Litchfield and Mining Co., a Mass. corporation, purchased this 1600 ac tract from Edward Q. Hunting and attempted to drill an oil well, with a spring pole - it was drilled about 200' before it was abandoned.
