Milford Yoak and Blaine Plauger being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by the above named well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, and Mike Underwood Oil and Gas Inspector representing the Director, say that said work was commenced on the 3rd day of October, 1991, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Ran tubing to 400ft., broke circulation, ran 2 bags			of gel, ran 30 bags of cement from 400ft. to 250 ft. Pulled 2" to 200ft. From surface,	
ran 65 sacks of cement from 200ft. to surface.
