WELL WORK PERMIT Horizontal 6A Well

This permit, API Well Number: 47-1706606, issued to EQT PRODUCTION COMPANY, is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

In addition to the applicable requirements of this permit, and the statutes and rules governing oil and gas activity in WV, this permit may contain specific conditions which must be followed. Permit conditions are attached to this cover letter.

Per 35CSR-4-5.2.g this permit will expire in two (2) years from the issue date unless permitted well work is commenced. If there are any questions, please feel free to contact me at (304) 926-0499 ext. 1654.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d) allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. <u>Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.</u>

CONDITIONS

- 1. This proposed activity may require permit coverage from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). Through this permit, you are hereby being advised to consult with USACE regarding this proposed activity.
- 2. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6A-5a (12), which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than fifty (50) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 3. When compacting fills, each lift before compaction shall not be more than 12 inches in height, and the moisture content of the fill material shall be within limits as determined by the Standard Proctor Density test of the actual soils used in specific engineered fill, ASTM D698, Standard Test Method for Laboratory Compaction Characteristics of Soil Using Standard Effort, to achieve 95 % compaction of the optimum density. Each lift shall be tested for compaction, with a minimum of two tests per lift per acre of fill. All test results shall be maintained on site and available for review.
- 4. Operator shall install signage per § 22-6A-8g (6) (B) at all source water locations included in their approved water management plan within 24 hours of water management plan activation.
- 5. Oil and gas water supply wells will be registered with the Office of Oil and Gas and all such wells will be constructed and plugged in accordance with the standards of the Bureau for Public Health set forth in its Legislative rule entitled *Water Well Regulations*, 64 C.S.R. 19. Operator is to contact the Bureau of Public Health regarding permit requirements. In lieu of plugging, the operator may transfer the well to the surface owner upon agreement of the parties. All drinking water wells within fifteen hundred feet of the water supply well shall be flow tested by the operator upon request of the drinking well owner prior to operating the water supply well.
- 6. Pursuant to the requirements pertaining to the sampling of domestic water supply wells/springs the operator shall, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of analytical data provide a written copy to the Chief and any of the users who may have requested such analyses.
- 7. If any explosion or other accident causing loss of life or serious personal injury occurs in or about a well or well work on a well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the explosion or accident, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief, within 24 hours of said accident.
- 8. During the casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within 24 hours.
- 9. Operator shall provide the Office of Oil & Gas notification of the date that drilling commenced on this well. Such notice shall be provided by sending an email to DEPOOGNotify@wv.gov within 30 days of commencement of drilling.

ORDER ISSUED UNDER WEST VIRGINIA CODE, CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE 6A

TO: EQT Production Company 115 Professional Place Bridgeport, WV 26330

INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter "Order") is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter "OOG"), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of W. Va. Code §§ 22-1-1, 22-6-1 and 22-6A-1 et seq. to EQT Production Company (hereinafter "EQT" or "Operator"), collectively the "Parties."

FINDINGS OF THE CHIEF

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

- 1. OOG, an office within the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, is the agency with the duty and authority to execute and enforce W. Va. Code §22-6-1 and §22-6A-1 et seq., and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 2. EQT is a "person" as defined by W. Va. Code §22-6-1(n), with a corporate address as 115 Professional Place, Bridgeport, WV 26330.
- On September 2, 2014, EQT submitted applications for gas wells identified as API#'s 17-06604, 17-06605 and 17-06606, located on the SMI31 Pad in the New Milton District of Doddridge County, West Virginia.
- 4. On September 2, 2014, EQT requested a waiver for Perennial Stream #1, outlined in Exhibit 1 from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for gas well permit applications identified as 17-06604, 17-06605 and 17-06606, located on the SMI31 Pad in the New Milton District of Doddridge County West Virginia

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. West Virginia Code §22-1-6(d) requires, in part, that "[i]n addition to other powers, duties and responsibilities granted and assigned to the secretary by this chapter, the secretary is authorized and empowered to...(3) Enter private lands to make surveys and inspections for environmental protection purposes; to investigate for violations of statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing; to serve and execute warrants and processes; to make arrests; issue orders, which for the purposes of this chapter include consent agreements; and to otherwise enforce the statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing."
- 2. West Virginia Code §22-6A-2(a)(6) requires, in part, that "Concomitant with the broad powers to condition the issuance of well work permits, the secretary should also have broad authority to waive certain minimum requirements of this article when, in his or her discretion, such waiver is appropriate: *Provided*, That the secretary shall submit a written report of the number of waivers granted to the Legislature commencing January 1, 2013, and each year thereafter."
- 3. West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the Office of Oil and Gas shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The Office of Oil and Gas may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary."

ORDER

Therefore, the Office of Oil and Gas grants EQT Production Company a waiver for Perennial Stream #1 from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for gas well permit applications identified as API #'s 17-06604, 17-06605 and 17-06606, located on the SMI31 Pad in New Milton District of Doddridge County, West Virginia. The Office of Oil and Gas hereby ORDERS that EQT Production Company shall meet the following site construction and operational requirements for the SMI31 well pad:

- a. A berm shall be constructed around the perimeter of the pad to contain any potential spills and storm water runoff. Berm is to be at least two feet (2') in height;
- b. Filter/silt socks and erosion control blankets shall be installed on all slopes and down gradient locations of the pad and topsoil pile areas as erosion and sediment controlling BMPs:
- c. Perennial Stream #1 shall have a triple compost filter sock stack installed adjacent to the stream;
- d. Disturbed areas not used for operations shall be seeded and mulched per the seeding tables in the WVDEP-OOG Erosion and Sediment Control Manual;
- e. Drill cuttings and associated drilling mud shall be disposed of in a permitted landfill;
- f. Waste generated by the flowback treatment systems shall be sent to offsite disposal at a permitted landfill;
- g. Weekly site inspections shall be conducted to monitor and maintain the integrity of the BMP storm water controls;
- h. Weekly storm water and spill prevention inspections shall be conducted focusing on storm water and spill prevention BMPs and maintenance of these BMPs;
- Inspections of the storm water and spill prevention measures shall be conducted after any major storm event defined as a half inch (1/2") rain within any twenty-four (24) hour period;
- j. Pad inspections shall be conducted no less than once a week to identify and mitigate potential deficiencies:
- k. All records from inspections shall be maintained on site for the life of the project and be available upon request.

Submit a conclusive demonstration to justify the proposed activity by addressing the following:

- 1. Demonstrate that there is not a practical alternative to impact the Waters of the U.S. by including other alternatives that were considered but eliminated.
 - a. Include a No-Action Alternative as to show "the future without the project
 - b. Location Alternatives must be shown
 - c. Must demonstrate why a 100' buffer cannot be maintained
- a. A future without this project would result in this landowner not being able to extract the deep oil and gas resources on his/her land; and a lack of reserves reaching the public market. As discussed in the sections below, the existing infrastructure and topography of the surrounding land is such that there are few viable locations to place a pad of a size required to safely extract deep resources.
- b. Several locations for the proposed well pad were investigated by a team of qualified biologists and engineers. The proposed location was chosen due to several factors: the site would be easily accessible from nearby existing roads; the topography was not prohibitive to construction equipment; tree clearing would be limited as 60% of the site consists of open fields; the extent of aquatic resources located on the site were isolated; and the site did not have many landowner constraints. As shown on the attached alternatives sketch, relocating the proposed facilities to provide a greater buffer for stream #1 (Douglascamp Run) would result in additional impacts to stream #2, additional tree clearing, and additional impacts to the existing natural gas infrastructure.
- c. The proposed site location minimizes the overall impacts associated with the development. Shifting the site to provide a greater buffer from Douglascamp Run would result in additional stream impacts and a substantial increase in earth disturbance and tree clearing due to the steep slopes. The limits of work have been reduced as much as possible to minimize impacts to streams or wetlands. Please refer to the accompanied Proposed Layout and Alternative Sketch Plans.
- 2. Show that treatment facilities (Erosion and Sediment Control Features) will be located as close as practical to the source(s) with which it is associated.

Compost filter sock shall be installed downslope of all earth disturbance. The filter sock will be installed along level grade approximately 10' from the toe of slope to allow clearance for maintenance and clean out. For the instream work, check dam rock filters will be installed as close to the disturbance as possible maintaining space for maintenance and clean out. Riprap outlet protection will be installed directly after each culvert outlet. Level spreaders will be installed immediately downstream of the outlet protection or channel outfall. The proposed site shall be stabilized as soon as possible after grading activities have ceased. Seed and mulch will be applied to all disturbed areas not otherwise stabilized. Seeding will be applied immediately upon reaching final grade, or upon temporary cessation of earth disturbance activity that will last longer than 21 days, to reduce soil runoff. Revegetation of the site will be provided in accordance with the WV E&SC Field Manual and the Site Construction, Reclamation, and Erosion & Sediment Control Plans. Reclamation of the pit shall occur as soon as possible after the final well is completed as shown on the Reclamation Plan.

Please refer to the accompanied Site Construction, Reclamation, and Erosion & Sediment Control Plans.

- 3. Demonstrate that all proposed activity will not impact Waters of the U.S. more than is necessary to accommodate the proper construction and operation of the facility.
 - Specify and identify wetlands using unique identification and/or perennial streams located within 100' of the pad's limit of disturbance (including erosion and sediment controls).
 - b. Is the proposed project the least environmentally damaging practicable alternative to the waters of the United States, so long as the alternative does not have other environmental consequences
- a. Please refer to the Site Construction, Reclamation, and Erosion & Sediment Control Plans. One wetland and two streams have been identified within 100' of the pad's limit of disturbance. Wetland #4 is a palustrine emergent wetland and is impacted as part of the project. Stream #2 is an ephemeral channel that loses definition prior to leaving the forest and continues as overland flow to Douglascamp Run. Stream #1 (Douglascamp Run) has been identified as a perennial stream. Encroachment within 100' of Douglascamp Run occurs near the pad in order to avoid existing pipeline infrastructure, additional tree clearing, and further impact to stream #2. Several other streams and wetlands are located adjacent to but outside the limits of disturbance for the access drive.
- b. The pad size has been reduced as much as possible leaving enough space for safe drilling operations. Due to its location, impacting the 0.01 acre wetland #4 is unavoidable without significant impacts to the existing infrastructure and additional stream impacts and forest clearing. The proposed site is not directly impacting Douglascamp Run. Shifting the pad to provide a greater buffer would result in additional impact to stream #2, force natural gas infrastructure relocation, and require additional tree clearing. In order to reduce stream impacts, the limits of disturbance are encroaching within 100' of the Douglascamp Run but only the section near the pad. The existing forested riparian buffer along Douglascamp Run is to be avoided and a full 100' buffer is to be maintained for the section near the pit. The current location requires a total of 286 LF of stream disturbance. Shifting the pad to provide a larger buffer would add 28 LF additional stream impacts.
- 4. Provide mapping, plans, specifications and design analysis for the preferred alternative to the project.
 - a. Specify in writing what additional controls, measures, devices, monitoring, etc will be utilized to protect these wetlands and/or perennial streams.
- a. Please refer to the Site Construction, Reclamation, and Erosion & Sediment Control Plans. Prior to the commencement of any earth disturbance, the critical areas such as streams and wetlands shall be delineated and their perimeters clearly marked. Orange construction fence will be installed around all critical areas that are not to be impacted. Compost filter socks shall be installed upslope of all streams and wetlands. Finally a perimeter berm is proposed around the pad itself further protecting the streams and wetlands. Stormwater shall be conveyed in a non-erosive manner utilizing channel lining, riprap outlet protection, rock check dams, and level spreaders. The proposed site shall be stabilized as soon as possible after grading activities have ceased. Seed and mulch will be applied to all disturbed areas not otherwise stabilized. Seeding will be applied immediately upon reaching final grade, or upon temporary cessation of earth disturbance activity that will last longer than 21 days, to reduce soil runoff. Revegetation of the site will be provided in accordance with the WV E&SC Field Manual and the Site Construction, Reclamation, and Erosion & Sediment Control Plans. Reclamation of the pit shall occur as soon as possible after the final well is completed as shown on the Reclamation Plan. The site shall be inspected daily during drilling operations and weekly thereafter. Additional silt fence and/or compost filter sock will be added around critical issues as necessary.




Withdrawal of Objections to EQT Well Work Permit Applications

Dear Mr. Martin,

The purposes of this letter are to (i) withdraw the enclosed objections filed with respect to the above-captioned well work permit applications ("Permit Applications"), and (ii) serve as our consent to the drilling of the above-captioned wells by EQT Production Company ("EQT") and waiver of any well location restrictions.

EQT is the proposed driller and operator of those certain gas wells identified as Well Nos. 514667, 514668, 514670, 514674 and 514675 on the proposed SMI31 well pad located in New Milton District, Doddridge County, West Virginia.

On September 9, 2014, we notified your Department of our objections to EQT's Permit Applications for the above-captioned wells and the location of the SMI31 well pad ("Objections"). The letter containing the Objections is enclosed for your reference.

My wife Peggy M. Smith and I, Victor J. Smith, DO NOT AGREE AND OBJECT TO THE DRILLING OF THESE WELLS OR FUTURE WELLS DRILLED AT THIS SITE.

This well site is to be drilled less than 600 feet from my house and property. I have received some maps that are so distorted from being copied they are hard to understand.

I object to the drilling of said site because of the closeness to my home and water well. The well site will be a problem with increased noise, traffic and extreme lighting, but more importantly I am extremely concerned for the foundation of my home and over all buildings structure. Neighbors have lost their water well due to a Marcellus well that was further away.

Our biggest fear and objections is the danger of being in the red zone resulting in loss of life or at the least loss of house and property.







ORDER

It is ordered that Nabors Completion & Production Services Co. may use the cement blend listed in Findings of Fact No.1 for the cementing of surface and coal protection casing of oil and gas wells in the State as may be requested by oil and gas operators. The waiting time on the cement blend shall be 8 hours. The cement blend shall be mixed in strict accordance with the specifications for each blend and weight measurements made on-site to assure the cement slurries meet the minimum weight specifications. A sample shall be collected and, if after 8 hours the cement is not set up, additional time will be required. Nabors Completion & Production Services Co. shall keep a record of cement blend jobs in which the cement blend approved under this order is to be used and made available to the Office of Oil and Gas upon request.

Notice is hereby given:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(b), notice is hereby given that the undersigned well operator has applied for a permit for well work or for a certificate of approval for the construction of an impoundment or pit.

This Notice Shall Include:

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6A-10(b), this notice shall include: (1) copies of the application; (2) the erosion and sediment control plan required by section seven of this article; and (3) the well plat.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6A-10(f), this notice shall include: (1) a statement of the time limits for filing written comments; (2) who may file written comments; (3) the name and address of the secretary for the purpose of filing the comments and obtaining additional information; and (4) a statement that the persons may request, at the time of submitting written comments, notice of the permit decision and a list of persons qualified to test water.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 35-8-5.7.a, the operator shall provide the Well Site Safety Plan to the surface owner and any water purveyor or surface owner subject to notice and water testing as provided in section 15 of this rule.

Pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 35-8-15.2.c, this notice shall: (1) contain a statement of the surface owner's and water purveyor's right to request sampling and analysis; (2) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of the rebuttable presumption for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply; advise the surface owner and water purveyor that refusal to allow the operator to conduct a pre-drilling water well test constitutes a method to rebut the presumption of liability; (3) advise the surface owner and water purveyor of his or her independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense; advise the surface owner and water purveyor whether or not the operator will utilize an independent laboratory to analyze any sample; and (4) advise the surface owner and or water purveyor that he or she can obtain from the Chief a list of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable of and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard acceptable methods.

Additional information related to horizontal drilling may be obtained from the Secretary, at the WV Department of Environmental Protection headquarters, located at 601 57th Street, SE, Charleston, WV 25304 (304-926-0450) or by visiting www.dep.wv.gov/oil-and-gas/pages/default.aspx.

Well Location Restrictions

Pursuant to W. Va. Code § 22-6A-12, Wells may not be drilled within two hundred fifty feet measured horizontally from any existing water well or developed spring used for human or domestic animal consumption. The center of well pads may not be located within six hundred twenty-five feet of an occupied dwelling structure, or a building two thousand five hundred square feet or larger used to house or shelter dairy cattle or poultry husbandry. This limitation is applicable to those wells, developed springs, dwellings or agricultural buildings that existed on the date a notice to the surface owner of planned entry for surveying or staking as provided in section ten of this article or a notice of intent to drill a horizontal well as provided in subsection (b), section sixteen of this article was provided, whichever occurs first, and to any dwelling under construction prior to that date. This limitation may be waived by written consent of the surface owner transmitted to the department and recorded in the real property records maintained by the clerk of the county commission for the county in which such property is located. Furthermore, the well operator may be granted a variance by the secretary from these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan which identifies the sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations. The variance, if granted, shall include terms and conditions the department requires to ensure the safety and protection of affected persons and property. The terms and conditions may include insurance, bonding and indemnification, as well as technical requirements. (b) No well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the department shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary. (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, nothing contained in this section prevents an operator from conducting the activities permitted or authorized by a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit or other approval from the United: States Army Corps of Engineers within any waters of the state or within the restricted areas referenced in this section. (d) The well location restrictions set forth in this section shall not apply to any well on a multiple well pad if at least one of the wells was permitted prior to the effective date of this article. (e) The secretary shall, by December 31, 2012, report to the Legislature on the noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds generated by the drilling of horizontal wells as they relate to the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures pursuant to this section. Upon a finding, if any, by the secretary that the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures are inadequate or otherwise require alteration to address the items

examined in the study required by this subsection, the secretary shall have the authority to propose for promulgation legislative rules establishing guidelines and procedures regarding reasonable levels of noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds relating to drilling horizontal wells, including reasonable means of mitigating such factors, if necessary.

Water Well Testing:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(d), notification shall be made, with respect to surface landowners identified in subsection (b) or water purveyors identified in subdivision (5), subsection (b) of this section, of the opportunity for testing their water well. The operator shall provide an analysis to such surface landowner or water purveyor at their request.

Water Testing Laboratories:

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(i), persons entitled to notice pursuant to subsection (b) of this section may contact the department to ascertain the names and locations of water testing laboratories in the subject area capable and qualified to test water supplies in accordance with standard accepted methods. In compiling that list of names the department shall consult with the state Bureau for Public Health and local health departments. A surface owner and water purveyor has an independent right to sample and analyze any water supply at his or her own expense. The laboratory utilized by the operator shall be approved by the agency as being certified and capable of performing sample analyses in accordance with this section.

Rebuttable Presumption for Contamination or Deprivation of a Fresh Water Source or Supply:

W. Va. Code § 22-6A-18 requires that (b) unless rebutted by one of the defenses established in subsection (c) of this section, in any action for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply within one thousand five hundred feet of the center of the well pad for horizontal well, there is a rebuttable presumption that the drilling and the oil or gas well or either was the proximate cause of the contamination or deprivation of the fresh water source or supply. (c) In order to rebut the presumption of liability established in subsection (b) of this section, the operator must prove by a preponderance of the evidence one of the following defenses: (1) The pollution existed prior to the drilling or alteration activity as determined by a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (2) The landowner or water purveyor refused to allow the operator access to the property to conduct a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (3) The water supply is not within one thousand five hundred feet of the well. (4) The pollution occurred more than six months after completion of drilling or alteration activities. (5) The pollution occurred as the result of some cause other than the drilling or alteration activity. (d) Any operator electing to preserve its defenses under subdivision (1), subsection (c) of this section shall retain the services of an independent certified laboratory to conduct the predrilling or prealteration water well test. A copy of the results of the test shall be submitted to the department and the surface owner or water purveyor in a manner prescribed by the secretary, (e) Any operator shall replace the water supply of an owner of interest in real property who obtains all or part of that owner's supply of water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other legitimate use from an underground or surface source with a comparable water supply where the secretary determines that the water supply has been affected by contamination, diminution or interruption proximately caused by the oil or gas operation, unless waived in writing by that owner. (f) The secretary may order the operator conducting the oil or gas operation to: (1) Provide an emergency drinking water supply within twenty-four hours; (2) Provide temporary water supply within seventy-two hours; (3) Within thirty days begin activities to establish a permanent water supply or submit a proposal to the secretary outlining the measures and timetables to be used in establishing a permanent supply. The total time in providing a permanent water supply may not exceed two years. If the operator demonstrates that providing a permanent replacement water supply cannot be completed within two years, the secretary may extend the time frame on case-by-case basis; and (4) Pay all reasonable costs incurred by the real property owner in securing a water supply. (g) A person as described in subsection (b) of this section aggrieved under the provisions of subsections (b), (e) or (f) of this section may seek relief in court... (i) Notwithstanding the denial of the operator of responsibility for the damage to the real property owner's water supply or the status of any appeal on determination of liability for the damage to the real property owner's water supply, the operator may not discontinue providing the required water service until authorized to do so by the secretary or a court of competent jurisdiction.

Time Limits and Methods for Filing Comments.

The law requires these materials to be served on or before the date the operator files its Application. You have THIRTY (30) DAYS after the filing date to file your comments. Comments must be filed in person or received in the mail by the Chief's office by the time stated above. You may call the Chief's office to be sure of the date. Check with your postmaster to ensure adequate delivery time or to arrange special expedited handling. If you have been contacted by the well operator and you have signed a "voluntary statement of no objection" to the planned work described in these materials, then the permit may be issued at any time.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-11(c)(2), Any objections of the affected coal operators and coal seam owners and lessees shall be addressed through the processes and procedures that exist under sections fifteen, seventeen and forty, article six of this chapter, as applicable and as incorporated into this article by section five of this article. The written comments filed by the parties entitled to notice under subdivisions (1), (2), (4), (5) and (6), subsection (b), section ten of this article shall be considered by the secretary in the permit issuance process, but the parties are not entitled to participate in the processes and proceedings that exist under sections fifteen, seventeen or forty, article six of this chapter, as applicable and as incorporated into this article by section five of this article

Comment Requirements

Your comments must be in writing and include your name, address and telephone number, the well operator's name and well number and the approximate location of the proposed well site including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

Disclaimer: All comments received will be placed on our web site http://www.dep.wv.gov/oil-and-gas/Horizontal-Permits/Pages/default.aspx and the applicant will automatically be forwarded an email notice that such comments have been submitted. The applicant will be expected to provide a response to comments submitted by any surface owner, water purveyor or natural gas storage operator noticed within the application.

Permit Denial or Condition

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit. Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d), the permit may not be issued or be conditioned, including conditions with respect to the location of the well and access roads prior to issuance if the director determines that:

- (1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons;
- (2) The plan for soil erosion and sediment control is not adequate or effective;
- (3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources; or
- (4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies.

A permit may also be denied under West Virginia Code § 22-6A-7(k), the secretary shall deny the issuance of a permit if the secretary determines that the applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previously issued permit for a horizontal well, including the applicable erosion and sediment control plan associated with the previously issued permit, or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under this article, and in each instance has failed to abate or seek review of the violation within the time prescribed by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2), subsection (a), section five of this article and the rules promulgated hereunder, which time may not be unreasonable.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(g), any person entitled to submit written comments to the secretary pursuant to subsection (a), section eleven of this article, shall also be entitled to receive from the secretary a copy of the permit as issued or a copy of the order modifying or denying the permit if the person requests receipt of them as a part of the written comments submitted concerning the permit application. Such persons may request, at the time of submitting written comments, notice of the permit decision and a list of persons qualified to test water.



The variance, if granted, shall include terms and conditions the department requires to ensure the safety and protection of affected persons and property. 




