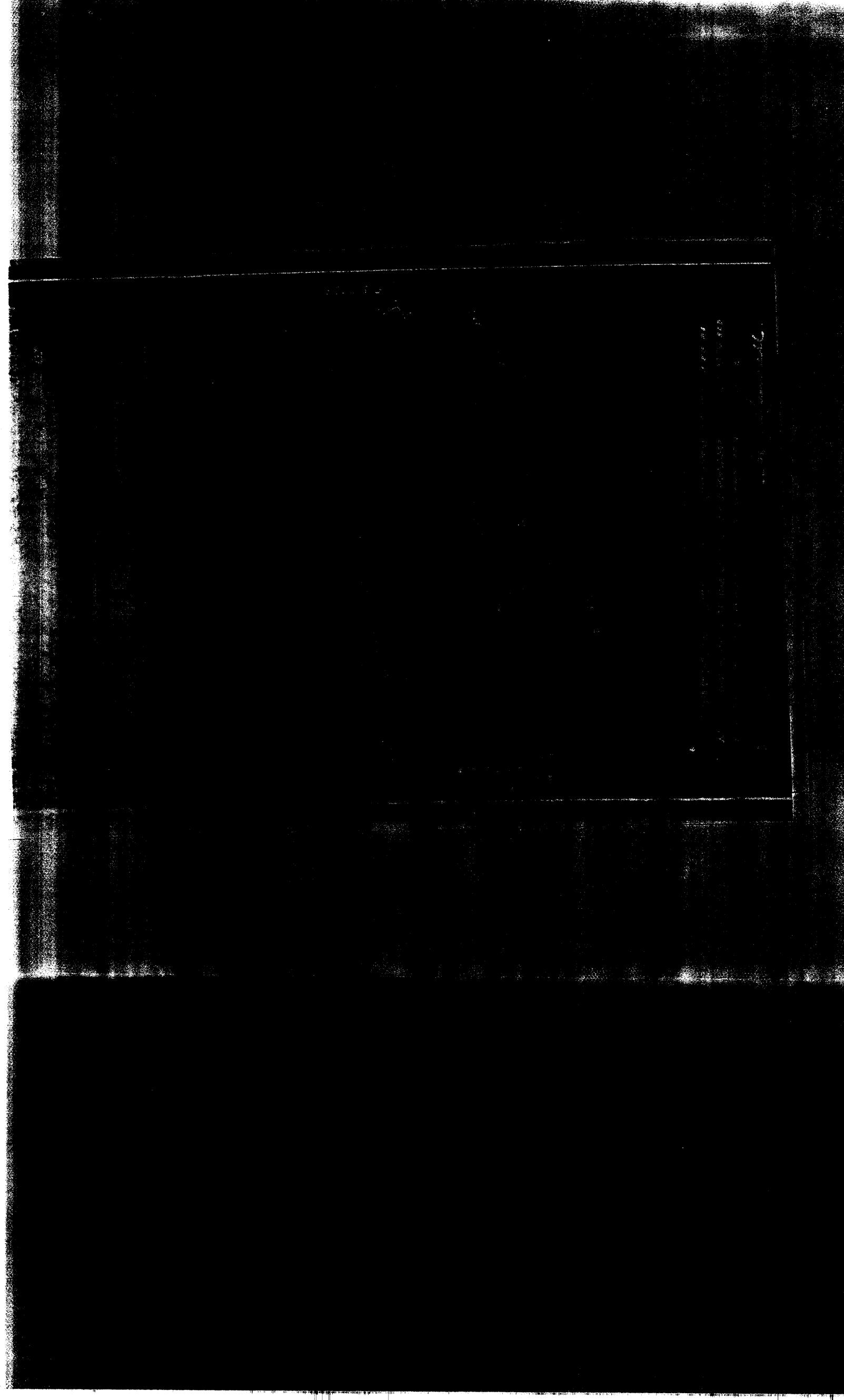

Answering your letter of August 6th, upon investigation of the above numbered well on the Belle Holt tract I find we purchased this well, already drilled, from the Sun Gas Company in September, 1916.

At that time they advised that the well was producing from the Gordon sand at a total depth of 2413 feet. There was a total of 2210 feet of 6 5/8" casing and 2413 feet of 2" tubing. This is the only information we have as we do not have a log of the well.
