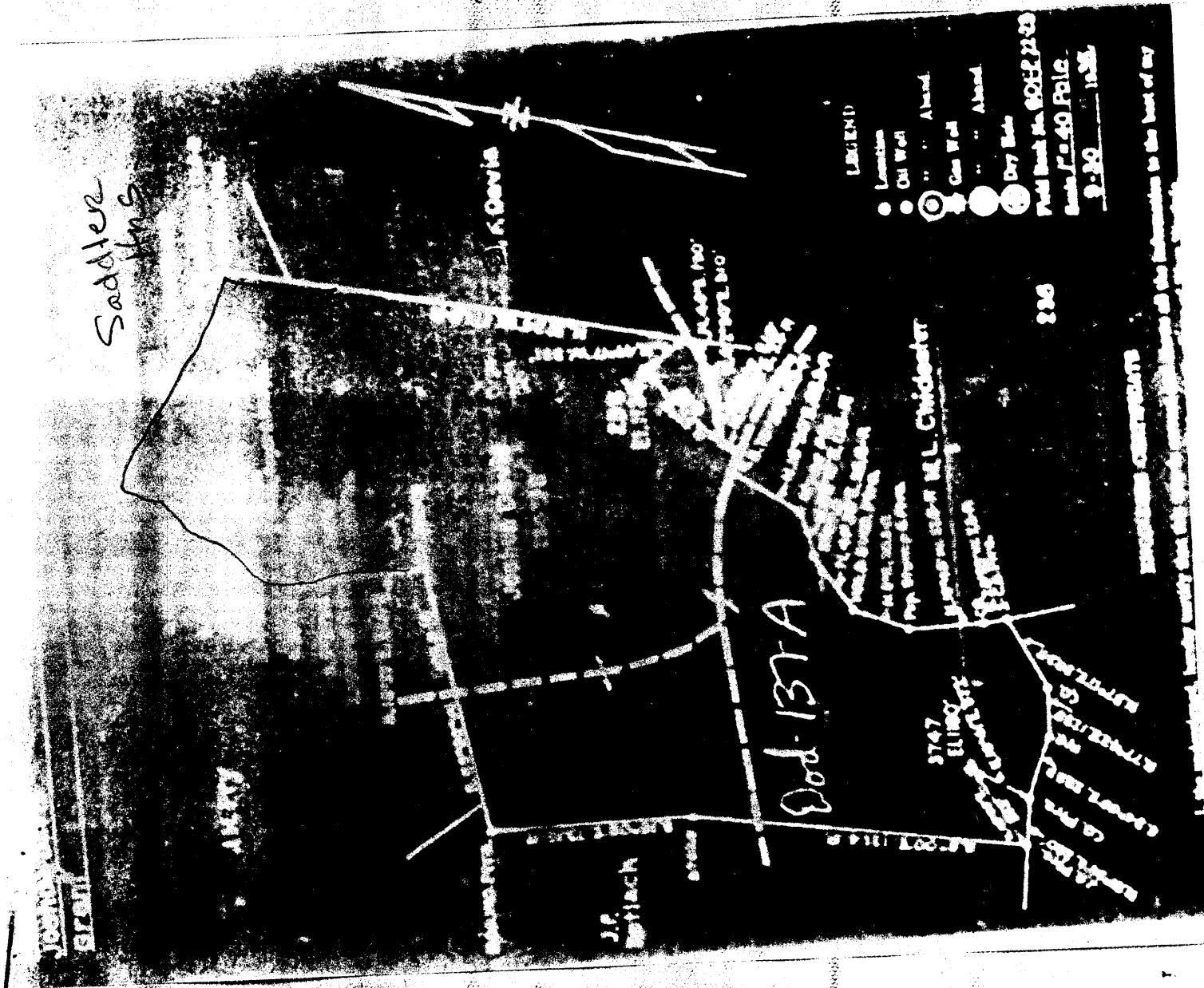

AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA,
County of Boone

Thomas F. Stum and Thomas A. Statler being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Boone Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 5th day of October, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in

Manner in which said well was plugged: Filled hole with clay mud from bottom to 2911, 20 feet above Gordon tray and placed a suitable cement plug and a wood plug. Installed permanent bridge at 2318, 30' above the big Injun sand, and temporarily filled with clay mud to 2170, 20' above the big Injun sand. Placed 6-5/8" wood rod, lead wool, and cement plugs. Removed 6-5/8" casing, set at 2154'. Installed permanent bridge at 1490, 30' below Dunkard Sand, and filled with clay mud to 1425'. Dunkard Sand, and placed cement plug. Installed permanent bridge at 890, 30' below Pittsborough Coal, and filled with cement to 836, 20' above Coal seam. From this point to the surface the hole was filled with clay mud to surface, and a concrete monument was erected over the hole.

Description of monument: 10 x 8 x 5 with inscription HNGCO. # 238.
