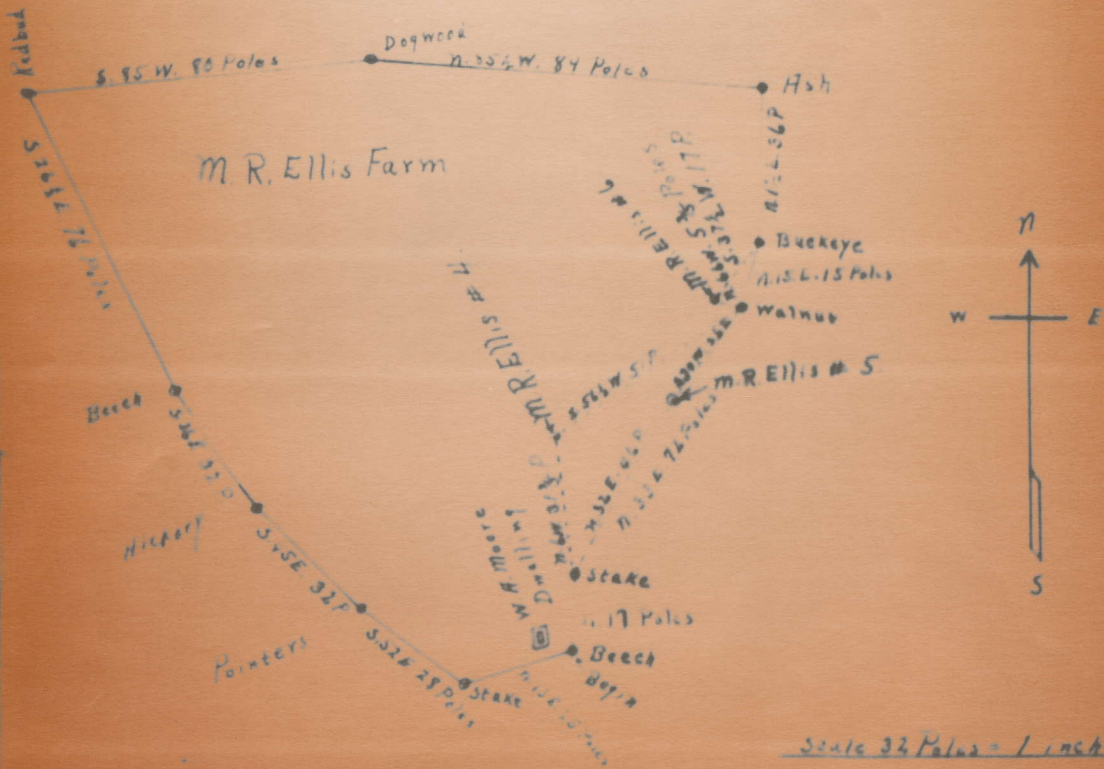


NOT LOCATED

A. M. Ellis and he is being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that ~~they~~ he experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by W. R. Rittenhouse O & G Co. well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 5th day of July, 1931 and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

**Manner in which sand was plugged:**

Well was filled up to 1690 feet with red mud and cement, not being able on account of pipe sitting on the sand to drive plug that day I filled up 30 feet more with sand and cement and drove plug in pipe to 1640 but did not shut off gas, filled up to 1600 with red clay, drove plug, gave it a twelve hour test, showed that the hole was completely sealed, then shot off the pipe, pulled the pipe and filled the hole with red mud and stone.
