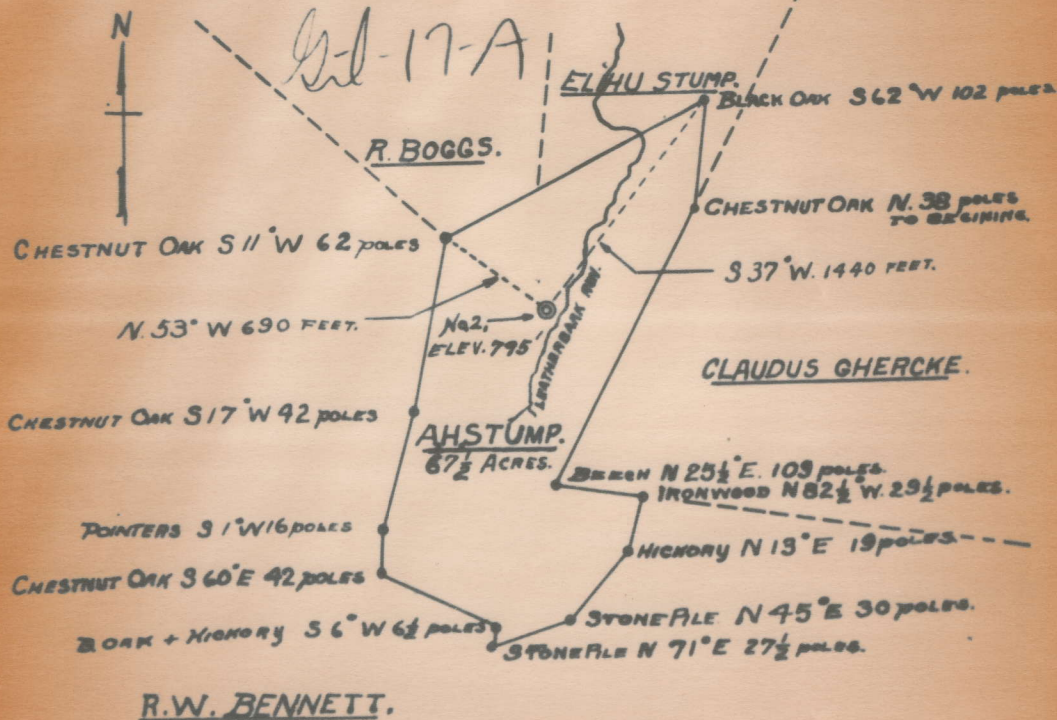

15th day of September, 1930, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged: In accordance with provisions of Sec. 10, this well was filled on top of a bridge set 30 ft. below the lowest pay sand, the Weir, and extending up the hole through all pay strata to a height of 116 ft. above the top strata. A wood plug was anchored 10 ft. below the largest casing and the remainder retained as a fresh water well.
