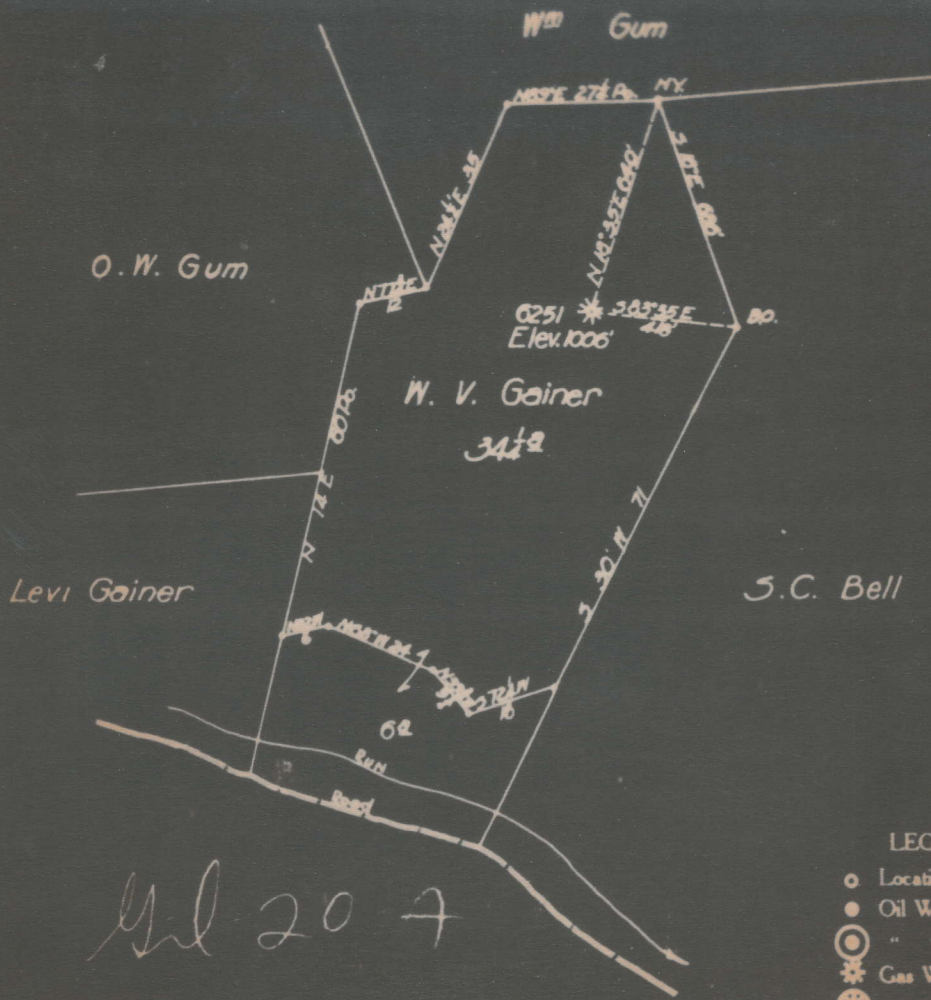

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 19th day of May, 1931, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Total Depth 2480.

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with clay to 2225 ft. drove 6" wood plug and run 2-bgs. cement. Filled solid to 2290', drove wood plug 2290' and ran 200' cement. Bridged hole @ 2140', filled solid to 1785, a point 20' above Injun Sand, and drove wood plug at 1785 and 5" lead plug at 1785'. Pulled 5-5/8" casing. Bridged hole at 1715 ft. and filled with clay to 1295 ft. a point 20 ft. above salt sand. Drove 6" wood plug at 1295' and ran 200' cement. Bridged hole at 1080 ft., filled solid to 960 ft. and drove 6" wood plug. Bridged hole at 800 ft. and filled solid to 760 ft. and drove wood plug. Pulled 6-5/8" Casing. Bridged hole at 375 ft. Filled solid to 245 ft. and

Manner in which coal was plugged: No Coal) drove 6" wood plug. Filled solid with clay to top. All gas shut off.

Description of monument: 8"x8" x 5' set in concrete base 30"x30"x30", monument extending 30" above surface of soil. 3" pipe extends throughout center of monument.
