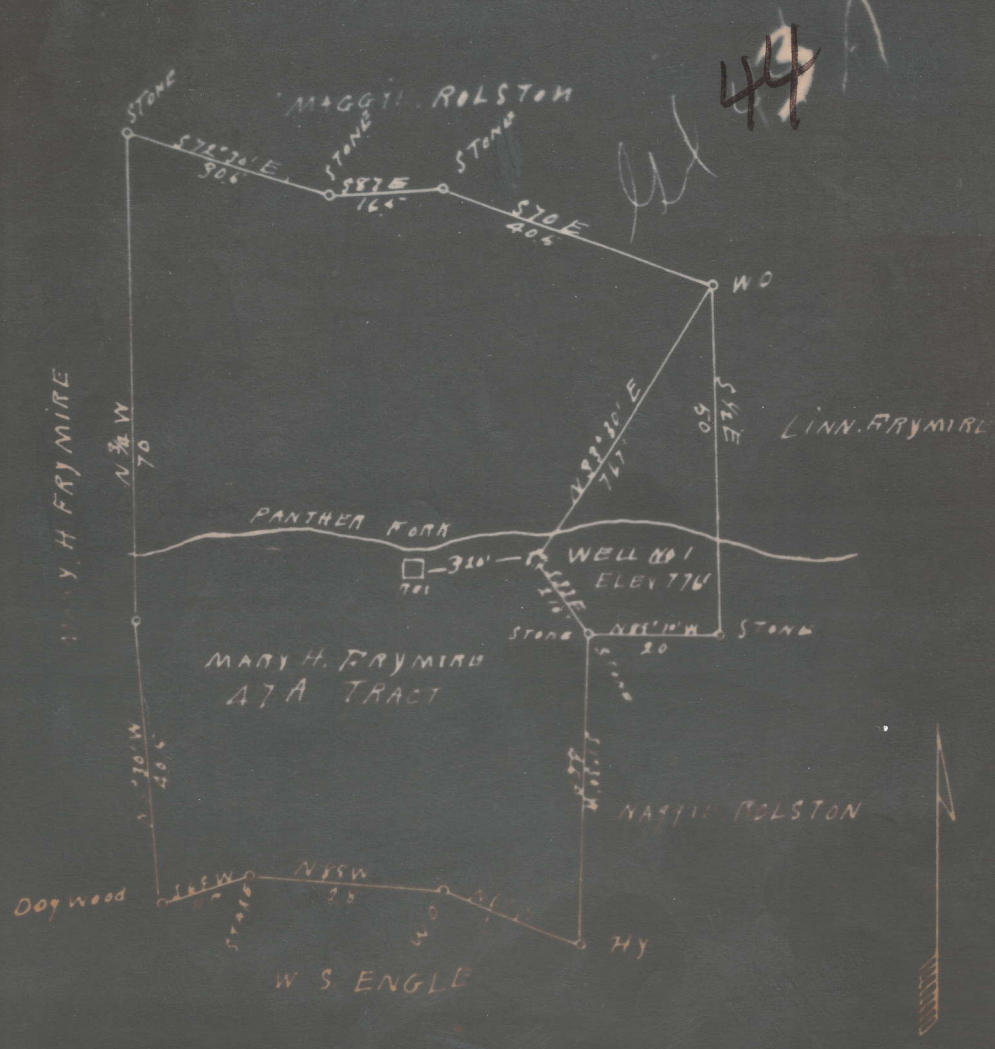


LOCATED IN DEPAID DISTRICT GILMER Co. W. VA.

20th day of July, 1933, and that the well was plugged and filled in
