

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of  
and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by E L Rakle, well  
and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced  
1st day of July, 1933, and that the well was plugged and  
the following manner:

Manner in which ~~well~~ was plugged:

With red clay from bottom up to 20' above big injun sand  
Lead plug set about 20' feet above Big injun sand, cement set  
Set permanent bridge 30' below salt sand; filled with red  
to 20' above salt sand; set wood plug about 30' above salt  
filled with red clay to within 300 feet of top of well; set  
wood plug there; filled with red clay to 392 feet from top of  
filled with red clay to top. Lead plug was further sealed with  
cement plug about 3' then at intervals above 5 other 3' cen  
tainers in which ~~was~~ was plugged.
