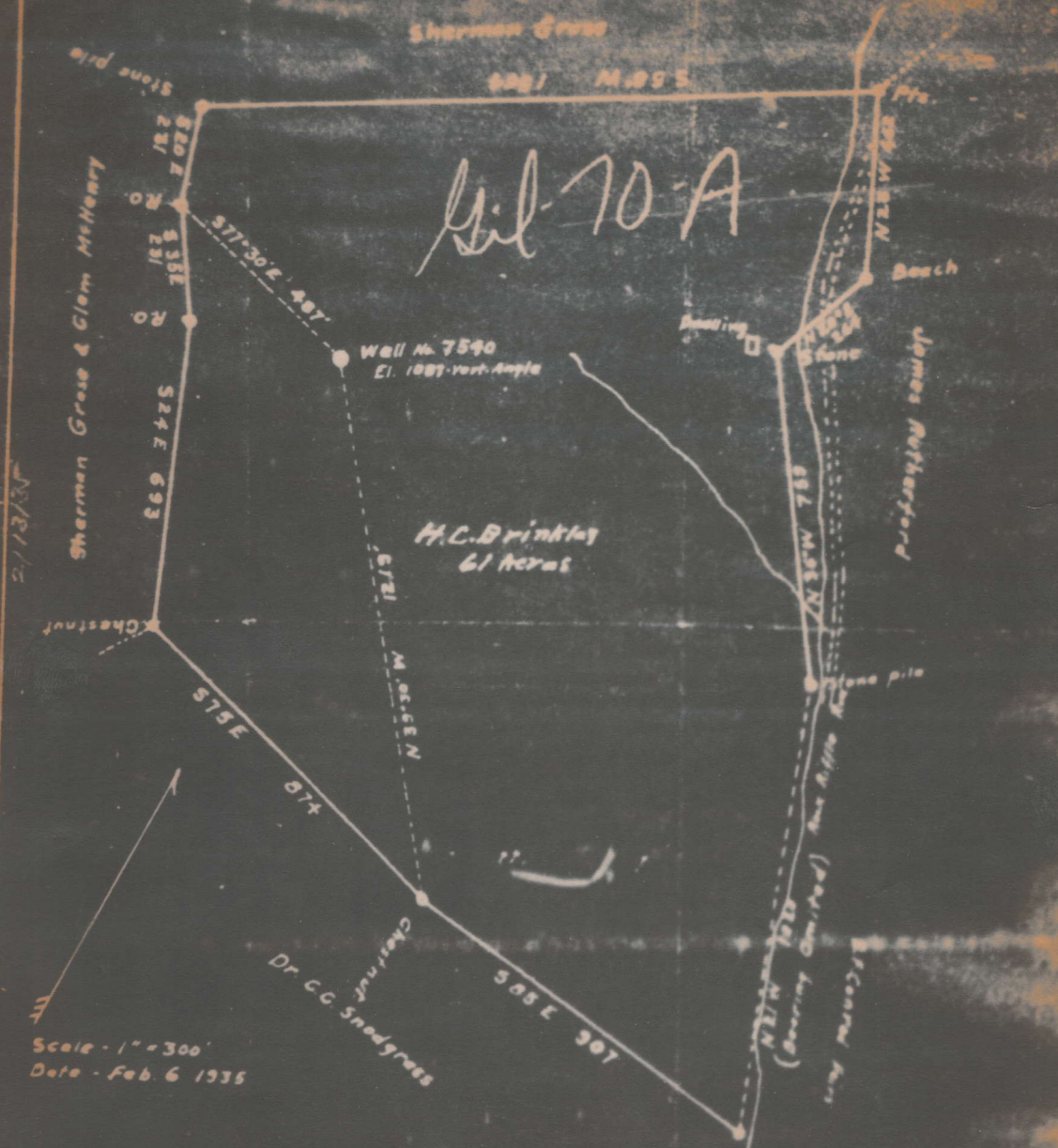


Plot of the actual location of the Sherman

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by T. C. Zinn, well operator,
and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the
18th day of February, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in
the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled with red clay from 2175' to 1957'
drove wood plug from 1957' to 1954', cemented from 1954' to 1943'
Pulled 6 5/8 casing, filled with red clay from 1945' to 1748' 20'
above laxton sand.

Drove wood plug from 1743' to 1745' filled with red clay from 1745'
to 1735', set a permanent bridge at 1045' to 920' filled with red clay
from 1045' to 920' and drove wood plug from 920' to 917' and filled
