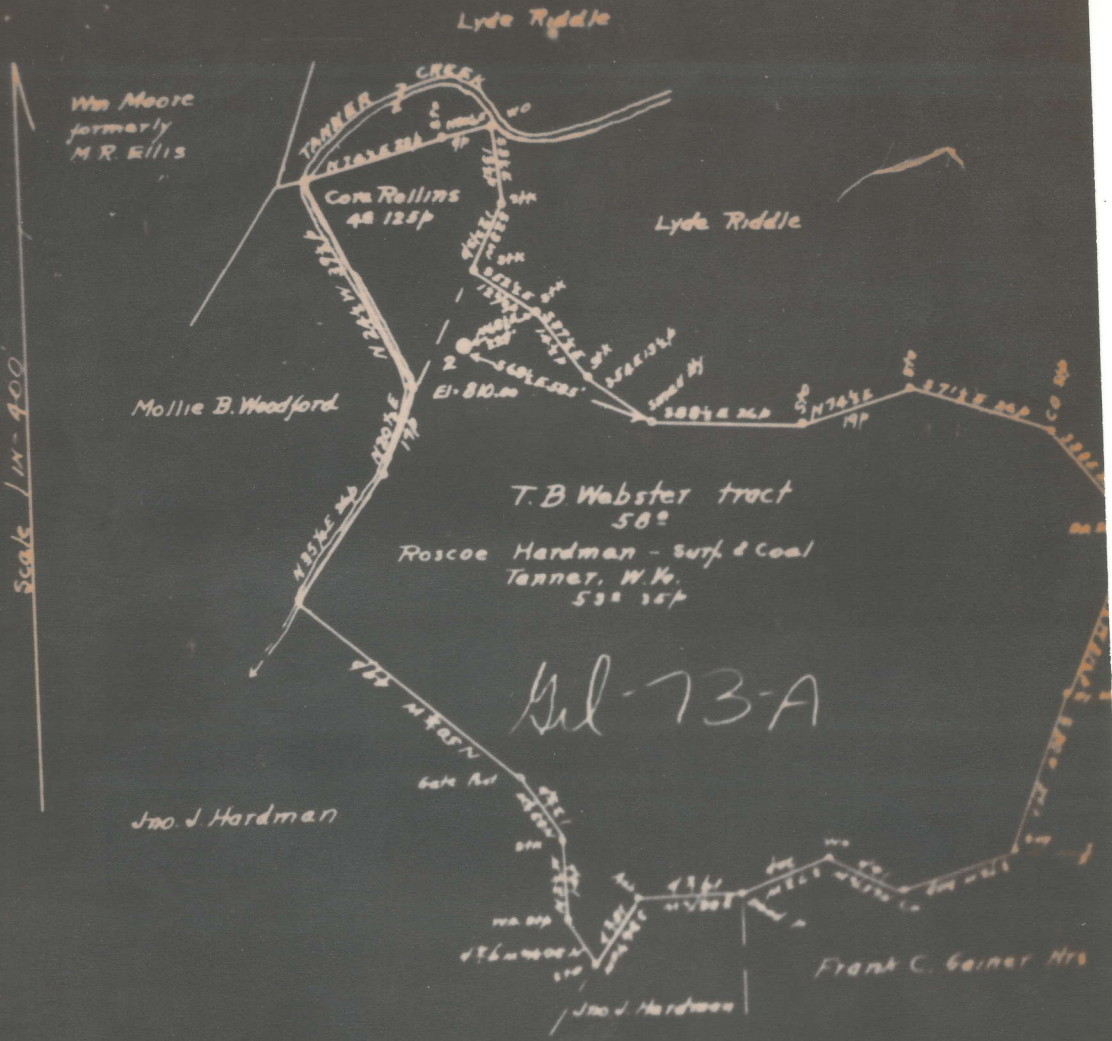

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Company and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

17th day of June, 19 35, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:

Total Depth 1596'. Filled with non-porous material to 1565'. Set 6-5/8" common wood dry hole plug 1565' to 1562'. Set cement plug 1562' to 1207' 6-5/8" casing would not pull. Cut casing at 1367' and pulled. Hole again plugged and filled up to 1207' after pulling 6-5/8" casing. Set 8-1/4" common wood dry hole plug 1207' to 1204'. Set cement plug 1204' to 1194'. Filled with non-porous material to 950'. Set 8-1/4" common wood dry hole plug 950' to 947'. Set cement plug 947' to 937'. Filled with non-porous material to 790'. Set 8-1/4" common wood dry hole plug 790' to 787'. Set cement plug 787' to 784'. Filled with non-porous material to 519'. Set cement plug 519' to 509'. Filled with non-porous material to 330'. Set wood plug 330' to 327'. Set cement plug 327' to 317'. Filled with non-porous material to surface.

Description of monument: Set in hole a piece of 2 1/2" casing for 17 ft. hole 17 ft. and extends above surface 4 ft. Filled inside of casing with and non-porous material within one foot of top. Put in one foot of cement top of marker in which is anchored a brass plate giving date, location, well number, farm name and company. All done in workmanlike manner.
