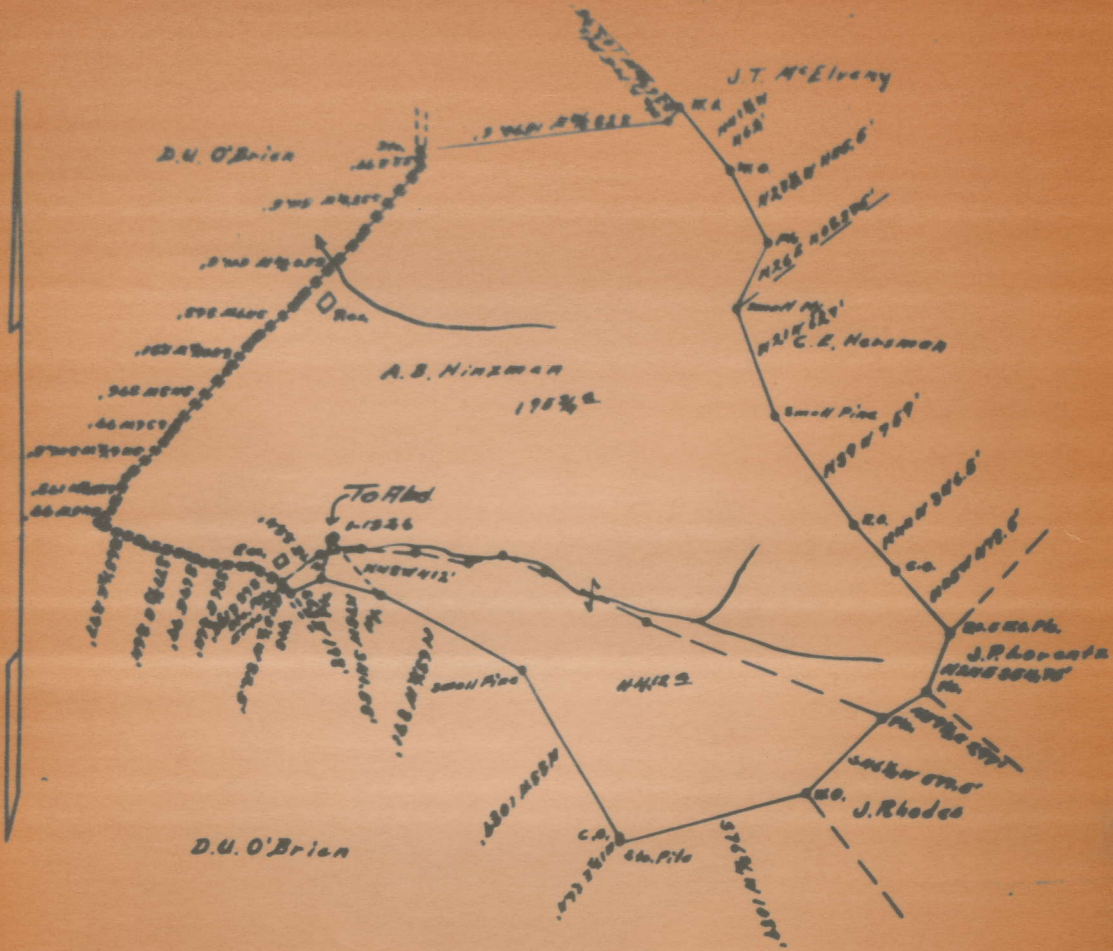

 and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by CARNEGIE NATURAL GAS COMPANY, well operator,
 and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the
4th day of NOVEMBER, 19 35, and that the well was plugged and filled in
 the following manner:

 Pulled 1578' of 2" Tubing
 Filled with clay from 1578' to 1553'
 Drove 6" Wood plug from 1553' to 1550'
 Cement from 1550' to 1540'
 Pulled 1540' of 6" Casing
 Filled with clay from 1540' to 1420'
 Cement from 1420' to 1410' - Sealing Maxon Sand

Manner in which coal was plugged:

Filled with clay from 1410' to 760'
 Drove 8" Wood plug from 760' to 757'
 Cement from 757' to 750'
 Pulled 750' of 8" Casing
 Filled with clay from 750' to 400'
 Cement from 400' to 390' - Sealing Big Dunkard Sand
 Filled with clay to surface - Gas would not light when plugging was completed
