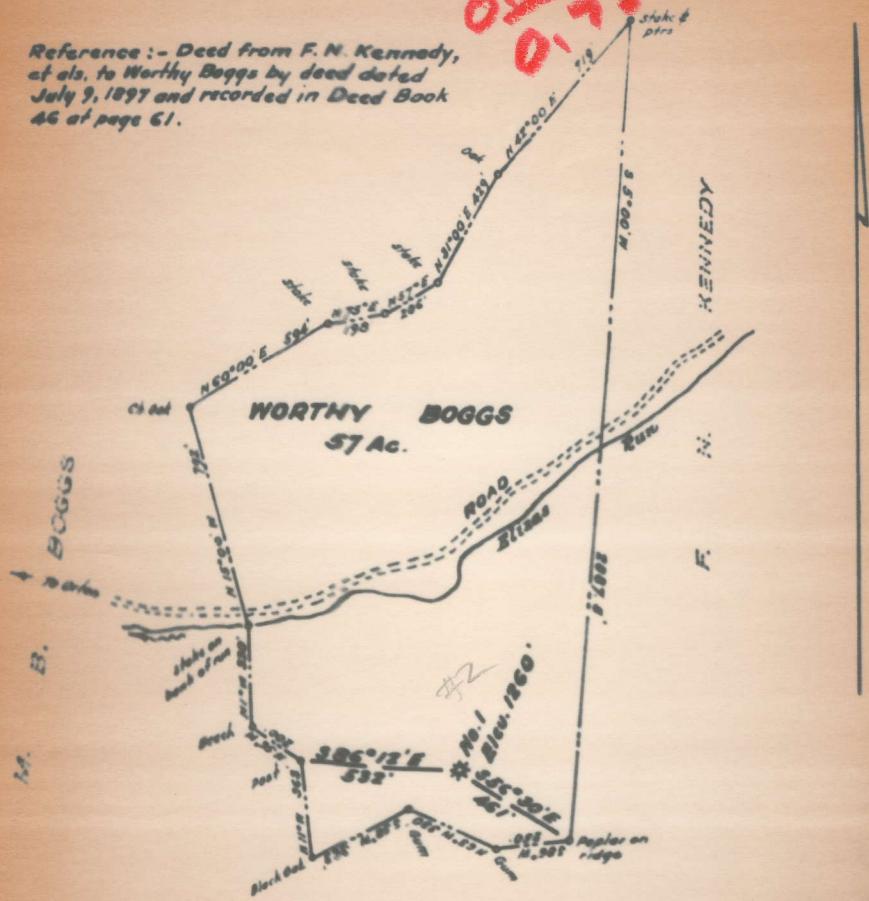

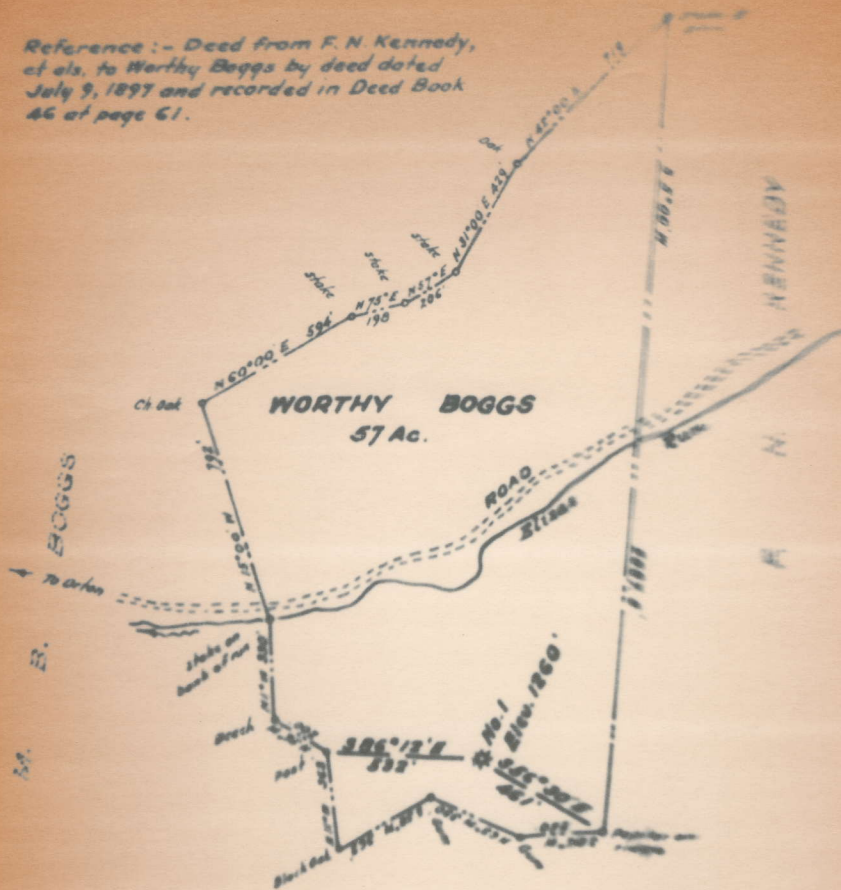

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES

Total Depth 2035'

Pull 2" tubing

Fill with clay from bottom to 1800'

Neat Cement 1800' - 1790'

5' crushed stone on cement plug - sealing hole completely through producing sand

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1200' - a point in the Salt Sands

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill with clay to 840' - 30' below 6-5/8" casing

Neat Cement 840' - 830'

5' crushed stone on cement plug - sealing off all salt water

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 300'

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill with clay to surface

Erect marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations

To the Department of Mines

Gentlemen:
