Abandonment reported to Dept. of Mines June 23, 1934.

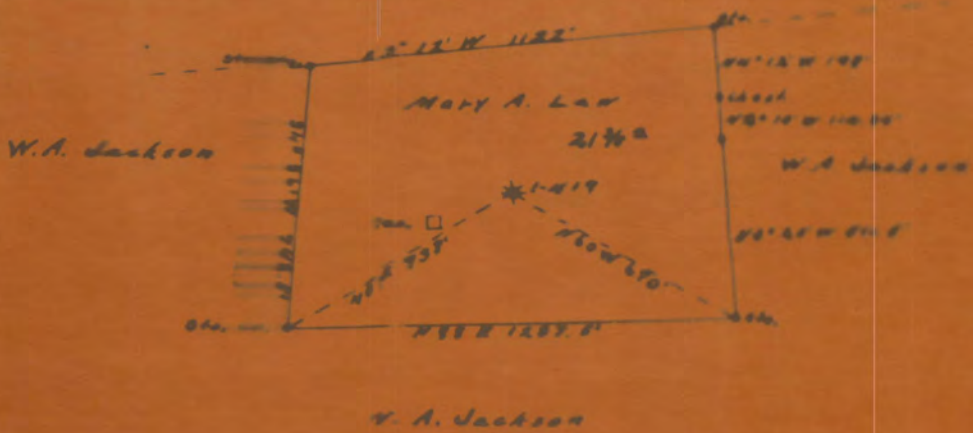
