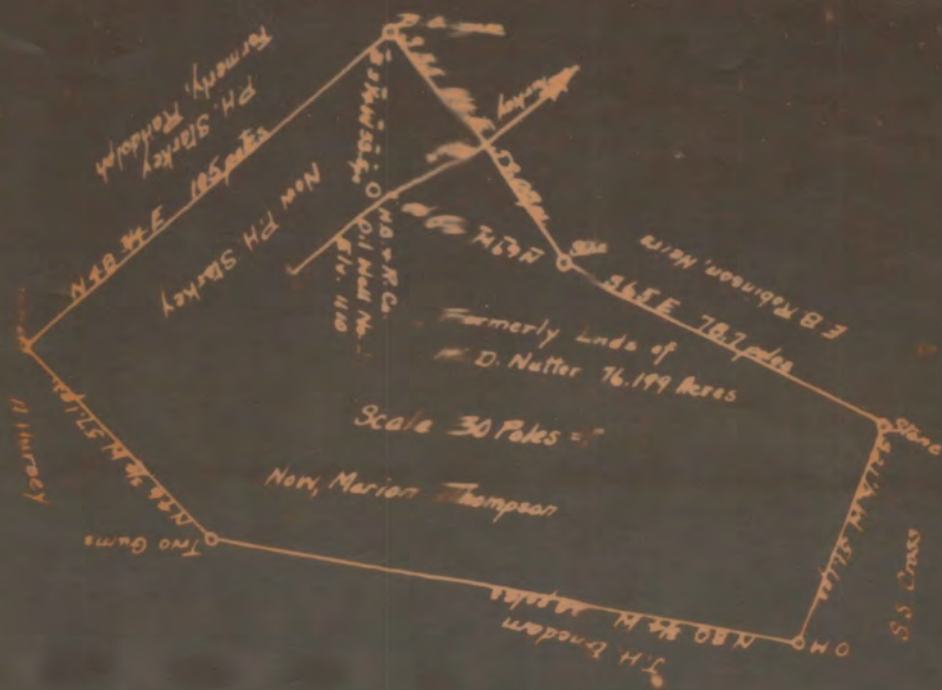

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by RAAD & MOSES, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

day of FEB. 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Filled hole with clay mud to 2860 and placed cement and wood plug removed ~~to 2860~~ 2000 feet of 5 3/16 casing and filled hole to 2675 placed cement and wood plug. Installed permanent bridge at 2350 and filled hole to 2170 and placed cement and wood plug. Installed bridge at 1765-30' below salt sand and filled hole with mud, clay to 1500 and placed cement plug. Installed bridge and plug at 1350' and filled with mud clay to 843-30' below Pitts. Manner in which coal was plugged: Coal Seam, then filled with cement to 787-20' above Pitts. Coal Seam; filled with clay to 280' 10' below where 10' casing was set, placed wood plug, removed casing and from that point to the surface was filled with clay and concrete monument erected over the hole as follows.
