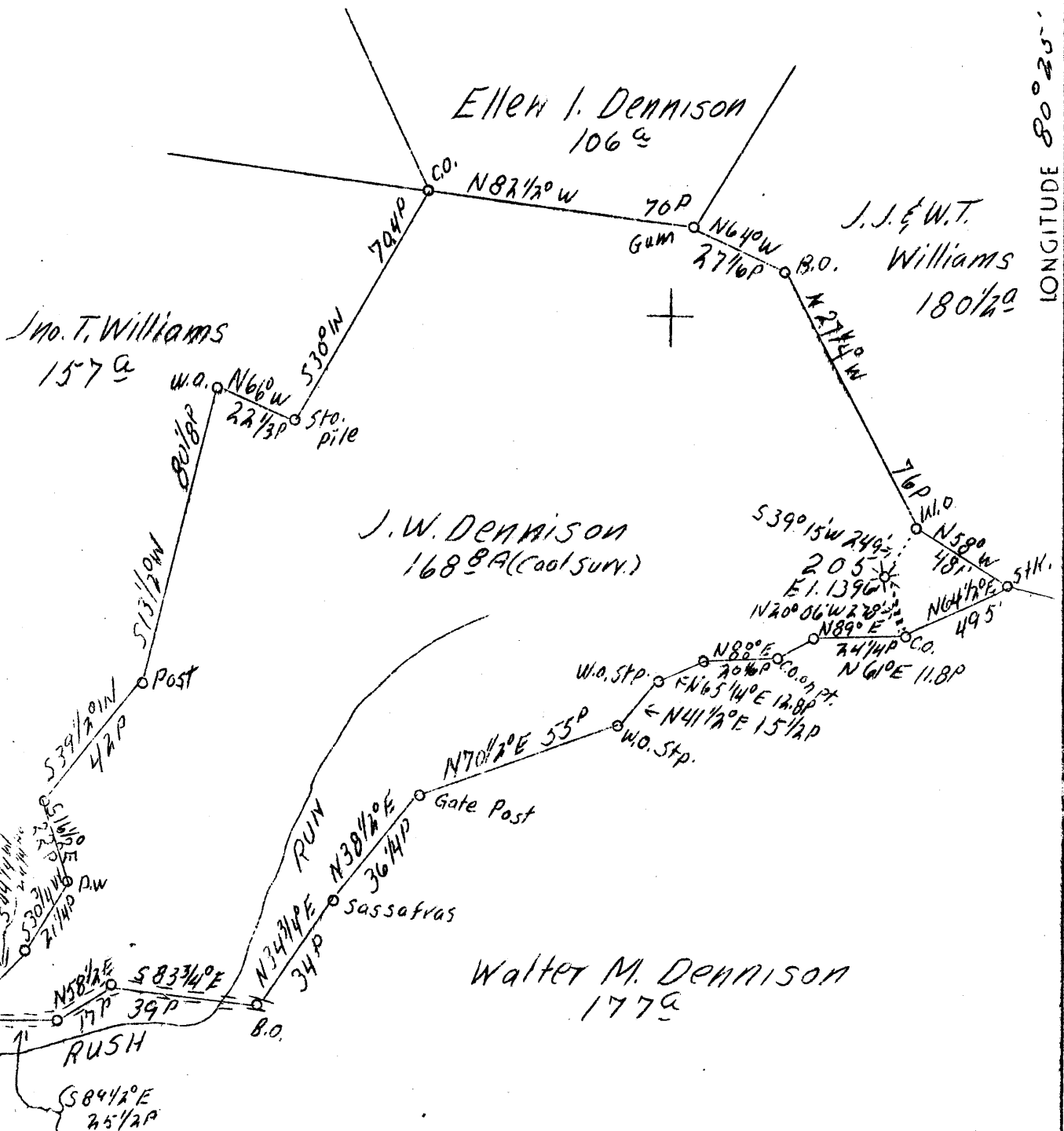

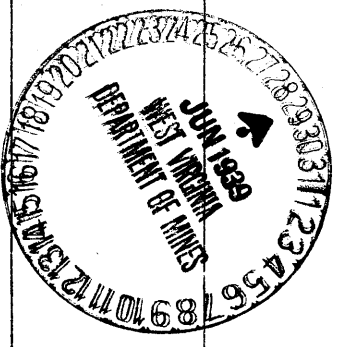

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Company, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 25th day of July, 1939, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which well was plugged:

Filled with clay to 2812, 20 feet above Fifth sand. Placed a cement plug. Filled with clay to 2971. Placed a cement plug. Bridged at 1920. Filled with clay to 1920. Drove lead plug at this point. All gas shut off. Ripped 6-3/8" casing at 1520, 1200, 1000 and at last at 813 feet. Was unable to pull casing below that point, as it had been mudded around. Filled with clay from 813 feet to 516 feet.

Manner in which coal was plugged:

Sealed from 516 to 460 feet. Filled from 460 to surface with clay and mud.

Description of monument:

Concrete shaft with inscription - H.N.G.Co. No. 205
