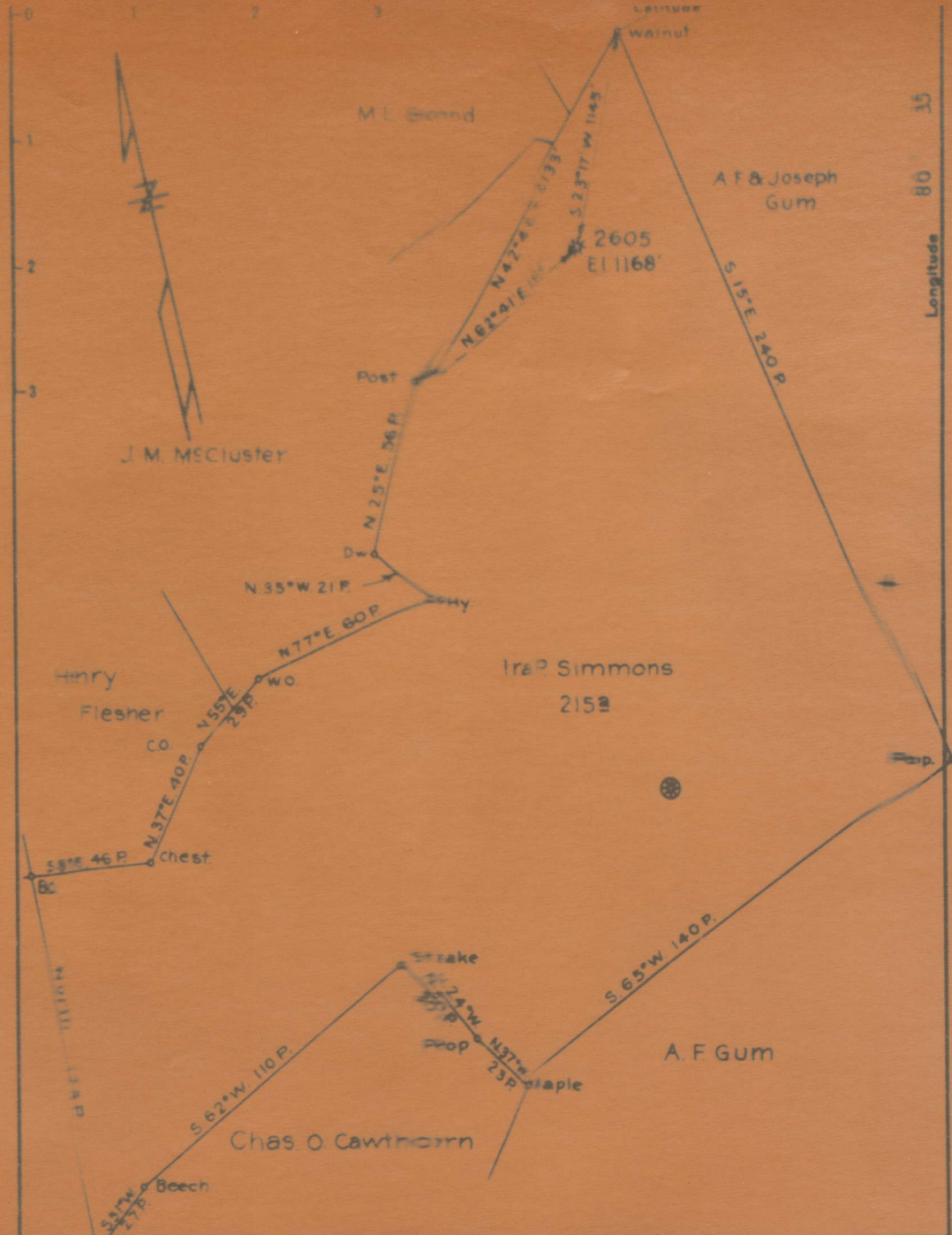

being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling of oil and gas wells and were employed by Hope Natural Gas Co., well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 18 day of May, 1936, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Total depth 2448 Ft. filled solid with clay to 2391 Ft. Set Cement Plug and 1 6-5/8" Wood Plug at 2391, Installed permanent bridge at 1970 filled solid with clay to 1810, Set lead plug. Installed bridge at 1310, filled with clay to 1115, cement plug at 1115, filled with clay to 985 & set Cement Plug, Bridged at 550 & filled with m
Manner in which coal was plugged: Clay to 324 ft.
Filled solid with Cement from 324 to 220 ft. through coal. and then filled solid with clay to surface of ground.

Description of monument: Concrete monument 5 ft. long erected over hole 2 1/2 ft under ground, and 2 1/2 ft. above ground inscribed with well number and name of Company
