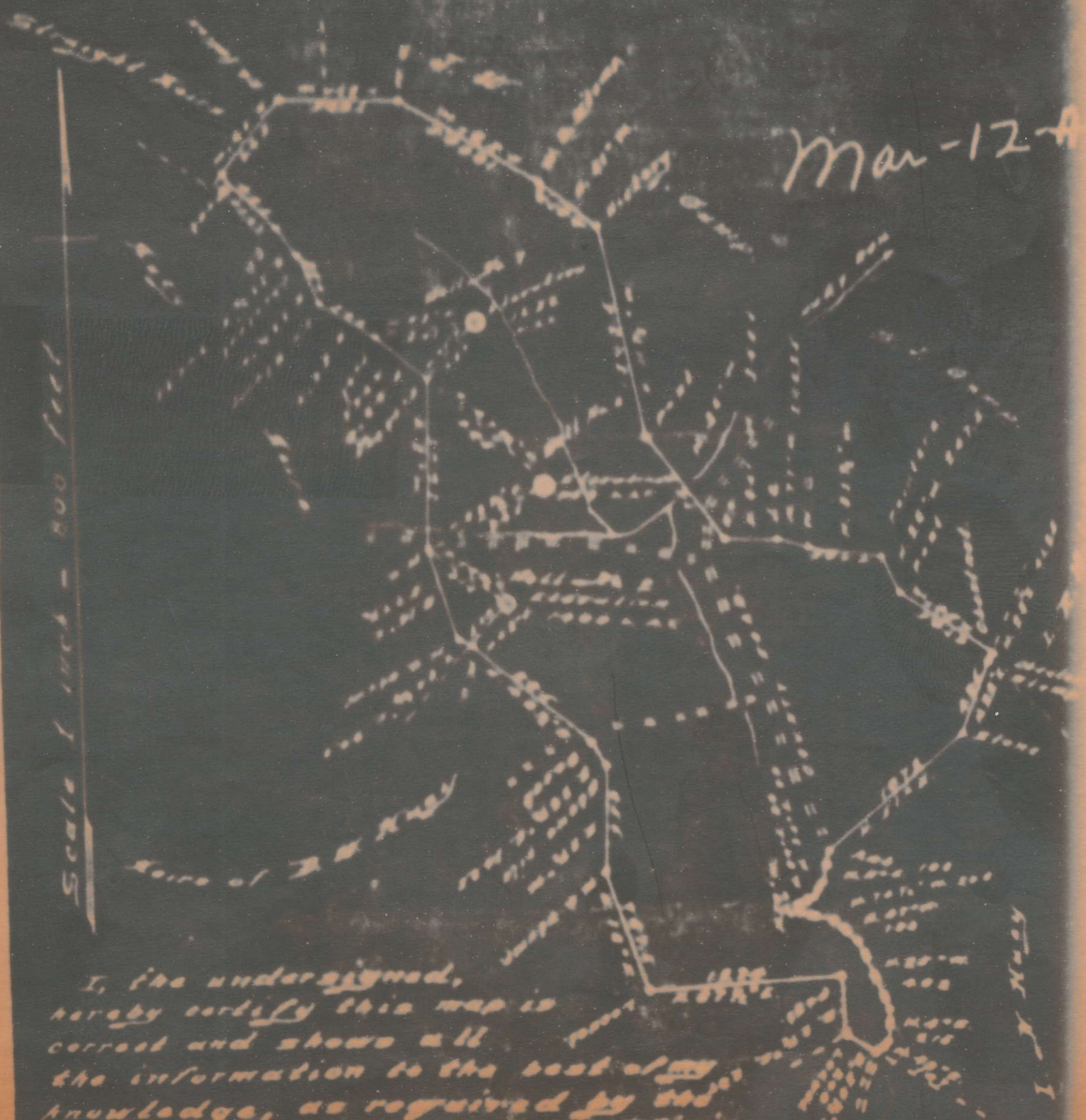

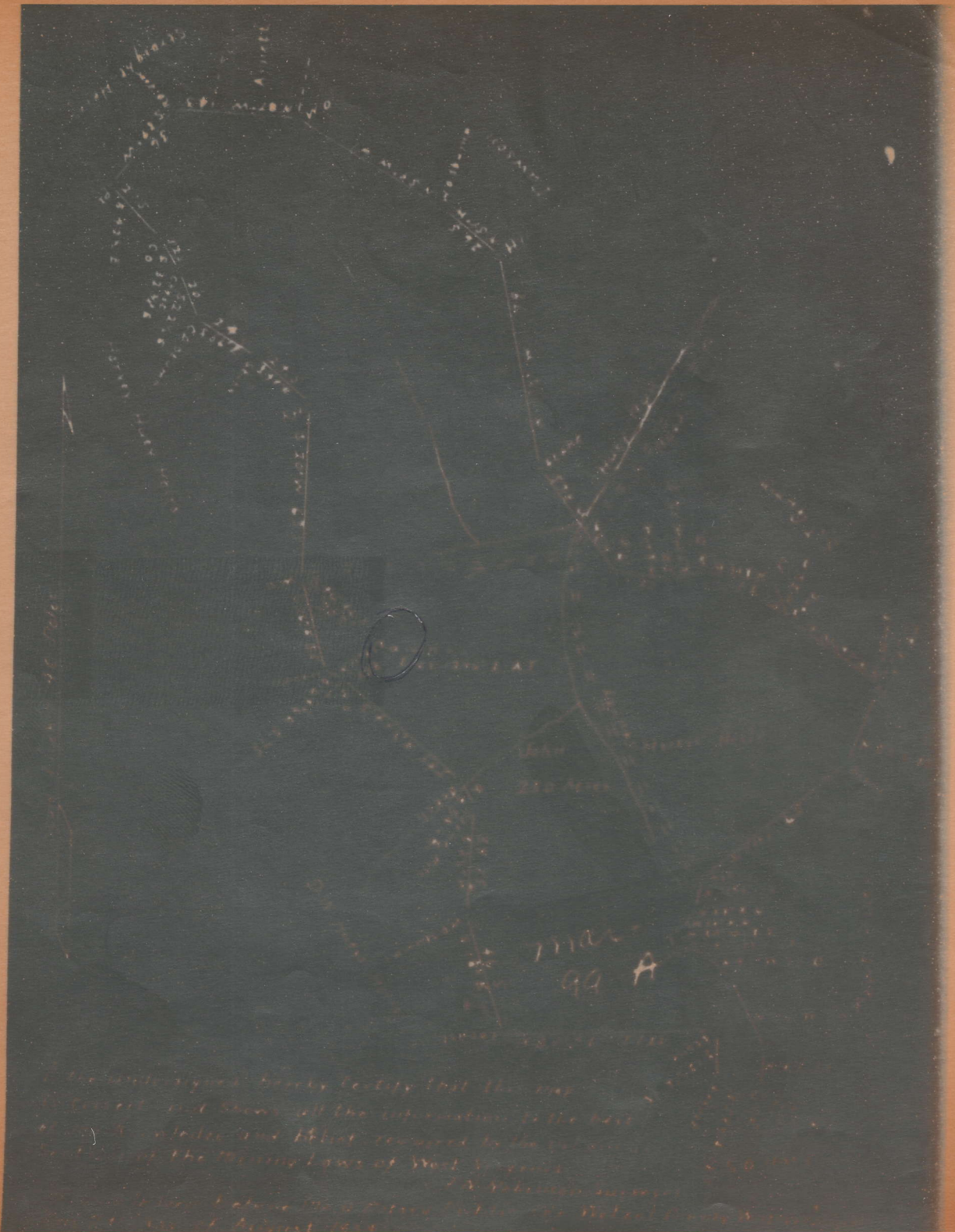
WELL LOCATION MAP
