MATTHEW A. YEARSLEY and KEVIN S. WRIGHT being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by West Virginia Land Resources, Inc. well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 1st day of June, 2022 and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

	Cleaned a 12 1/4" hole from the surface to 314'. Reduced the hole to 9 7/8" at 314'. Cleaned a 9 7/8" hole from 314' to the top of the existing 8 5/8" casing at 1109'. Reduced the hole to 7 7/8" at 1109'. Cleaned a 7 7/8" hole from the top of the 8 5/8" casing at 1109' to 1322'. Attempted to remove the 8 5/8" casing from 1109' by pulling 150% of the string weight but all attempts were unsuccessful due to extreme bonding behind the 8 5/8" casing. Due to the extreme bonding no additional perforations, rips or cuts were required per the Marshall Co. Mine 101C petition. Pilot milled the 8 5/8" casing through the Pittsburgh Coal Seam (1108.1' - 1115.0') from 1109' to 1121'. Left an unknown amount of 8 5/8" casing in the hole from 1121' to an unknown depth. Cleaned a 9 7/8" hole through the Pittsburgh Coal Seam. Left 20' of 16" conductor pipe in the hole from the surface to 20'. Cemented the hole from 1322' back to surface as follows: From 1322' to 908' with 155 sacks of Thixotropic Cement with a Gas Blocker additive. Tagged top of the Thixotropic Cement plug at 908'. Cemented the hole from 908' to the surface with 445 sacks of Expandable Cement. Cement did circulate at the surface. A total of 600 sacks of cement were used to fill the hole from 1322' to the surface.	8 5/8" Casing 16" Conductor	12' milled 0'	Unknown 20'


