WELL LOCATION MAP

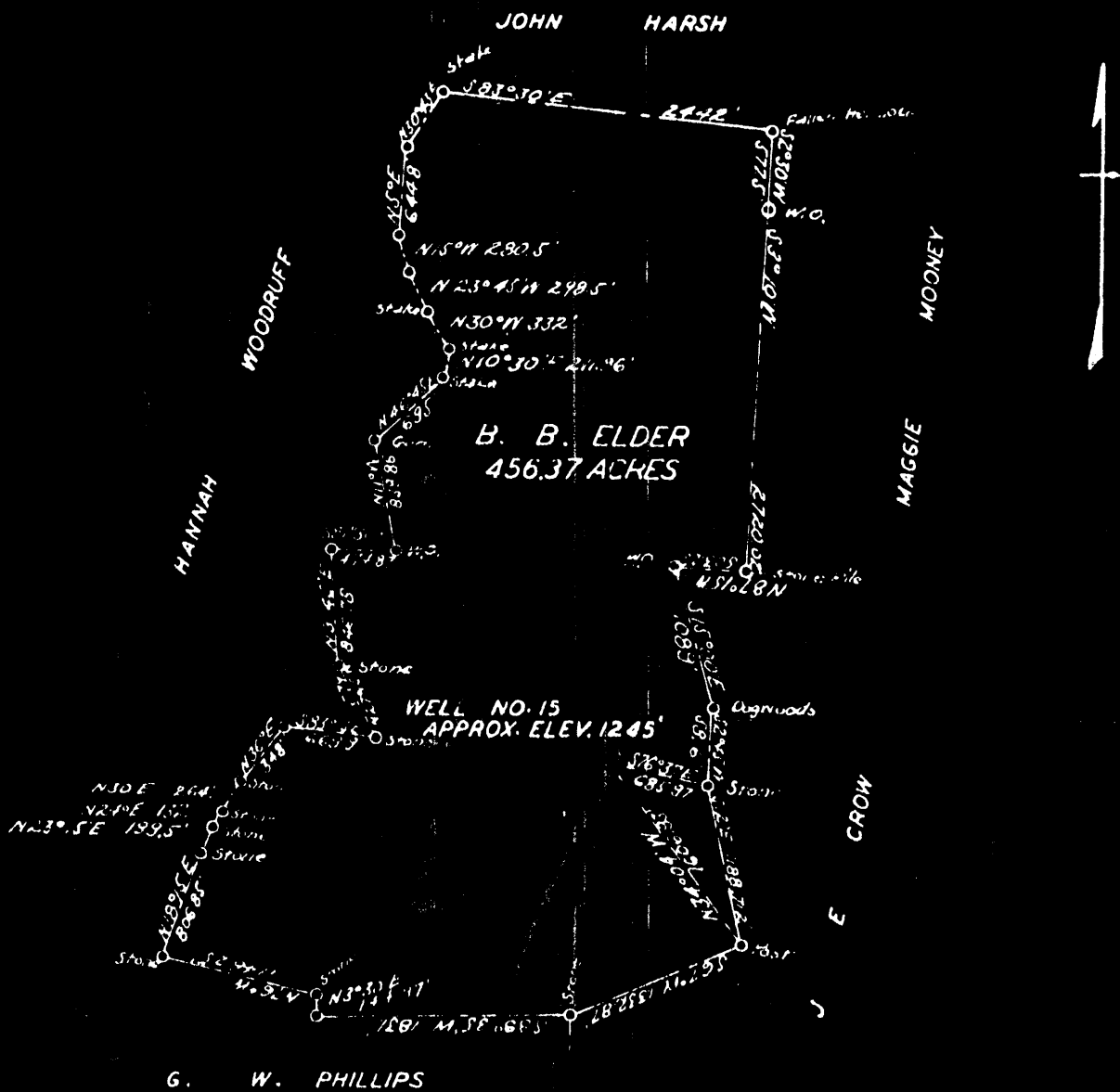
