



YEARSLEY being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Consolidation Coal Company well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 3RD of August, 2020, Year and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

Pumped 105 gallons of Expandable Cement from 50' to Surface. Cement did circulate at surface. Pumped a total of 1,554 gallons or 127.6% of the total calculated volume. 
