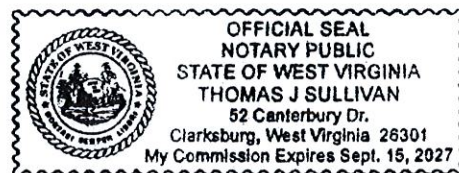

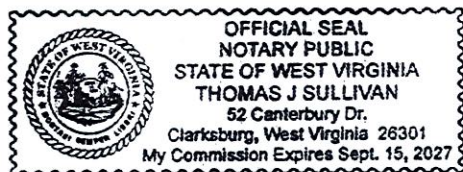

MATTHEW A. YEARSLEY and KEVIN S. WRIGHT being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by West Virginia Land Resources Inc well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 8th day of May, 2023 and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

Sand or Zone Record Formation	Filling Material	Casing/Tubing Size	Casing Pulled	Casing Left In
Attempted to remove 7" casing by pulling 150% of string weight. All attempts were unsuccessful. Tagged solid plug at 973'. Set bottom hole cement plug from 973' to 876' with 25 sacks of Thixotropic Cement. Tagged plug at 876'. Set 7" packer at 376' and pumped 7,392 gallons of lateral flow cement or 224% of the total calculated volume into the laterals, through the coal seam, access hole to bridge plug, production hole from bottom hole plug to packer until cement was visible at all four packers. Released 7" packer and cemented the hole from 376' to the surface with 70 sacks of Expandable Cement. Cement did circulate at the surface. Left 993.9' of 7" casing from the surface to 993.9' with 7" Fiberglass from 778' to 836' through the Pittsburgh Coal Seam (818.7' - 824.2'). Left 421.8' of 9 5/8" casing in the hole from the surface to 421.8'. Left 42' of 13 3/8" conductor pipe in the hole from the surface to 42'.		7" Steel Casing	0'	778'
