Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas Inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days of completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

PERMIT CONDITIONS 47 0 5 1 0 1 1

West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d) allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. <u>Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.</u>

CONDITIONS

- 1. This proposed activity may require permit coverage from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). Through this permit, you are hereby being advised to consult with USACE regarding this proposed activity.
- 2. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6A-5a (12), which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than one hundred (100) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 3. When compacting fills, each lift before compaction shall not be more than 12 inches in height, and the moisture content of the fill material shall be within limits as determined by the Standard Proctor Density test of the actual soils used in specific engineered fill, ASTM D698, Standard Test Method for Laboratory Compaction Characteristics of Soil Using Standard Effort, to achieve 95 % compaction of the optimum density. Each lift shall be tested for compaction, with a minimum of two tests per lift per acre of fill. All test results shall be maintained on site and available for review.
- 4. Operator shall install signage per § 22-6A-8g (6) (B) at all source water locations included in their approved water management plan within 24 hours of water management plan activation.
- 5. Oil and gas water supply wells will be registered with the Office of Oil and Gas and all such wells will be constructed and plugged in accordance with the standards of the Bureau for Public Health set forth in its Legislative rule entitled *Water Well Regulations*, 64 C.S.R. 19. Operator is to contact the Bureau of Public Health regarding permit requirements. In lieu of plugging, the operator may transfer the well to the surface owner upon agreement of the parties. All drinking water wells within fifteen hundred feet of the water supply well shall be flow tested by the operator upon request of the drinking well owner prior to operating the water supply well.
- 6. Pursuant to the requirements pertaining to the sampling of domestic water supply wells/springs the operator shall, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of analytical data provide a written copy to the Chief and any of the users who may have requested such analyses.
- 7. 24 hours prior to the initiation of the completion process the operator shall notify the Chief or his designee.
- 8. During the completion process the operator shall monitor annular pressures and report any anomaly noticed to the chief or his designee immediately.
- 9. If any explosion or other accident causing loss of life or serious personal injury occurs in or about a well or well work on a well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the explosion or accident, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief, within 24 hours of said accident.
- 10. During the casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within 24 hours.

ORDER ISSUED UNDER WEST VIRGINIA CODE, CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE 6A

INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter "Order") is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter "OOG"), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of W. Va. Code §§ 22-1-1, 22-6-1 and 22-6A-1 et seq. to Chevron Appalachia, LLC (hereinafter "Operator"), collectively the "Parties."

FINDINGS OF THE CHIEF

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

- 1. OOG, an office within the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection, is the agency with the duty and authority to execute and enforce W. Va. Code §22-6-1 and §22-6A-1 et seq., and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 2. Chevron Appalachia, LLC is a "person" as defined by W. Va. Code §22-6-1(n), with a corporate address as P.O. Box 611, Moon Township, Pennsylvania.
- 3. On December 1, 2016, Chevron Appalachia, LLC submitted well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01903 and 47-051-01904. Then on January 24,2017, Chevron Appalachia, LLC also submitted well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01914, 47-051-01916 and 47-051-01917. The five proposed wells are to be located on the Longworth Pad in Clay District of Marshall County, West Virginia.
- 4. On December 1, 2016 and January 24, 2017, Chevron Appalachia, LLC requested a waiver for Wetlands 2A, 2B, 3, 4B and 4D outlined in Attachment 1, from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01903, 47-051-01904, 47-051-01914, 47-051-01916 and 47-051-01917. Wetland 2A and 4D will be excluded from this waiver. Wetland 2A will be covered under the 404-permit due to its impact. Wetland 4D is outside the area of the pad LOD.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. West Virginia Code §22-1-6(d) requires, in part, that "[i]n addition to other powers, duties and responsibilities granted and assigned to the secretary by this chapter, the secretary is authorized and empowered to...(3) Enter private lands to make surveys and inspections for environmental protection purposes; to investigate for violations of statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing; to serve and execute warrants and processes; to make arrests; issue orders, which for the purposes of this chapter include consent agreements; and to otherwise enforce the statutes or rules which the Office of Oil and Gas is charged with enforcing."
- 2. West Virginia Code §22-6A-2(a)(6) requires, in part, that "Concomitant with the broad powers to condition the issuance of well work permits, the secretary should also have broad authority to waive certain minimum requirements of this article when, in his or her discretion, such waiver is appropriate: *Provided*, That the secretary shall submit a written report of the number of waivers granted to the Legislature commencing January 1, 2013, and each year thereafter."
- 3. West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the Office of Oil and Gas shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring. The Office of Oil and Gas may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary."

ORDER

West Virginia Code §22-6A-12(b) requires, in part, that "[n]o well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland. The Office of Oil and Gas grants the request for a waiver for Wetlands 2B, 3 and 4B from well location restriction requirements in W. Va. Code §22-6A-12(b) for the well work permit applications identified as API#s 47-051-01903, 47-051-01904, 47-051-01914, 47-051-01916 and 47-051-01917. The Office of Oil and Gas hereby **ORDERS** that Chevron Appalachia, LLC shall meet the following site construction and operational requirements for the Longworth Well Pad:

- a. A berm shall be constructed around the perimeter of the pad to contain any potential spills and storm water runoff. Berm is to be at least twenty-four inches (24") in height;
- b. Erosion control blankets shall be installed on all slopes and down gradient locations of the pad as erosion and sediment controlling BMPs;
- c. Wetland 2B, 3 and 4B shall have both a compost filter sock trap and a thirty-two (32") compost filter sock to prevent sediment from reaching the wetlands.
- d. Disturbed areas not used for operations shall be seeded and mulched per the seeding tables in the WVDEP-OOG Erosion and Sediment Control Manual;
- e. Drill cuttings and associated drilling mud shall be disposed of in a permitted landfill;
- f. Waste generated by the flowback treatment systems shall be sent to offsite disposal at a permitted landfill;
- g. Weekly site inspections shall be conducted to monitor and maintain the integrity of the BMP storm water controls;
- h. Weekly storm water and spill prevention inspections shall be conducted focusing on storm water and spill prevention BMPs and maintenance of these BMPs;
- i. Inspections of the storm water and spill prevention measures shall be conducted after any major storm event defined as a half inch (½") rain within any twenty-four (24) hour period;
- j. Pad inspections shall be conducted no less than once a week to identify and mitigate potential deficiencies:
- k. All records from inspections shall be maintained on site for the life of the project and be available upon request.

1.0 INTRODUCTON

On behalf of Chevron Appalachia, LLC (Chevron), Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc. (CEC) is submitting a Wetland and Perennial Stream Waiver Request form pursuant to Chapter 22 Article 6A Section 12 of the West Virginia Code. Chevron is requesting a waiver for five (5) wetlands which lie within 100 feet of the limits of disturbance (LOD) of the proposed Longworth Well Site Project located in Clay District, Marshall County, West Virginia.

Chevron is proposing to construct a natural gas well pad and associated access driveway. The total LOD for the project is approximately 38 acres. The waiver request form is included as Attachment A. The following figures are included as Attachment B: Site Location Map, Aquatics Impact Map, and Wetland Waiver Request Figure. The Erosion and Sediment Control (E&S) Plans are included as Attachment C. Existing wetlands and streams were delineated by CEC ecological professionals on April 22, 2016. The following section provides additional information as required by the waiver.

2.0 WETLAND WAIVER REQUEST

Question 1: Describe the proposed project location, including unique identifying names of all wetlands, and the names of perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.

The proposed Longworth Well Site Project is located off of Roberts Ridge Saint Joseph Road along Spindle Lane in Clay District, Marshall County, West Virginia near the town of Rosbys Rock, as shown on the Site Location Map included in Attachment B. The project's proposed LOD is located within 100 feet of five (5) wetlands, as shown on the Aquatic Impacts Map also included in Attachment B. The approximate distance of each wetland to the nearest boundary of the LOD is as follows:

- Wetland 2A 0 linear feet;
- Wetland 2B 4 linear feet;
- Wetland 3 71 linear feet;
- Wetland 4B 18 linear feet; and
- Wetland 4D 34 linear feet.

No perennial streams are located within 100 feet of the project LOD. A waiver is not being requested for the wetlands and intermittent/ephemeral streams located within the LOD, including: Wetlands 1A, 1B, 2A, 2C and UNTs 1, 2, 3, and 6 to Grave Creek. Chevron is requesting authorization from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Pittsburgh District for impacts to these features. The Pre-construction Notification and Authorization request submittal to the USACE for these impacts is included in Attachment D.

Question 2: Justify the proposed activity by describing alternatives to this project that were considered.

a. Include a No-Action Alternative as to show "the future without the project".

The No-Action alternative represents "no alteration" of the existing environment, meaning the site would not be developed and no immediate environmental impacts would occur. Oil and gas extraction would not occur at this site, and Chevron would be required to find an alternative site. This option is highly undesirable and would not fulfill the project's purpose and need.

b. Location alternatives must be shown.

Due to the size of the proposed well pad, the steep topography of the surrounding area, existing residences, and the location of a subsurface coal boundary, the current location of the Longworth Well Pad is the primary location desired by Chevron. Minor adjustments to the dimensions of the proposed well pad were made during the conceptual planning phase of the project; however, the current location of the well pad has remained unchanged due to the limitations listed above. The size of the well pad is optimized for the extraction and production equipment that will be set on the well pad. As such, minimizing the dimensions of the well pad beyond the dimensions provided is not feasible. The location of the well pad and LOD are shown on Figure 3 – Wetland Waiver Request Figure provided in Attachment B.

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c. Must demonstrate why a one hundred foot buffer cannot be maintained.

Maintaining a 100-foot buffer from all on-site wetlands is not feasible due to topographic constraints, location of the existing features, and landowner constraints. The five (5) wetlands that are located within 100 feet of the LOD are located on the southern side of the proposed well pad. In order to maintain a 100-foot buffer from the five (5) wetlands, the well pad would need to shift north, which would have greater permanent impacts to existing streams located on the northern side of the well pad. The current site layout permanently impacts the least amount practicable of existing stream and wetlands. In addition, a shift north would create higher fill slopes, larger toe-keys, and more earthwork. As such, shifting the proposed well pad is not feasible.

The other alternative to meet the setback requirements would be a reduction in the project's footprint, and the proposed design represents the minimum footprint required to meet the project's purpose and need. A reduction in the well pad's limits would mean the project could not be developed.

d. Describe how the proposed project is the least environmentally damaging practicable alternative.

The current proposed Longworth Well Site design represents the alternative which reduces permanent impacts to the greatest degree practicable. Shifting the proposed well pad south or north would create higher fill slopes, and more disturbance to existing streams and wetlands.

Question 3: Identify sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect waters of the state. This description should include all additional erosion and sediment control measures and devices that will be used.

As part of the well pad permitting process, E&S plans have been prepared for the Longworth Well Site project which stipulates implementations to reduce soil erosion, compaction, and sedimentation of receiving streams and wetlands. The following measures will be implemented as part of the E&S plan to protect the existing wetlands and stream:

- Compost filter sock traps will be positioned downslope of larger drainage areas and upslope of the existing wetlands and/or intermittent/ephemeral streams;
- Compost filter socks will be positioned downslope of smaller drainage areas and upslope of the existing wetlands and/or intermittent/ephemeral streams;

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- Orange construction fence will be erected along the edge of the LOD to clearly mark and help protect the wetlands from being impacted during construction operations;
- Erosion control blanket will be placed on slopes greater than 3 Horizontal to 1 Vertical (3H:1V) to limit erosion and promote vegetative growth; and
- Riprap aprons will be constructed at the outfalls of pipes to dissipate runoff.

Question 4: Proved mapping, plans, specifications and design analysis for the preferred alternative to the project.

a. Specify in writing what additional controls, measures, devices, monitoring, etc. will be used to protect wetlands and/or perennial streams for which the waiver is sought.

Refer to the E&S plans and details in Attachment C for locations of erosion control measures, specifications on installation and maintenance requirements, and the construction sequence.

- (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhead or spring.

The department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A waiver, if granted, shall impose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary.

§22-6A-12(c) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, nothing contained in this section prevents an operator from conducting the activities permitted or authorized by a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit or other approval from the United States Army Corps of Engineers within any waters of the state or within the restricted areas referenced in this section.

The center of well pads may not be located within six hundred twenty-five feet of an occupied dwelling structure, or a building two thousand five hundred square feet or larger used to house or shelter dairy cattle or poultry husbandry. This limitation is applicable to those wells, developed springs, dwellings or agricultural buildings that existed on the date a notice to the surface owner of planned entry for surveying or staking as provided in section ten of this article or a notice of intent to drill a horizontal well as provided in subsection (b), section sixteen of this article was provided, whichever occurs first, and to any dwelling under construction prior to that date. This limitation may be waived by written consent of the surface owner transmitted to the department and recorded in the real property records maintained by the clerk of the county commission for the county in which such property is located. Furthermore, the well operator may be granted a variance by the secretary from these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan which identifies the sufficient measures, facilities or practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations. The variance, if granted, shall include terms and conditions the department requires to ensure the safety and protection of affected persons and property. The terms and conditions may include insurance, bonding and indemnification, as well as technical requirements. (b) No well pad may be prepared or well drilled within one hundred feet measured horizontally from any perennial stream, natural or artificial lake, pond or reservoir, or a wetland, or within three hundred feet of a naturally reproducing trout stream. No well pad may be located within one thousand feet of a surface or ground water intake of a public water supply. The distance from the public water supply as identified by the department shall be measured as follows: (1) For a surface water intake on a lake or reservoir, the distance shall be measured from the boundary of the lake or reservoir. (2) For a surface water intake on a flowing stream, the distance shall be measured from a semicircular radius extending upstream of the surface water intake. (3) For a groundwater source, the distance shall be measured from the wellhouse spring the department may, in its discretion, waive these distance restrictions upon submission of a plan identifying sufficient measures, defining of practices to be employed during well site construction, drilling and operations to protect the waters of the state. A water, if granted, slabingpose any permit conditions as the secretary considers necessary. (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, nothing contained in this section provisions are conductions as the secretary considers necessary. in this section prevents an operator from conducting the activities permitted or authorized by a Clean Water Act Section 404 permit or other approval from the United States Army Corps of Engineers within any waters of the state or within the restricted areas referenced in this section. (d) The well location restrictions set forth in this section shall not apply to any well on a multiple well pad if at least one of the wells was permitted prior to the effective date of this article. (e) The secretary shall, by December 31, 2012, report to the Legislature on the noise, light, dust and volatile organic compounds generated by the drilling of horizontal wells as they relate to the well location restrictions regarding occupied dwelling structures pursuant to this section. Rebuttable Presumption for Contamination or Deprivation of a Fresh Water Source or Supply:

W. Va. Code § 22-6A-18 requires that (b) unless rebutted by one of the defenses established in subsection (c) of this section, in any action for contamination or deprivation of a fresh water source or supply within one thousand five hundred feet of the center of the well pad for horizontal well, there is a rebuttable presumption that the drilling and the oil or gas well or either was the proximate cause of the contamination or deprivation of the fresh water source or supply. (c) In order to rebut the presumption of liability established in subsection (b) of this section, the operator must prove by a preponderance of the evidence one of the following defenses: (1) The pollution existed prior to the drilling or alteration activity as determined by a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (2) The landowner or water purveyor refused to allow the operator access to the property to conduct a predrilling or prealteration water well test. (3) The water supply is not within one thousand five hundred feet of the well. (4) The pollution occurred more than six months after completion of drilling or alteration activities. (5) The pollution occurred as the result of some cause other than the drilling or alteration activity. (d) Any operator electing to preserve its defenses under subdivision (1), subsection (c) of this section shall retain the services of an independent certified laboratory to conduct the predrilling or prealteration water well test. A copy of the results of the test shall be submitted to the department and the surface owner or water purveyor in a manner prescribed by the secretary. (e) Any operator shall replace the water supply of an owner of interest in real property who obtains all or part of that owner's supply of water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other legitimate use from an underground or surface source with a comparable water supply where the secretary determines that the water supply has been affected by contamination, diminution or interruption proximately caused by the oil or gas operation, unless waived in writing by that owner. (f) The secretary may order the operator conducting the oil or gas operation to: (1) Provide an emergency drinking water supply within twenty-four hours; (2) Provide temporary water supply within seventy-two hours; (3) Within thirty days begin activities to establish a permanent water supply or submit a proposal to the secretary outlining the measures and timetables to be used in establishing a permanent supply. The total time in providing a permanent water supply may not exceed two years. If the operator demonstrates that providing a permanent replacement water supply cannot be completed within two years, the secretary may extend the time frame on case-by-case basis; and (4) Pay all reasonable costs incurred by the real property owner in securing a water supply. (g) A person as described in subsection (b) of this section aggrieved under the provisions of subsections (b), (e) or (f) of this section may seek relief in court... Permit Denial or Condition

The Chief has the power to deny or condition a well work permit. Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d), the permit may not be issued or be conditioned, including conditions with respect to the location of the well and access roads prior to issuance if the director determines that:

- (1) The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons;
- (2) The plan for soil erosion and sediment control is not adequate or effective;
- (3) Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources; or
- (4) The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies.

A permit may also be denied under West Virginia Code § 22-6A-7(k), the secretary shall deny the issuance of a permit if the secretary determines that the applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previously issued permit for a horizontal well, including the applicable erosion and sediment control plan associated with the previously issued permit, or a substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under this article, and in each instance has failed to abate or seek review of the violation within the time prescribed by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2), subsection (a), section five of this article and the rules promulgated hereunder, which time may not be unreasonable.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code § 22-6A-10(g), any person entitled to submit written comments to the secretary pursuant to subsection (a), section eleven of this article, shall also be entitled to receive from the secretary a copy of the permit as issued or a copy of the order modifying or denying the permit if the person requests receipt of them as a part of the written comments submitted concerning the permit application. Such persons may request, at the time of submitting written comments, notice of the permit decision and a list of persons qualified to test water.
