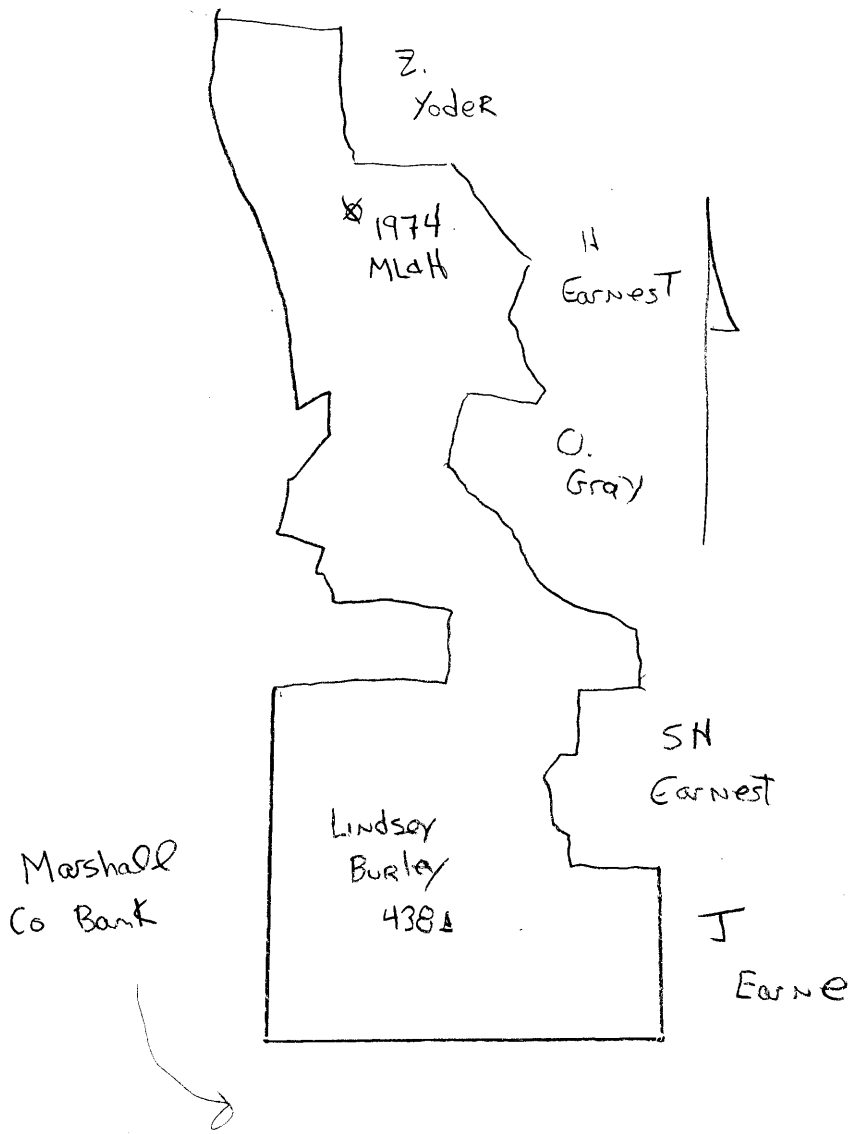

Drilled prior to June 1, 1929.

Elevation, 1360'.

16" conductor; 8 1/2" casing, 1576'; 6-5/8", 2220'; 4" tubing, 2446'.

6-5/8 x 1/2 packer set at 2418'.

Coal was encountered at 760-765, 960-965, 1055-1062' (& 700-705').

Abandonment reported to Dept. of Mines June 2nd, 1931.

Well was shot at 3056-3063 1/2', with 40 qts.
