 being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Victor E Tennant, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 15 Oct. 1929, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Filled with clay to 3107. Wood plug to 2124 Filled with Clay to 3016 Wood Plug and One sack Cement Filled with Clay to 2800. Wood Plug to 2796. Filled with Clay to 2150. Wood Plug to 2147. Drove in 100 lbs Lead Wool 2 Sacks Cement .Filled to 1800. Shot 6" Pipe off Pulled out and filled up to 1620. Put in 2 Sacks Cement . Pulled 8" and filled to 890. Cement up to 845. Filled with Clay up to 780. Cemented up to 780. Filled with Clay to 18.ft. of Surface. Filled Conductor with Stone and Cement to Surface Built Marker 30" above Surface.

Dear Mr. Tomsett:

Our records disclose that you have never filed any affidavits of plugging on any of your abandoned wells with the exception of Well No. 1, on the Lloyd Brook Farm, Box Box District, Wayne County. Some of the abandonment are as much as seven years old and about ten years ago when you were in this office, you previously advised us that you would send all this information within a short time after your return home.

The Department cannot continue to over-look your neglect in complying with the Oil and Gas laws as regards plugging, and we would appreciate receiving the affidavits within the next week or ten days to complete your records to date. A list of the affidavits to be filed are as follows:

On July 29th I wrote Mr. Victor B. Townsend outlining the conditions that were required in this contract for ten wells that in his prospect were being dug so long as seven years. A copy of this letter is sent to you.
