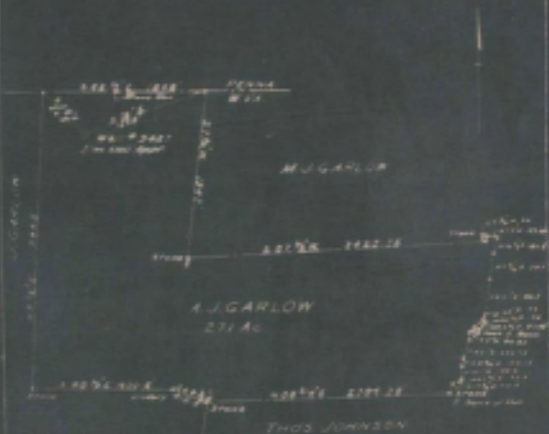

being first duly sworn, deponent to the above and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging  
and filling oil and gas wellbores and were employed by John Hester Stewart, well operator,  
and participated in the wellbore plugging and filling the above well, and said work was commenced on the  
26th day of July, 1937, at 11 AM, and that the well was plugged and filled in  
the following manner:

Manner in which well was plugged:

Filled up hole with stone sediment from 1380' to 1160'.  
Set 4-4/8" E. & E. Wood Ring set at 1160'. Filled up with stone  
and stone sediment from 1160' to 60'.

Manner in which well was plugged:

Set 12" x 6" Wellhead Vent Plug set at 60'. Connected from  
60' to top of surface, using 2" vent pipe from 60' to 2" above  
the surface.

Description of equipment:

Connected well surface with 2" pipe extending 2" above the  
surface and one 2" H.I., one 2" St. H.I., and 6' of 2" Huggles.
