being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by SOUTH FREN OIL COMPANY, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 25th day of June, 1931, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which well was plugged: Drove 3 3/16" x 8' wood plug in top of 4" x 4" Liner at 2700'; filled hole with red mud and stone from 2700' to 2705'; hole bridged at 2800'; hole filled with red mud and stone from 2800' to 2150'; drove 6 5/8" x 8' wood plug to 2150'; put in small amount of red mud on top of wood plug, then drove 3 5/8" x 8' Lead Plug to 2150'; filled hole with red mud and stone from 2150' to 2100'; drove 12" x 8' wood plug to 2100'; hole filled with red mud and stone from 2100' to 2000'; 2" vent pipe 200' long set at 2000'; Manning Glory Backer set at 2000'; vent pipe cemented in cement Manner in which well was plugged: from 2000' to 2000'; red mud and stone from 2000' to surface; vent pipe perforated from 2000' to 2000'.
