being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are acquainted with the work of plugging and filling of said well and were employed by Star Drilling Coal Co. and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

9 day of September, 1935, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which said well was plugged:

This well was filled with red sand from bottom 2175' to 2035' -  
14' below the 5-3/16" casing.  
Sweden plug was driven from 2035' to 2030'  
This was completed from 2030' to 2025'

Manner in which said well was plugged:

A permanent bridge was set at 200'  
This was cemented from 200' to 170' - 30' above the Pittsburgh Coal  
This well was filled with clay from 170' to 50' below the Berkeley Coal  
This was cemented from 30' below to 25' above the Berkeley Coal
