PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF MINES

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Hole to be filled with clay from bottom at 1875 to 1780, being 20 feet above the top of the Injun Sand. Here a wooden plug will be driven with concrete plug on top of same.

Fill solid with clay from 1780 to 1470, being 20 feet above third streak of Salt Sand. Here a wooden plug will be driven with concrete on same.

Fill solid with clay from 1470 to 1180, being 20 feet above first streak of salt sand. Here wooden plug will be driven, with concrete on same.

Fill solid with clay from 1180 to 275 feet, being approximately 10 feet below the large string of casing. Here a wooden plug will be driven with concrete on same.

From 275 feet to top of hole, fill with clay and a monument of concrete 6" square by 18" long will be set.
