WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

- Fill with red clay from 1885 to 1741
- Drive wood plug from 1741 to 1738
- Fill with cement sealing hole from 1738 to 1733
- Fill with red clay from 1733 to 1643
- Drive wood plug from 1643 to 1640
- Fill with cement from 1640 to 1635 shutting off gas and sealing hole completely.
- Fill with red clay from 1635 to 1578
- Drive wood plug from 1578 to 1575
- Fill with cement from 1575 to 1570 shutting off gas and sealing hole completely.
- Fill with red clay from 1570 to 918
- Drive wood plug from 918 to 915
- Fill with cement from 915 to 910
- Set bridge at 823
- Drive wood plug from 823 to 820
- Fill with red clay from 820 to 803
- Drive wood plug from 803 to 800
- Set permanent bridge at 200 ft. (bottom of 13" hole)
- Fill with red clay to top
- Erect permanent marker as prescribed by Mining Laws of West Virginia.
