Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

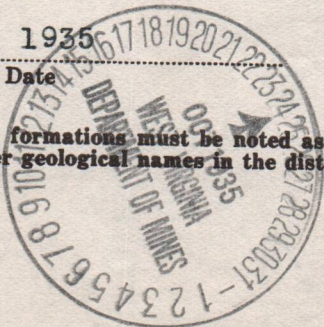

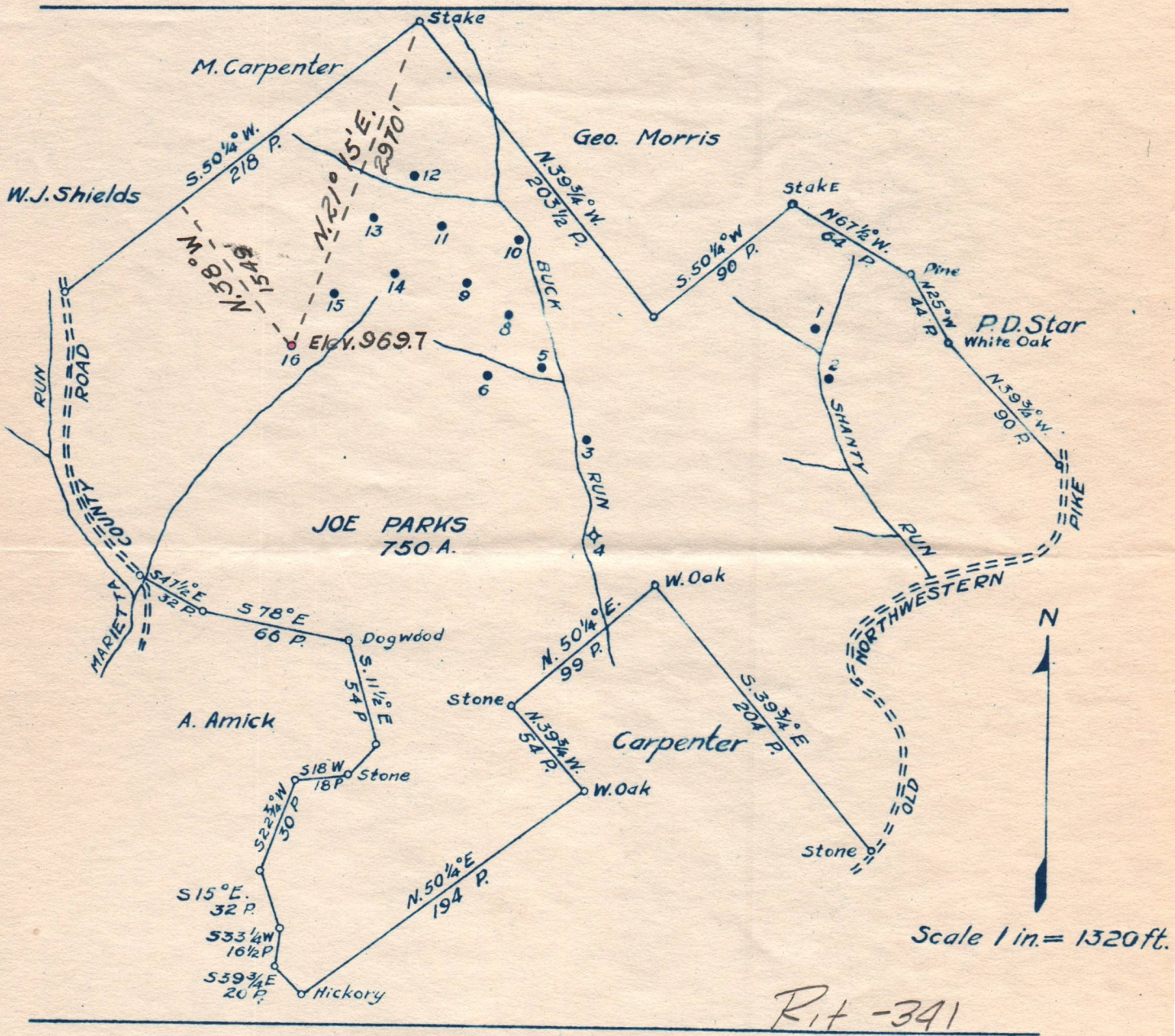

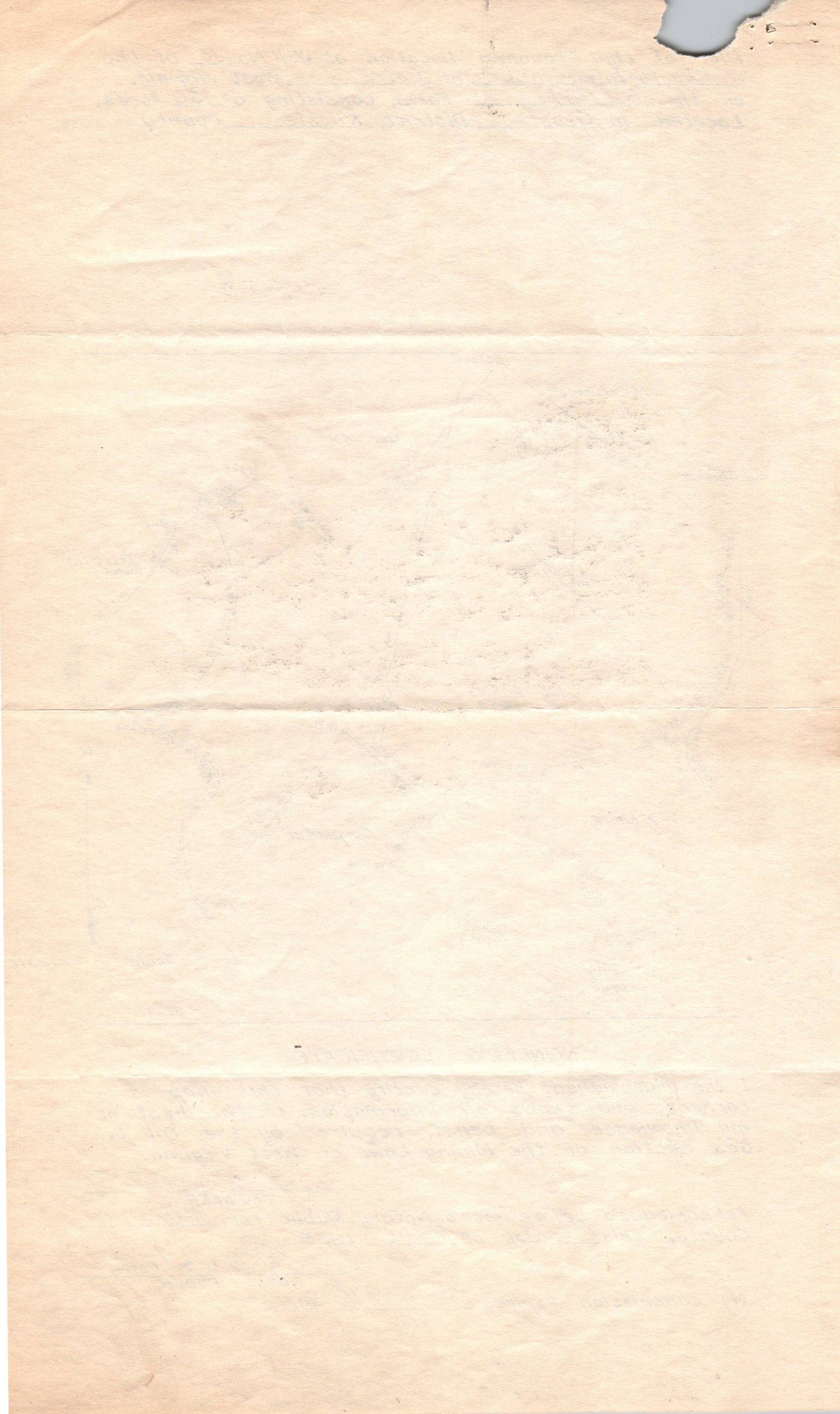

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

- Fill with red clay from 1980 to 1834.
- Pull 5 3/16" casing.
- Fill with red clay from 1834 to 1721.
- Drive wood plug from 1721 to 1718.
- Fill with cement from 1718 to 1713.
- Fill with red clay from 1713 to 1665.
- Drive wood plug from 1665 to 1662.
- fill with cement from 1662 to 1657.
- fill with red clay from 1657 to 1643.
- Drive wood plug from 1643 to 1640.
- Fill with cement from 1640 to 1635.
- Fill with red clay from 1635 to 1134.
- Pull 6 5/8" casing.
- Fill with red clay from 1134 to 1028.
- Drive wood plug from 1028 to 1025.
- Fill with cement from 1025 to 1020, plugging hole completely.
- Set permanent bridge at 315 after pulling 8 1/4" casing.
- Fill with red clay to top and erect a marker as required by the mining laws of West Virginia.

WORK ORDER REVISED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Fill with clay from the bottom 1980' to 1850' - 16' below the 5-3/16" casing  
 Drive wood plug from 1850' to 1847'  
 Cement from 1847' to 1837' sealing the hole in the Big Injun Sand.

PULL 5-3/16" casing set at 1834' and Fill with clay to 1791' - 20' above the Keener Sand.  
 Drive wood plug from 1791' to 1788'  
 SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1694' - 30' below the Maxon Sand in the Little Lime and  
 Fill with clay to 1615' - 20' above the Maxon Sand.  
 Drive wood plug from 1615' to 1612'  
 Cement from 1612' to 1602' sealing the hole above the Maxon Sand.

Fill with clay from 1602' to 1138' - 4' below the 6-5/8" casing and Drive wood plug to 1135'  
 PULL 6-5/8" casing set at 1134' and  
 Fill with clay from 1134' 1028' - Cement from 1028' to 1018'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 325' - 10' below the 8-1/4" casing  
 Drive wood plug from 325' to 322' and Cement from 322' to 315' \* PULL 8-1/4" casing set at 315'  
 Fill with red clay from 315' to the surface and

To the Department of Mines,  
 Coal Owner or Operator,  
 Lease or Property Owner.

Erect a marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulation

Gentlemen:

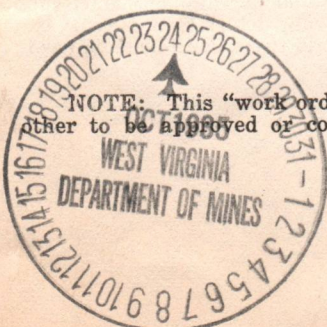
