The enclosed plat was prepared by a competent engineer and shows the proposed location of a well to be drilled for oil and gas by the undersigned well operator on the farm and in the Magisterial District and County above named, determined by survey and courses and distances from two permanent points, or land marks.

The undersigned well operator is informed and believes there are no coal operators operating beds of coal beneath said farm or tract of land on which said well is located, or within 500 feet of the boundaries of the same, who have mapped their workings and filed their maps as required by law, excepting the coal operators or coal owners (if any) above named as addressees.

The above named coal operators or coal owners (if any) are notified that any objections they may desire to make to such proposed location, or which they are required to make by Section 3 of said Act, if the drilling of a well at said proposed location will cause a dangerous condition in or about their respective coal mines, must be received by, or filed with the Department of Mines within ten* days from the receipt of a copy of this notice and accompanying plat by said Department. Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

You are further notified that whether you are represented or not represented the undersigned will proceed on that date, or shortly thereafter, to plug and fill said well in the manner required by Section 10, Article 4, Chapter 22 of the Code and given in detail on the reverse side of this notice, in "Work Order."

PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Bottom of Well 1877 $\frac{1}{2}$ '

Fill well from the bottom 1877' with red clay to 1772' - 20' above the Big Injun
Drive wood plug from 1772' to 1769'
Cement from 1769' to 1759' sealing the Big Injun Sand.

Continue to fill with red clay from 1759' to 1730' - 5' below the 6-5/8" casing/
PULL casing and (drive plug 1730-1727')

Continue to fill with red clay to 1545' - 20' above the Maxon Sand.
Drive wood plug from 1545' to 1542'
Cement from 1542' to 1532' sealing the hole completely

Continue to fill with red clay from 1532' to 1445' - 20' above the Gas Sand.
Drive wood plug from 1445' to 1442'
Cement from 1442' to 1432' sealing the Gas Sand.

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 940' 930' below the 8-1/4" casing
1 sack of cement on top of bridge
Fill with red clay from 940' to 889' - 20' above the Big Dunkard Sand.
Drive wood plug from 889' to 886'
Cement from 886' to 876' sealing the well above the Big Dunkard

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 800'
1 sack of cement on top of bridge.

Continue to fill with red clay from 800' to the surface and

Erect a marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.
