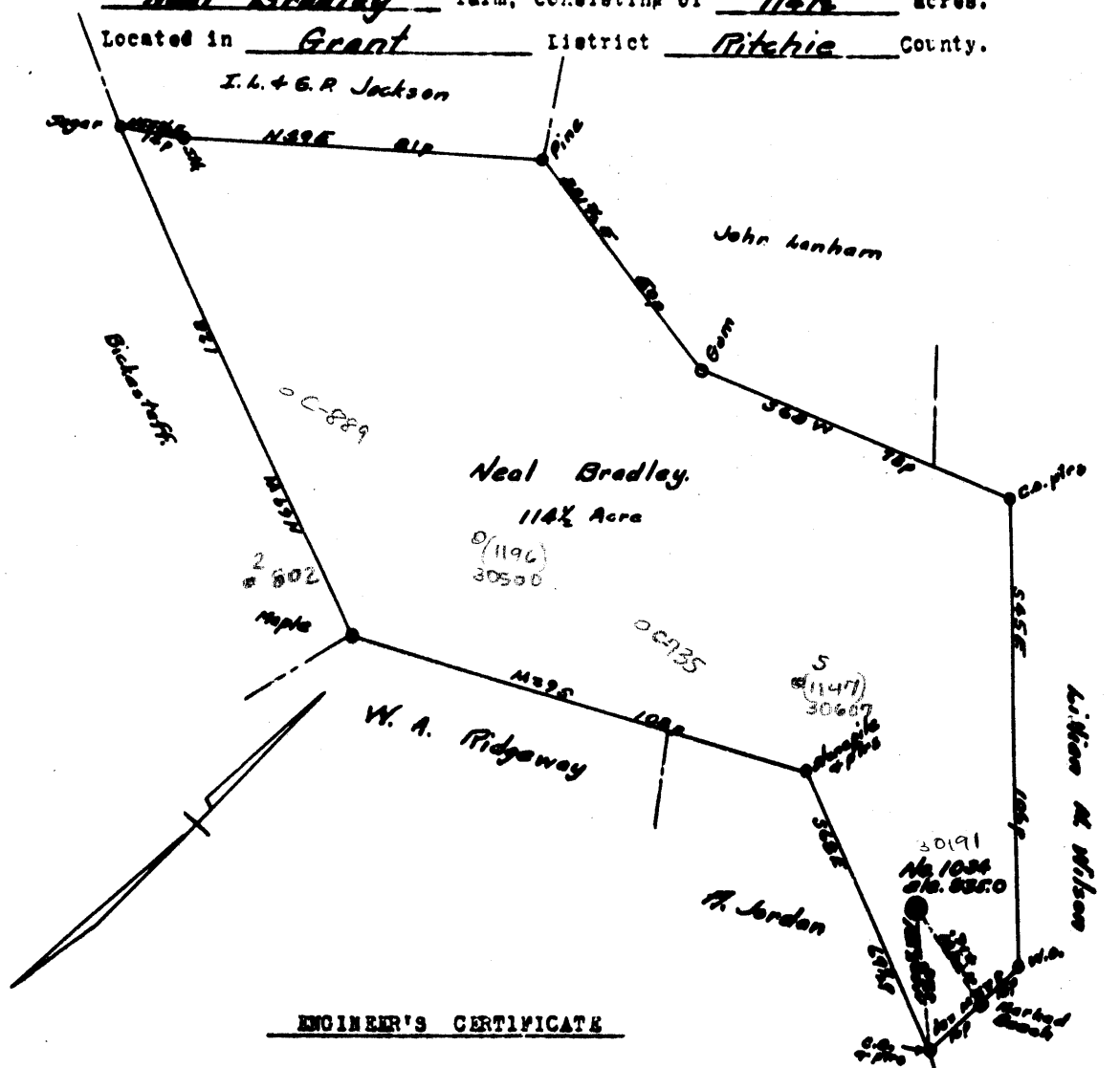


Plat of the Proposed Abandonment of Well No. 1034 of the
