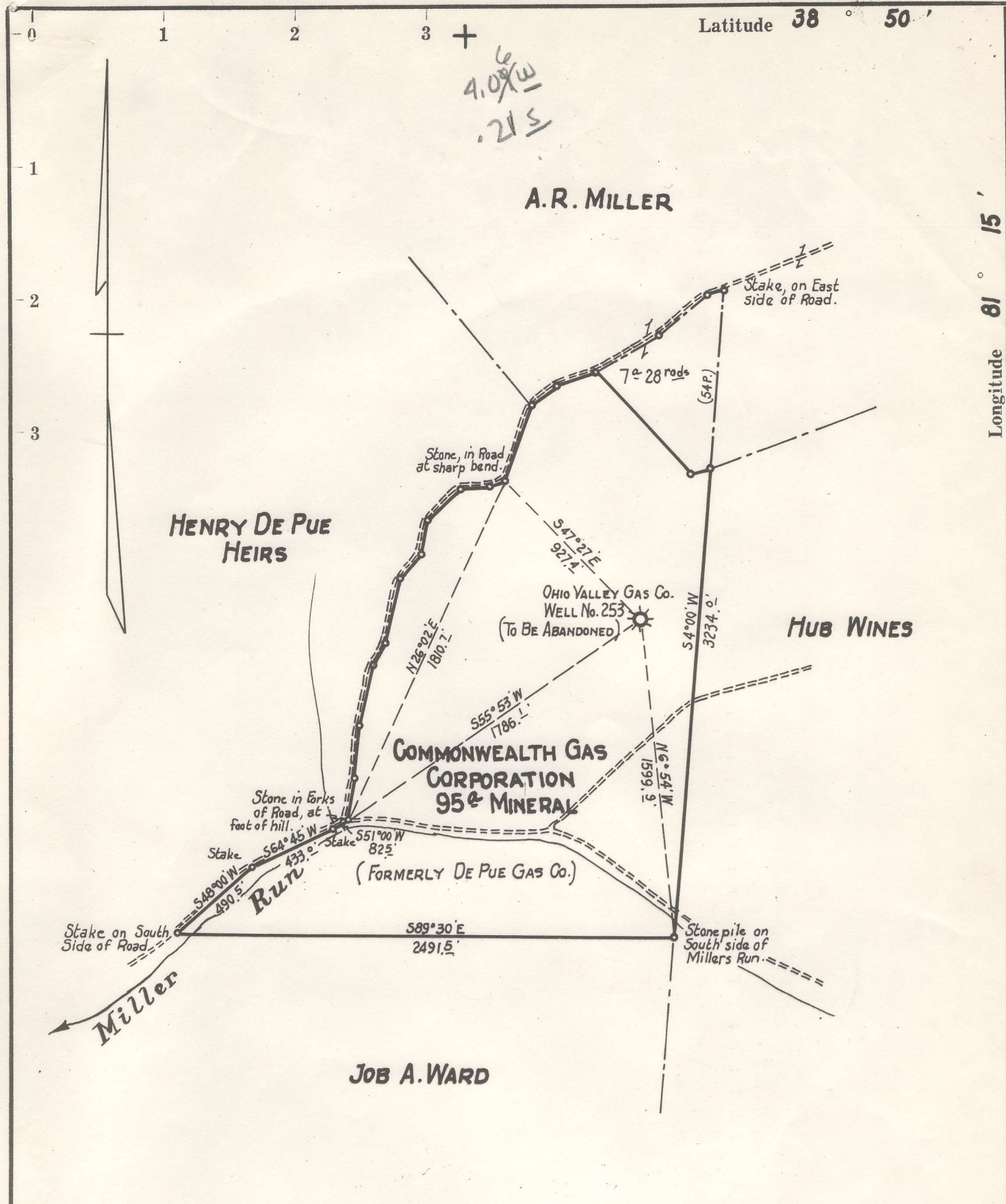

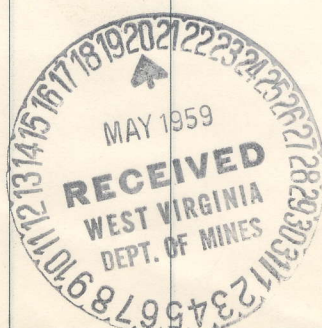

Note: This well was drilled January 31, 1916, by DePue Gas Company. This well and the property on which it is located was deeded to Godfrey L. Cabot on August 9, 1920. This property was later acquired by Ohio Valley Gas Company, the predecessors of Commonwealth Gas Corporation. The well was assigned to Romeo V. Miller on October 27, 1958. This log is not complete, but is the only one available. There is a note on the original log which states, "Well as packed on 3 inch tubing and packer set at 2550, May, 1922, casing absolutely tight, also tubing tight."
