"The well starts about 180 feet above the horizon of the Washington Coal, or 650 feet above the Pittsburgh bed. Both the Big Injun and Berea Sands appear poor in this region. The great sand mass at 560 feet seems to be a combination of both the Sewickley (Rock Creek) and Upper Pittsburgh Sandstones."
