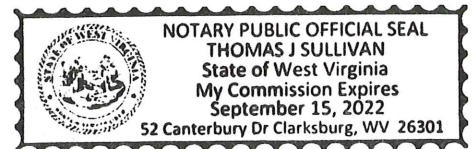

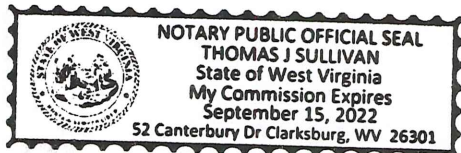

WRIGHT being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by ICG Tygart Valley, LLC well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 2nd day of March, 2021 and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

Removed 4180' of 1 1/2" tubing from the surface to 4180'. Cleaned a 3 3/4" hole through the 4 1/2" casing from the surface to 4245'. Tagged solid plug at 4245'. Cemented bottom hole with 185 sacks of Expandable Cement with a gas blocker additive from 4245' to 1360'. Removed 1360' of 4 1/2" casing from surface to 1360'. Left 3042' of 4 1/2" casing in the hole from 1360' to 4392'. Cleaned a 7 7/8" hole from the surface to 1360'. Tagged bottom hole cement plug at 1360'. Section milled window in 8 5/8" casing through the Lower Kittanning Coal Seam (520' - 528') from 510' to 538'. Left 510' of 8 5/8" casing in the hole from the surface to 510' and 611' from 538' to 1149' due to extreme cement bond on the 8 5/8" casing. No additional perforations or rips were required per the Leer Mine 101C Petition. All casing depths were taken from previous well records. Cemented hole from 1360' to surface as follows: From 1360' to 928' with 105 sacks of Expandable Cement. From 928' to 315' with 185 sacks of Thixotropic Cement with Green Dye. From 315' to surface with 95 sacks of Expandable Cement. Cement did circulate at surface. A total of 570 sacks of cement were used to fill the well 4245' to surface. Left 5' of 16" conductor pipe in the well at surface.
