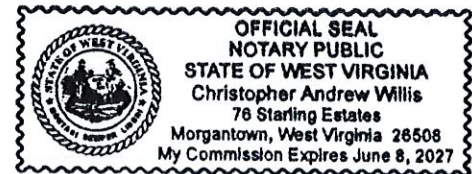

MATTHEW A. YEARSLEY and KEVIN S. WRIGHT being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by ICG Tygart Valley, LLC well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 20th day of June, 2023 and that the well was plugged in the following manner:

	Cleaned a 3 3/4" through existing 4 1/2" casing from the surface to 5350'. Existing perforations were located at 2510', 3070', 3090' 4,070', 4170', 4970', 5260' and 5270'. Cemented the bottom hole from 5350' to 1800' with 215 sacks of Expandable Cement with a Gas Blocker additive. Removed 1800' of 4 1/2" casing from the surface to 1800'. Due to extreme cement bonding 3580' of 4 1/2" casing was left in the hole from 1800' to 5380'. Cleaned a 7 7/8" hole from the surface to the top of the bottom hole plug at 1800'. Set intermediate cement plug from 1800' to 960' with 135 sacks of Expandable Cement. Tagged intermediate cement plug at 960'. Due to extreme cement bonding a 30' window was section milled through the Lower Kittanning Coal Seam (514.0' - 520.0') from 502' to 532'. Left 502' of 7" casing in the hole from the surface to 502' and 1318' from 532' to 1850' for a total of 1820' of 7' casing left in the hole. Due to the extreme cement bonding on the 7" casing, no additional cuts, rips or perforations were required by the Leer Mine 101C petition. Left 40.6' of 13 3/8" casing in the hole from the surface to 40.6'. 13 3/8" casing depth was taken from original well record.	4 1/2" Casing 7" Casing 13 3/8" Casing	1800' 0' 0'	3580' 1820' 40.6'

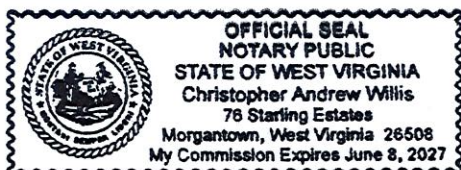
