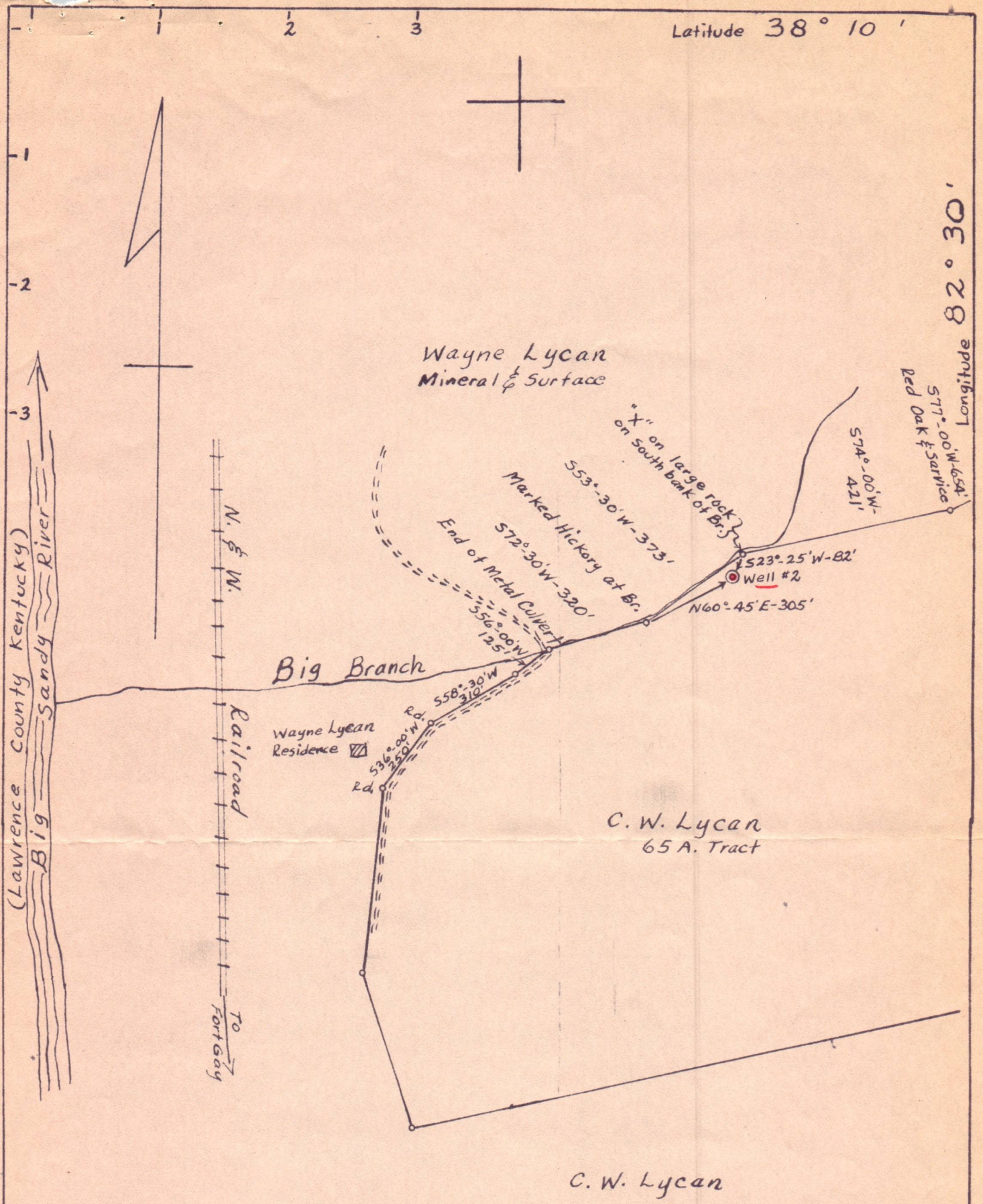

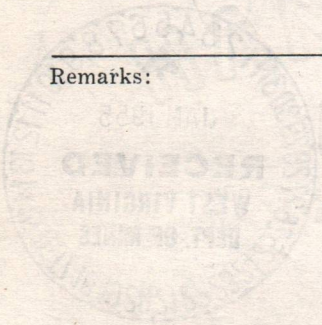

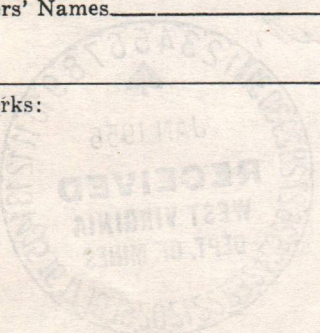

5' crushed stone on cement plug - sealing hole completely below 7"OD casing

Pull 7" casing

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 700' - a point in the Salt Sands
2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

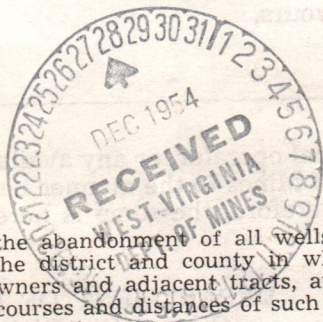

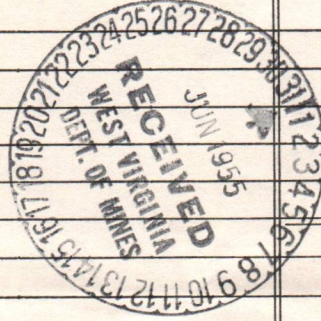

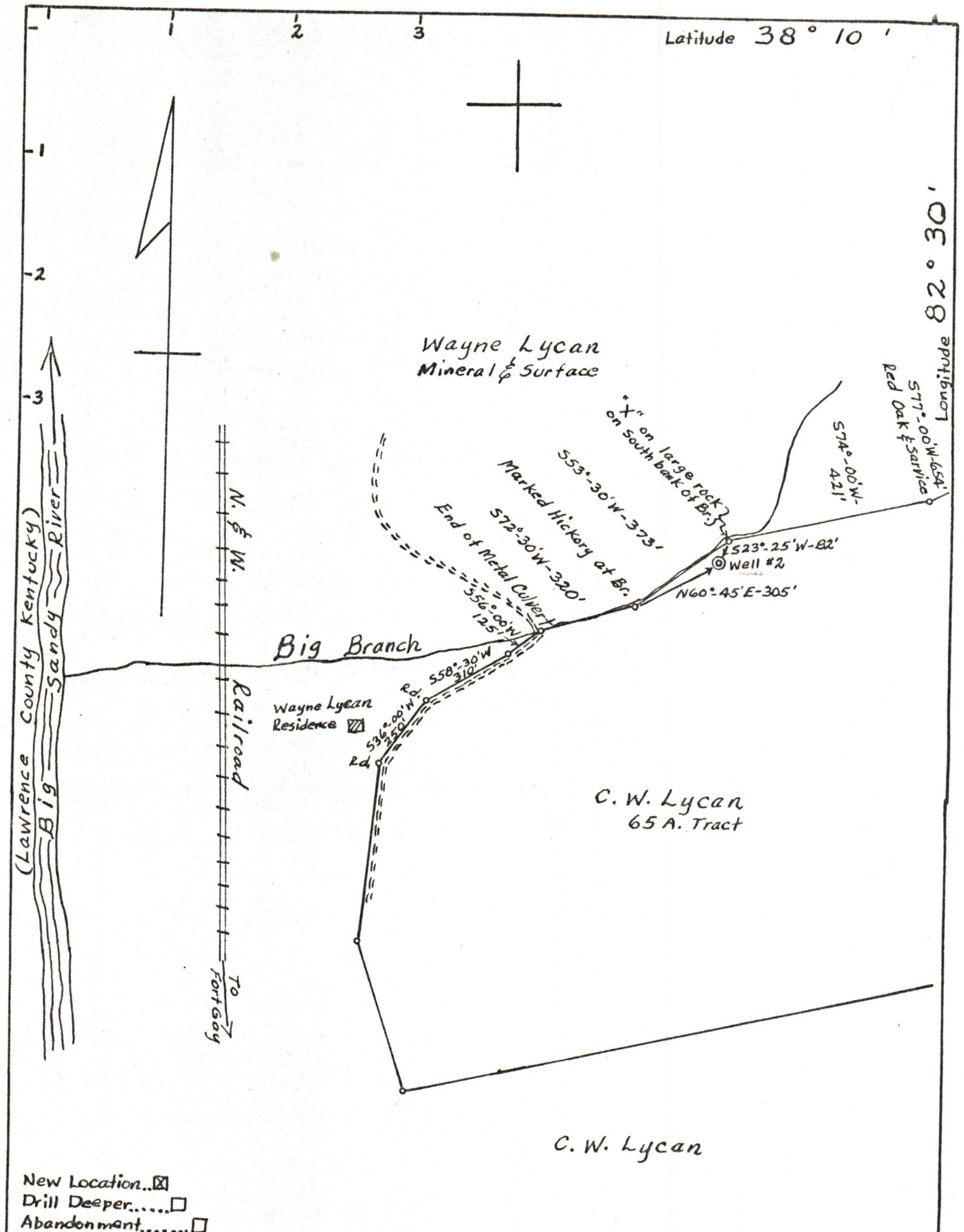
