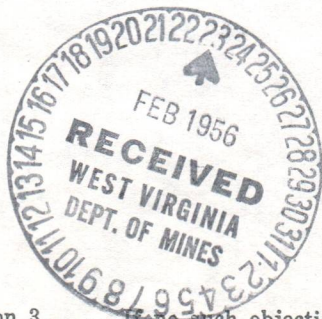

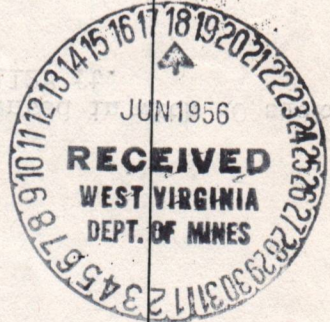

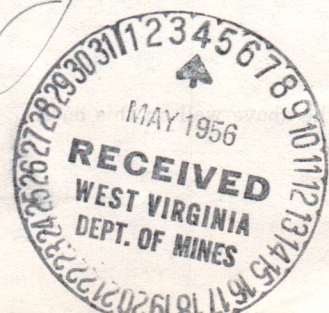

Pull 3-1/2" tubing at 1379.

Fill with clay 1379-1318.

Place 10 ft. cement plug (2½ sacks) 1318-1308.

Fill with clay 1308-1092, pulling 7" casing at 1129.

Place 10 ft. cement plug (3-1/2 sacks) 1092-1082.

Empty hole 1082-710.

Set 10 ft. rock bridge 710-700.

Fill with clay 700-600.

Place 10 ft. cement plug (3-1/2 sacks) 600-590.

Empty hole 590-350.

Pull 8-5/8" casing at 330 ft.

Set 10 ft. rock bridge 350-340.

Fill with clay 340-20.

Fill top 20 ft. of hole with concrete. In this concrete, set 6" pipe (concrete filled) extending 10 ft. below and 3 ft. above surface.

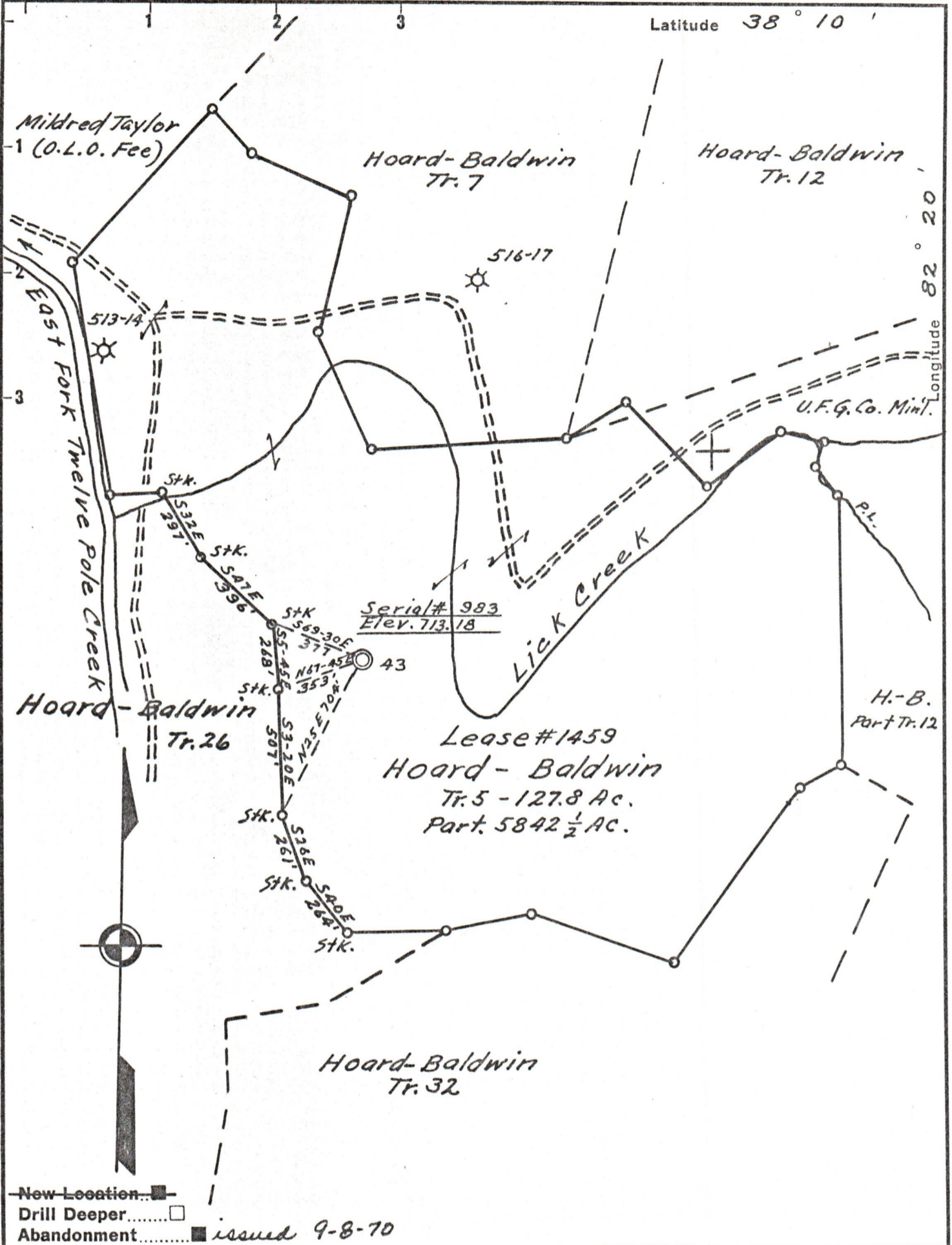
