Dear Sirs:

Will you kindly advise me the depth at which the gas well on my property near Shoals, West Virginia, was plugged. The plugging was done by Bob Adkins of Hamlin in the early part of 1957 - February or March of that year. The agreement I had with Adkins and your inspector was that the plugging be done at about 95 feet, so as to leave me a water well. It now measures 66 feet deep and has some 40 feet of water standing.

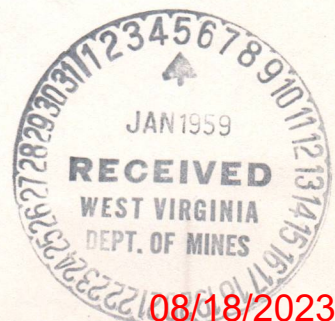
I wish this information from you so as to determine if caving has occurred since the well was plugged. I am now ready to install a pump and if caving has occurred, I wish to insert liner pipe to prevent additional damage.

Any information you may furnish me will be appreciated. Adkins does not seem to have any accurate information regarding the matter.

Dear Mrs. Griffith:

Mr. Adkins has handed me the letter which you wrote to me and addressed to him.

From where I stand it looks to me that I had better do some explaining. I have questioned Frank Woodall, the foreman on the plugging job, and this is what he says.

The well was plugged according to the work order up to forty five feet. Mr. Wofford, the owner of the property, suggested that he pay the Company for the 10'' casing and leave it in the well so he might use it as a water well for the benefit of his farm. This matter was taken up with the inspector, who was on the job at that time and he said he would go along with that. He gave his verbal consent for this change. The workmen in charge of this job failed to make any notation of this change in the work order and handed it to me as being completed according to the original work order. So I wrote up the affidavit according to the original order and they signed the same.

I hope this will explain the discrepancy. We will be glad to do whatever you suggest in this matter.

Mrs. Griffith, I hope we can get this matter settled in a satisfactorily way before I have to come into your office. I feel sure a good dressing down would be in order. I would rather do it by correspondence.

Dear Mr. Wofford:

Further information we have received of the plugging of your well is that filling and plugging was completed to within 45 feet of the surface with 28 feet of 10-inch pipe left in. This does not coincide with your information that well is 66 feet deep with 40 feet of water standing in the hole.

It appears that workmen who plugged the well are not certain how far filling reached in the well, however between your measurement and their report, it appears that there has been no caving-in of the well.

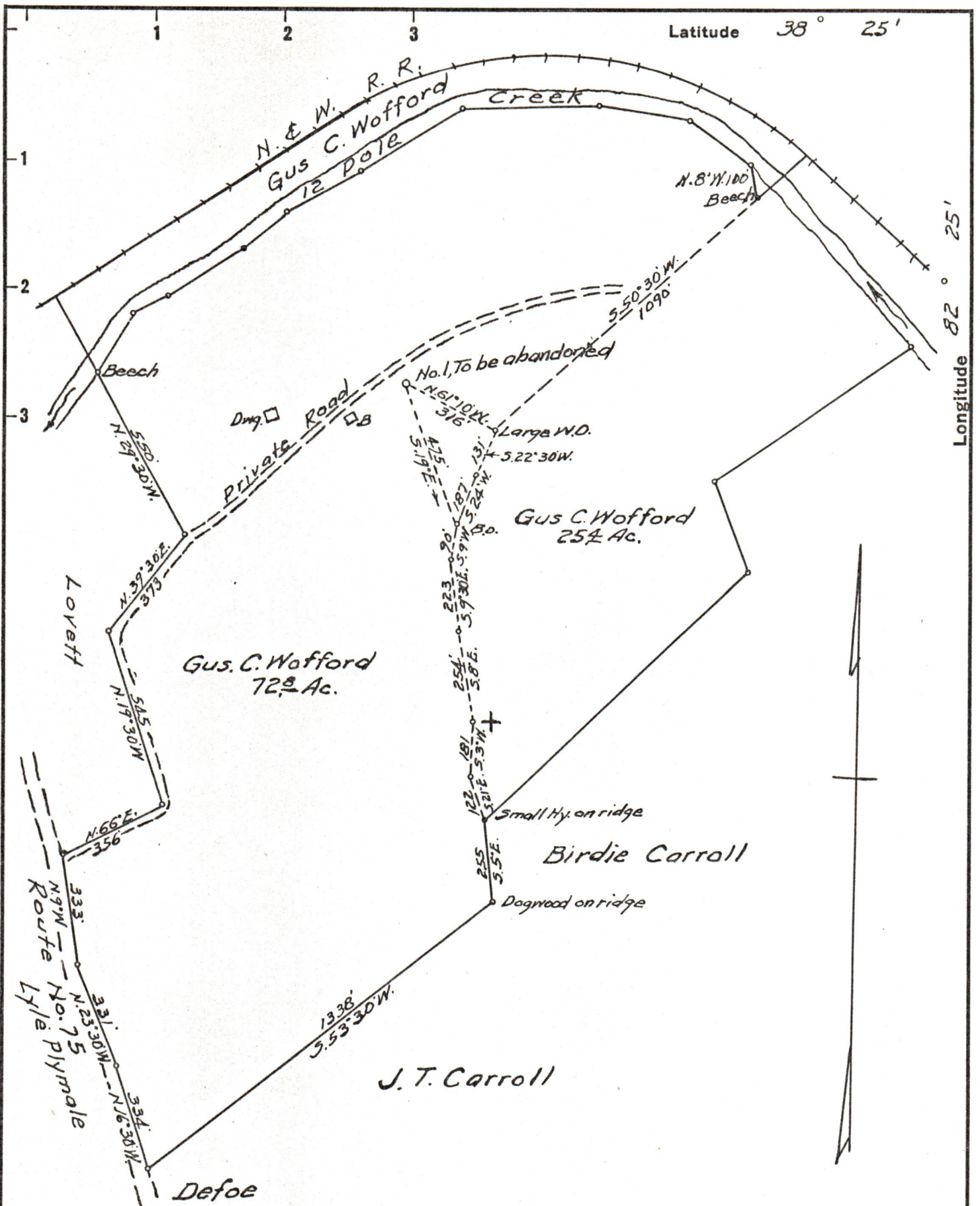
