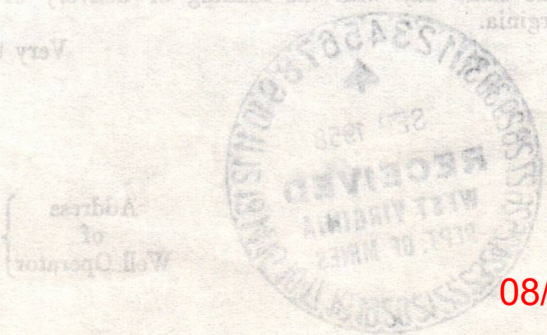

The above named coal operators or coal owners (if any) are notified that any objections they may desire to make to such proposed location, or which they are required to make by Section 3 of said Code, if the drilling of a well at said proposed location will cause a dangerous condition in or about their respective coal mines, must be received by or filed with the Department of Mines within ten days from the receipt of this notice and accompanying plat by said Department. Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

Copies of this notice and the enclosed plat were mailed by registered mail, or delivered to the above named coal operators or coal owners at their above shown respective addresses _____ days before or on the same day with the mailing or delivery of this copy to the Department of Mines at Charleston, West Virginia.

Section 3... If no such objections be filed or be found by the department or mines within said period of ten days from the receipt of said notice and plat by the department of mines to said proposed location, the department shall forthwith issue to the well operator a drilling permit, retaining the file of each plat that no objections have been made by the coal operators to the location, or found located by the department, and that the same is approved and the well operator authorized to proceed to drill at said location.

Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your affidavit of plugging Well No. 1 on Alex E. Booth, Jr Tract, Butler District, Wayne County, which does not meet the requirements of the Law.

1. It is not signed by the necessary signatures of the workmen who did the plugging.

2. It must be stated from which point to the next, the amount of fill used and kind of fill used, then a description of the plugs set and where set. If the amount of casing removed from the well is accurate on the affidavit, then these data were incorrectly given on your well record.

Please file a correct affidavit, describing in detail the manner in which the well was filled and plugged and have same signed before a notary other than yourself.

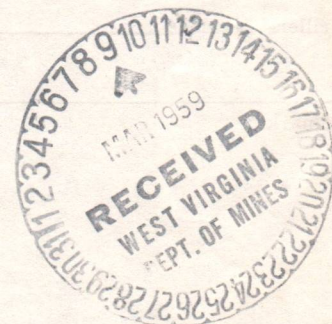

TOTAL DEPTH 1930

Fill with clay from 1930' to 1880' - 30' above Berea Grit

Neat cement 1880' - 1870'

5' crushed stone on cement, sealing off Berea Sand

Continue filling with clay to 1580' - 30' below 5-3/16" casing

Neat cement 1580' - 1570'

5' crushed stone on cement

Pull 5-3/16" casing

Continue filling with clay to 1155' - 30' below 6-5/8" casing

Neat cement 1155' - 1145'

5' crushed stone on cement, sealing hole completely below 6-5/8" casing

Pull 6-5/8" casing

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE at 850' in Salt Sands

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill with clay to 700'

Neat cement 700' - 690'

5' crushed stone on cement

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 280'

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Pull 8" casing and

Fill with Clay to surface

ERECT MARKER, In compliance with Rule 18, 1931 Regulations

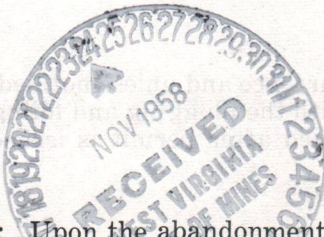

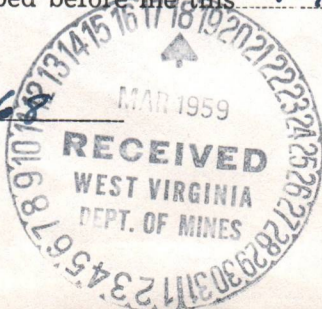

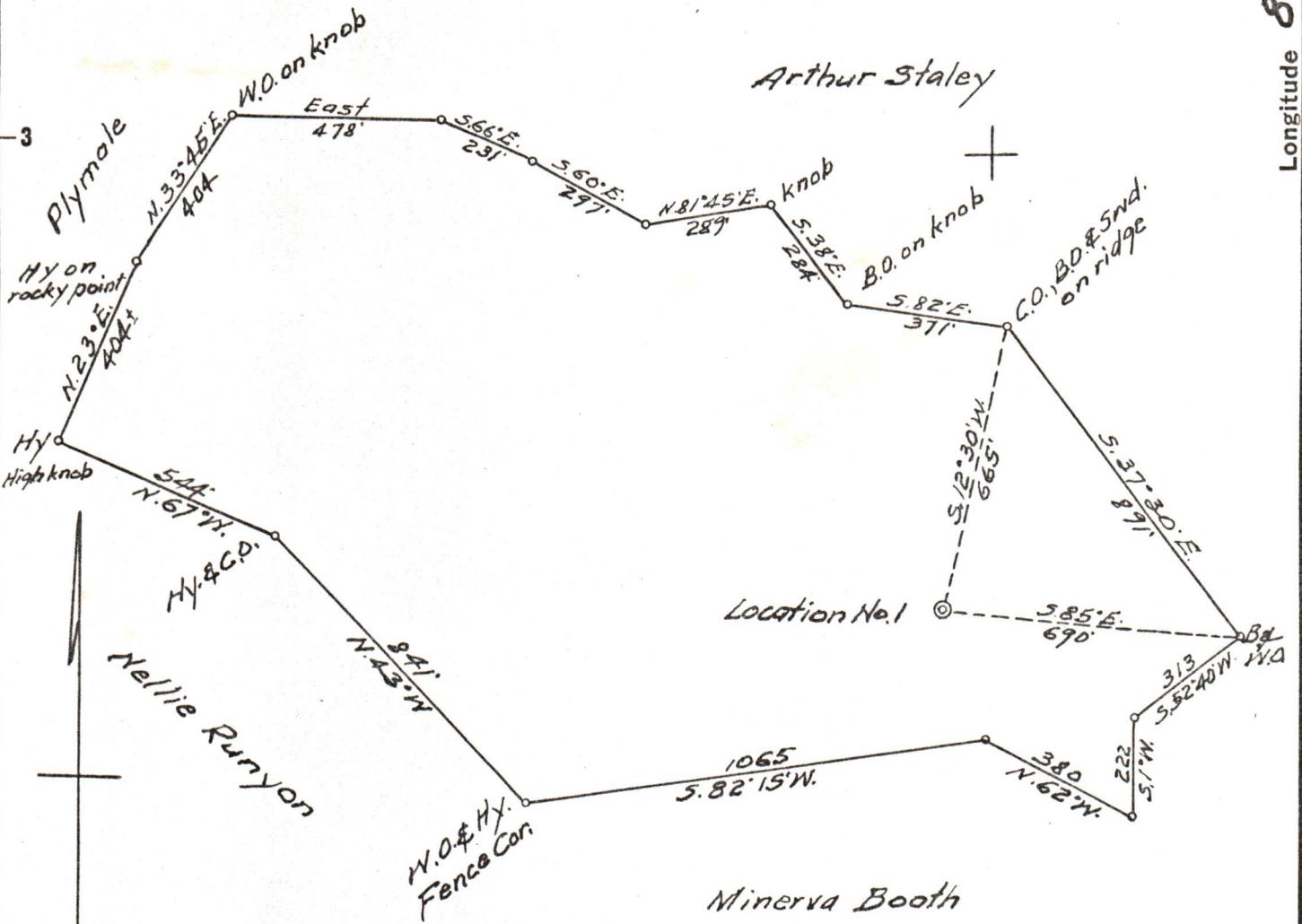
