- Fill with mud fluid from 2787 to 2706 ft.
- Set plug - 2706 to 2703 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 2703 to 2212 ft.
- Set bridge - 2212 to 2202 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 2202 to 1909 ft.
- Set plug - 1909 to 1906 ft. - pull 6-5/8" casing.
- Fill with mud fluid from 1906 to 1565 ft.
- Set plug - 1565 to 1562 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 1562 to 1475 ft.
- Set plug - 1475 to 1472 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 1472 to 1225 ft.
- Set plug - 1225 to 1222 ft., - pull 8-1/4" casing.
- Fill with mud fluid from 1222 to 1080 ft.
- Set plug - 1080 to 1077 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 1077 to 806 ft.
- Set plug - 806 to 803 ft.
- Fill with cement from 803 to 748 ft.
- Fill with mud fluid from 748 to 707 ft.
- Set plug - 707 to 704 ft.

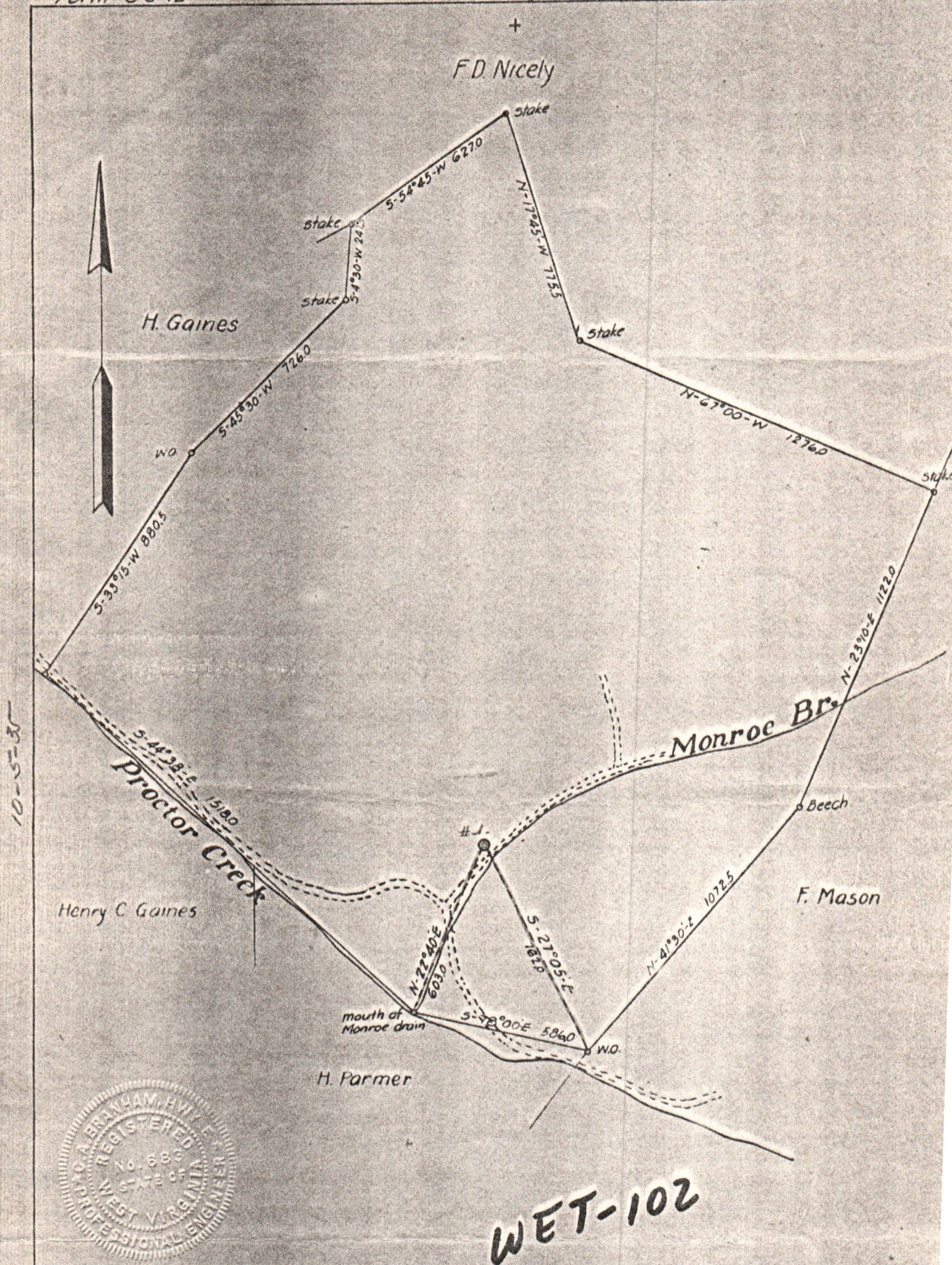
