On August 21st we issued permit WET-105-P to Miller and Lewis, 1004 Ann Street, Parkersburg, West Virginia, for the abandonment of Well No. 5-1 on the J. R. Blatt Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County. The total depth of the well was 2120'. The Pittsburgh coal was located from 1105' to 1107' and another seam of coal above the Pittsburgh seam 1005' to 1008' and a large amount of water in the Salt Sand at 1855' and gas production originally at 2111' to 2118'. There was 2115' of 6-5/8" casing and 2120' to 2" tubing.

The affidavit recently filed for the plugging shows that the 6-5/8" casing parted at 895' and they state "filled with red clay to 885'" giving no indication from what point filling began nor how much material was used and of course this would show that no cement was put through the Pittsburgh seam.

One report was recently filed by you on October 12th which stated merely "completed" so that I gather the company did not call you when they found they could not properly plug the well and of course, they did not call this office.

I would appreciate your contacting Miller or Lewis, making clear to them the requirements and the necessities for instructions from this Department or from you in cases of this kind. Further more, please make clear to them that the Department will not accept the work on this well if any difficulty arises due to the manner in which it was plugged.

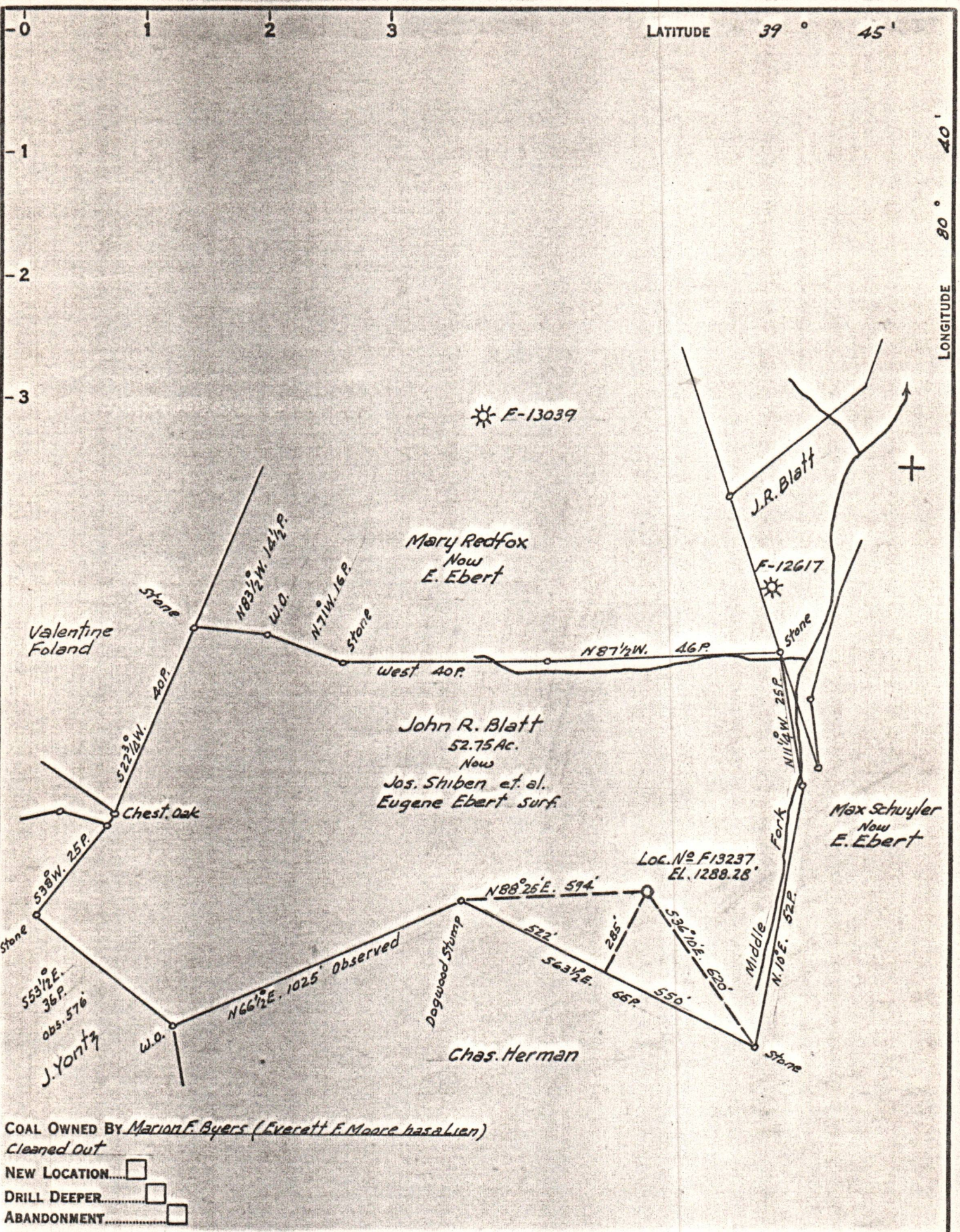
