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

Answering the above, I presume you mean the owners of the oil and gas underlying said farm. Of course the Maxton Oil and Gas Co. owns and holds the leasehold rights under the lease for oil and gas purposes, undexxikaxiaxa mentioned in the application. The royalty oil and gas is owned by the heirs of E. F. Hoffman. The only one of the heirs I know is Mr. Hervey Hoffman who lives in Wheeling, W. Va., and I think he is Admr. of the estate. Both Mr. and Mrs. Hoffman died several years ago. I do not know his street address, but he is an old B. & O. employee.

I did not try to include the owners of the oil and gas in the application forwarded to you, because I could conceive of no necessity for notifying them. The lease we hold on the premises is a valid subsisting lease giving us full drilling rights, with the owners' royalty interest fully set out and protected. 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
