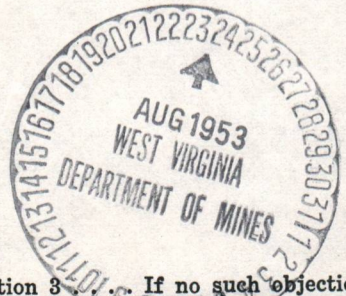

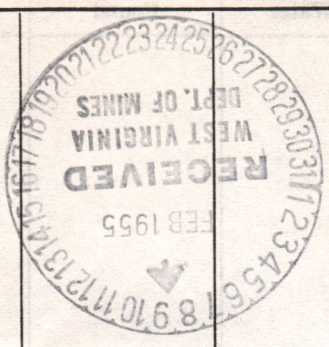

Rip casing above collapsed point and raise one joint. If possible the casing should be parted below the salt water at 1620.

Fill space inside and outside of casing up to top of casing left in.

Run 3 bags of cement to seal hole.

Fill clay to 1592 and set cement plug, sealing salt sand.

As the 6" casing is being pulled fill with clay to 1300'

Run 2 bags of cement.

Fill with clay to 814', 30' below Pittsburgh Coal

Cement from 814 to 760

Fill with clay to 719

Cement from 719 to 665, thru Mapletown Coal.

Fill with clay to 370, 20' below water bearing sand

set cement plug

Fill with clay to 200'

All cement to be mixed with water only, using about 5 gallons to one bag of cement.

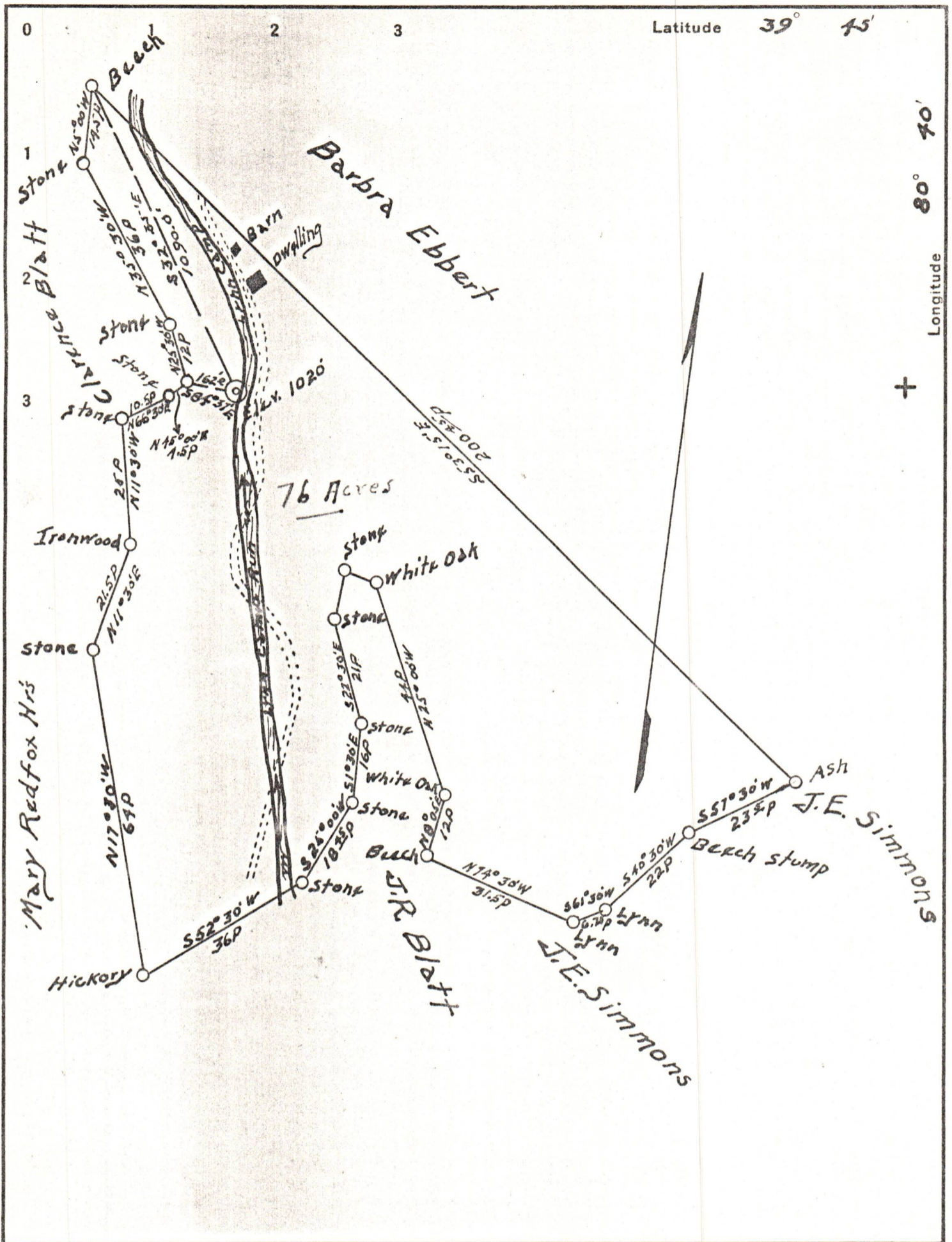

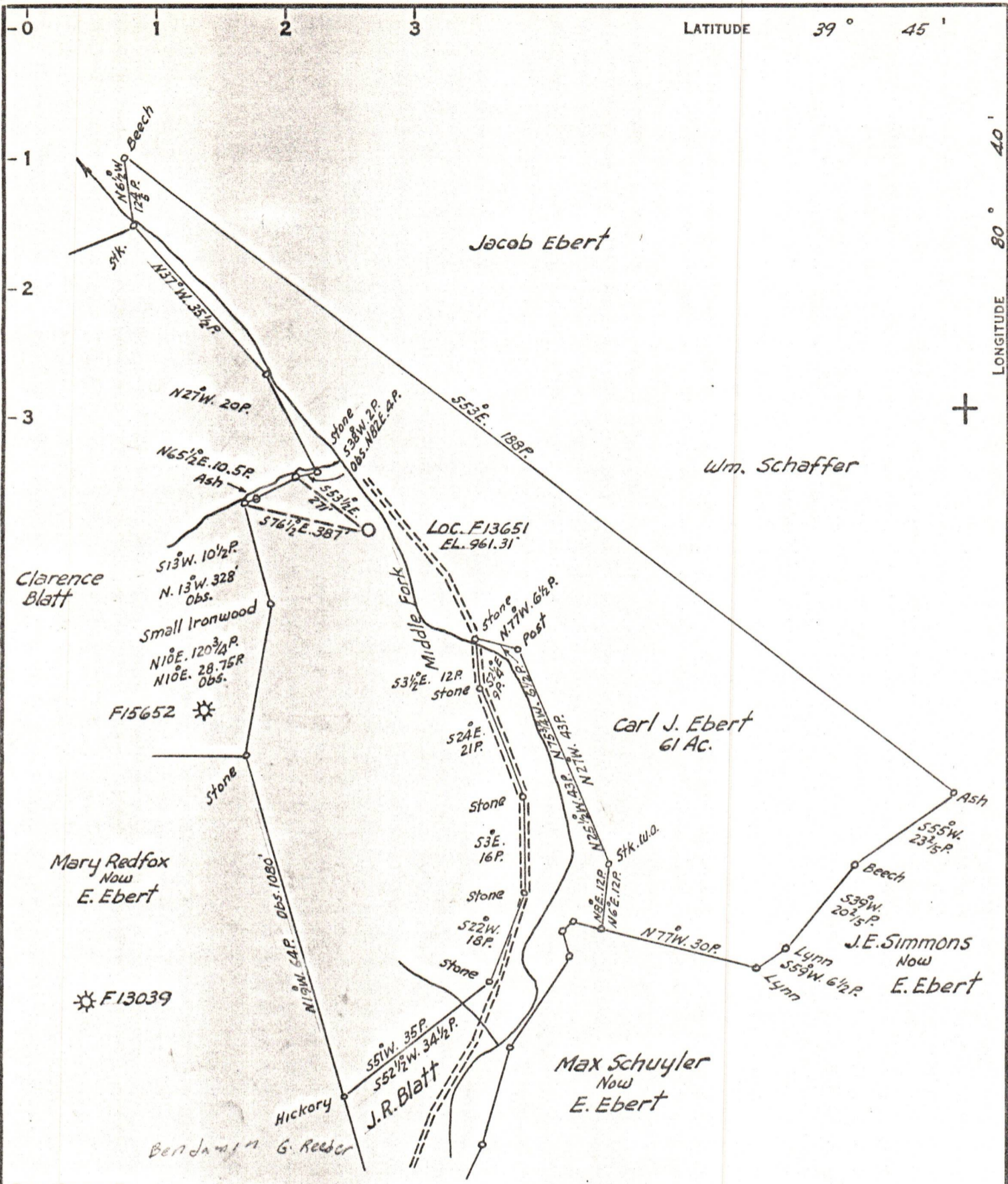
