Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

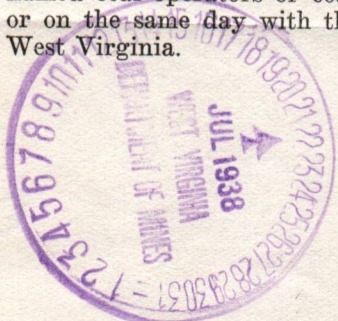

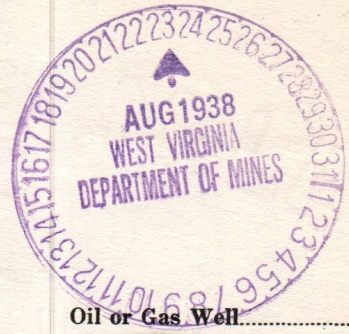

PROPOSED MANNER OF PLUGGING AND FILLING WELL

(REQUIRED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS)

WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF MINES

OIL AND GAS DIVISION

WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

Pull 2" tubing

Cover Cow Run Sand with cement

Fill with clay to 500'

Pull 4-7/8" Casing

Set Wood Plug on shoulder, and cement plug

Fill 6-1/4" hole with clay to 400'

Form bridge at 240', and fill to coal (Black slate)

Cement coal

Pull 6-1/4" casing, and fill with clay to surface

NOTE: If coal is not of marketable quality, it need not be cemented, but fill hole from 400' to 140' with red clay
Set wood plug 140' - 137'
Cement 137' - 132' -
Fill with red clay to surface.
Erect marker such as is required by Rule 18, 1931 Regulations-- giving name of operator, farm name, well number, and date abandoned.

NOTE: CEMENT FOR MAKING CEMENT PLUGS BE MIXED WITH WATER ONLY--APPROXIMATELY FIVE GAL WATER TO ONE SACK CEMENT. ALLOW CEMENT TO SET BEFORE CONTINUING FILLING.

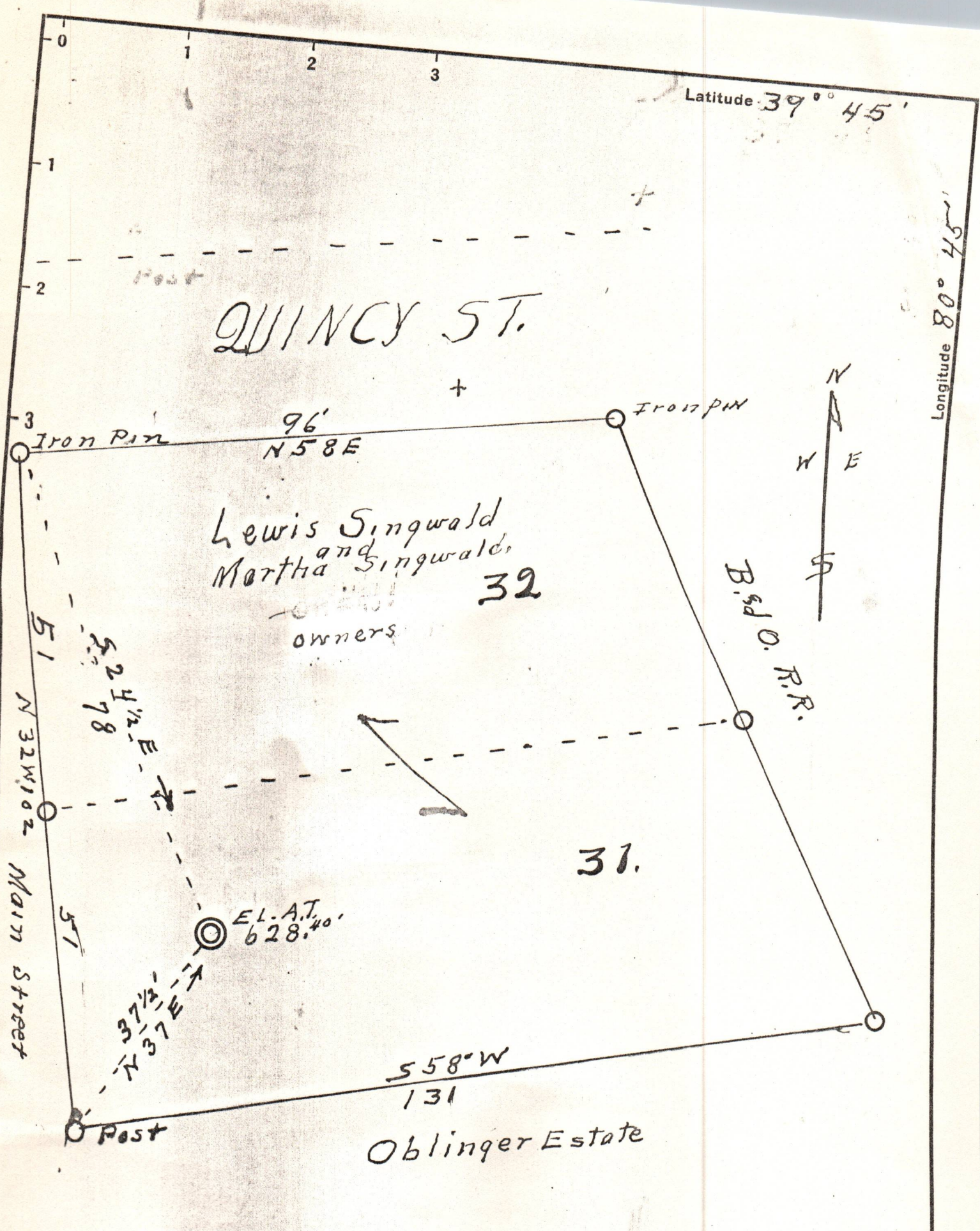
