Said coal operators are further notified that forms for use in making such objections will be furnished to them by the Department of Mines promptly on request and that all such objections must set forth as definitely as is reasonably possible the ground or grounds on which such objections are based and indicate the direction and distance the proposed location should be moved to overcome same.

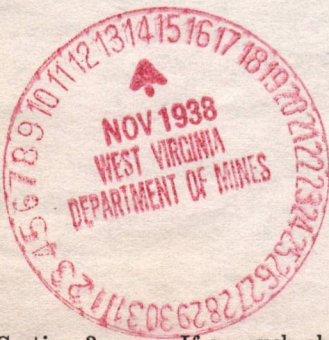

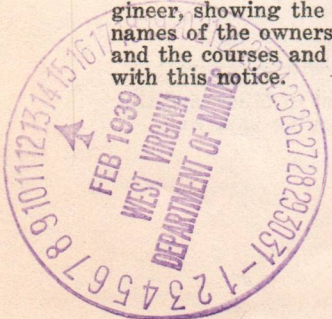

Fill with clay or other non-porous material from bottom 2135' - 2030' - 20' above Big Injun Sand.

Wood Plug 2030' - 2027'

Cement 2027' - 2017' - Sealing Big Injun & Keener Sands.

Pull 5-3/16" casing and--

Continue to fill with non-porous material to 1650' - top of Salt Sand.

Wood Plug 1650' - 1647'

Cement 1647' - 1637' - Sealing Salt Sands.

Set a permanent bridge 1375' - 20' below 6-5/8" casing.
1 sack cement on bridge.

Pull 6-5/8" casing.

Fill with nonporous material 1230' - in "Lime".

Wood Plug 1230' - 1227'

Cement 1227' - 1217' - Sealing hole completely

Fill with non-porous material to 1065'

Pull 6-5/8" casing and--

Set suitable plug at 1065' - sealing hole completely

Set a permanent bridge at 600'

1 sack cement on bridge.

Pull 10" casing and--

Fill with non-porous material to surface.

Erect Marker such as is required by Rule 18, 1931 regulations.

NOTE: CEMENT FOR MAKING CEMENT PLUGS BE MIXED WITH WATER ONLY--APPROXIMATELY FIVE GAL WATER TO ONE SACK CEMENT.

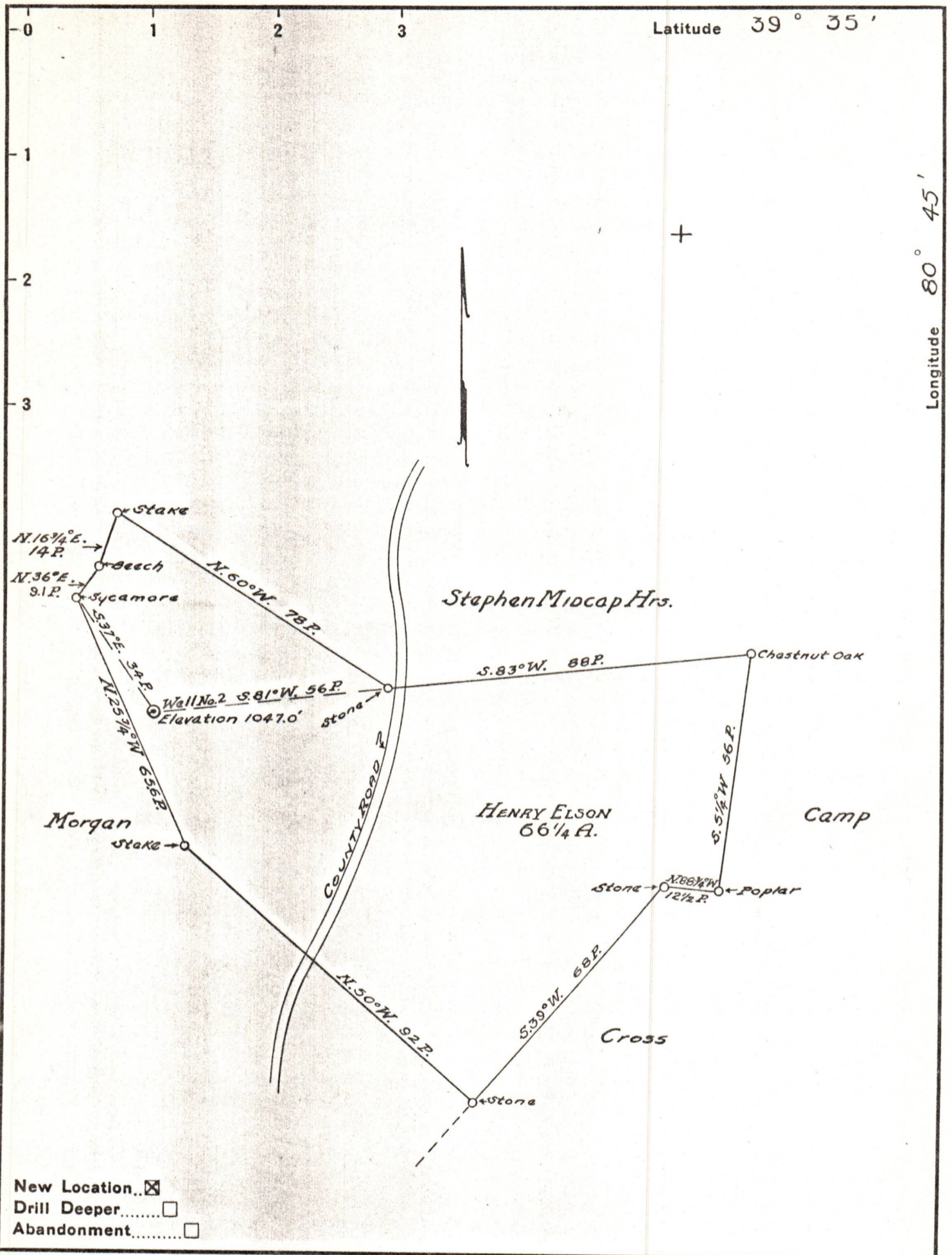
