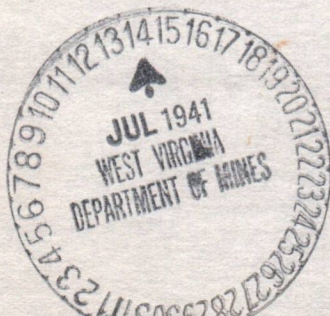

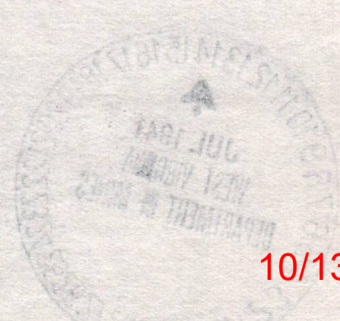


Under date of July 24, you forwarded this office Permit #WET-260 to drill Well #1 on the William Hohman Farm, Proctor District, Wetzel County, West Virginia.

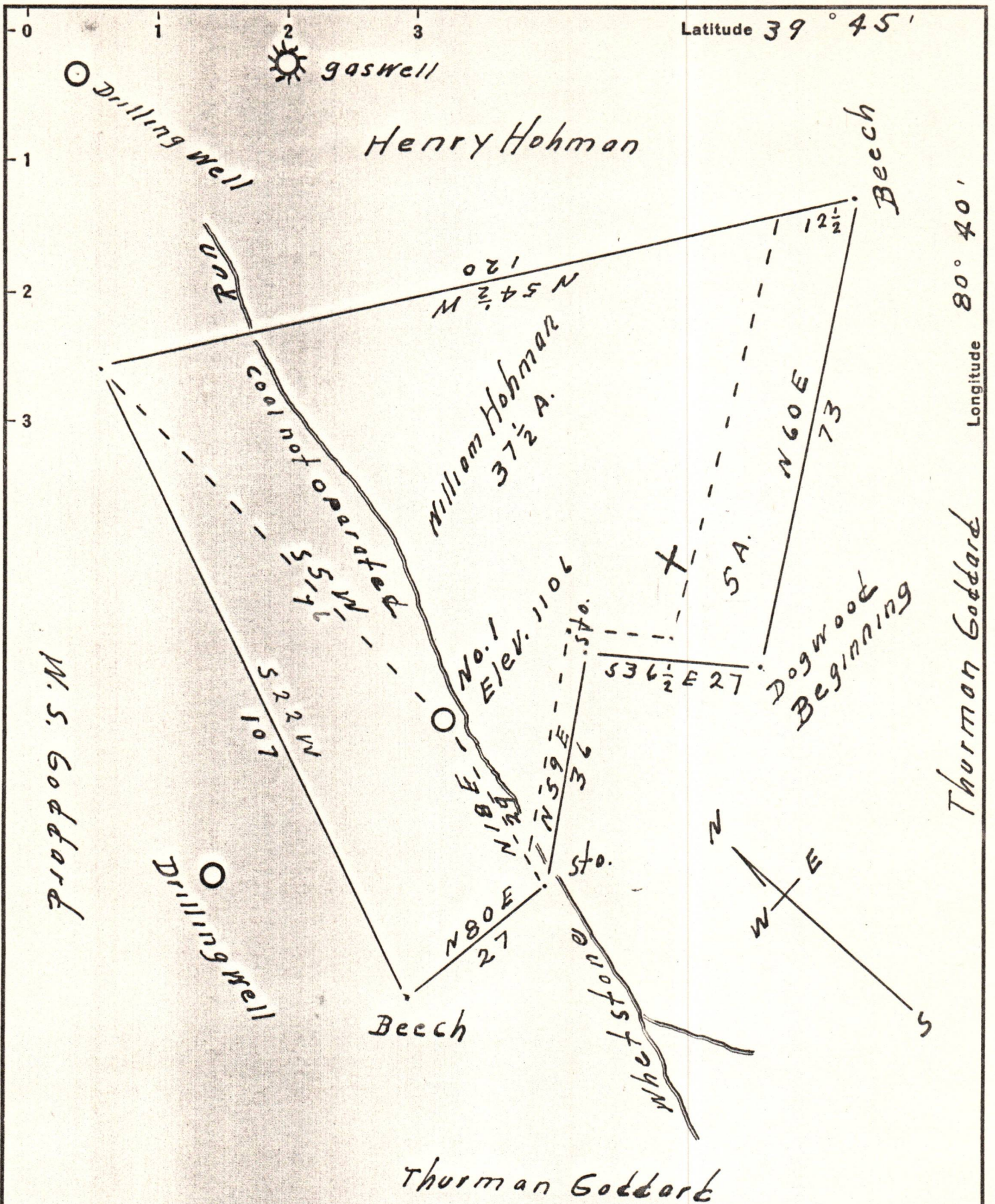

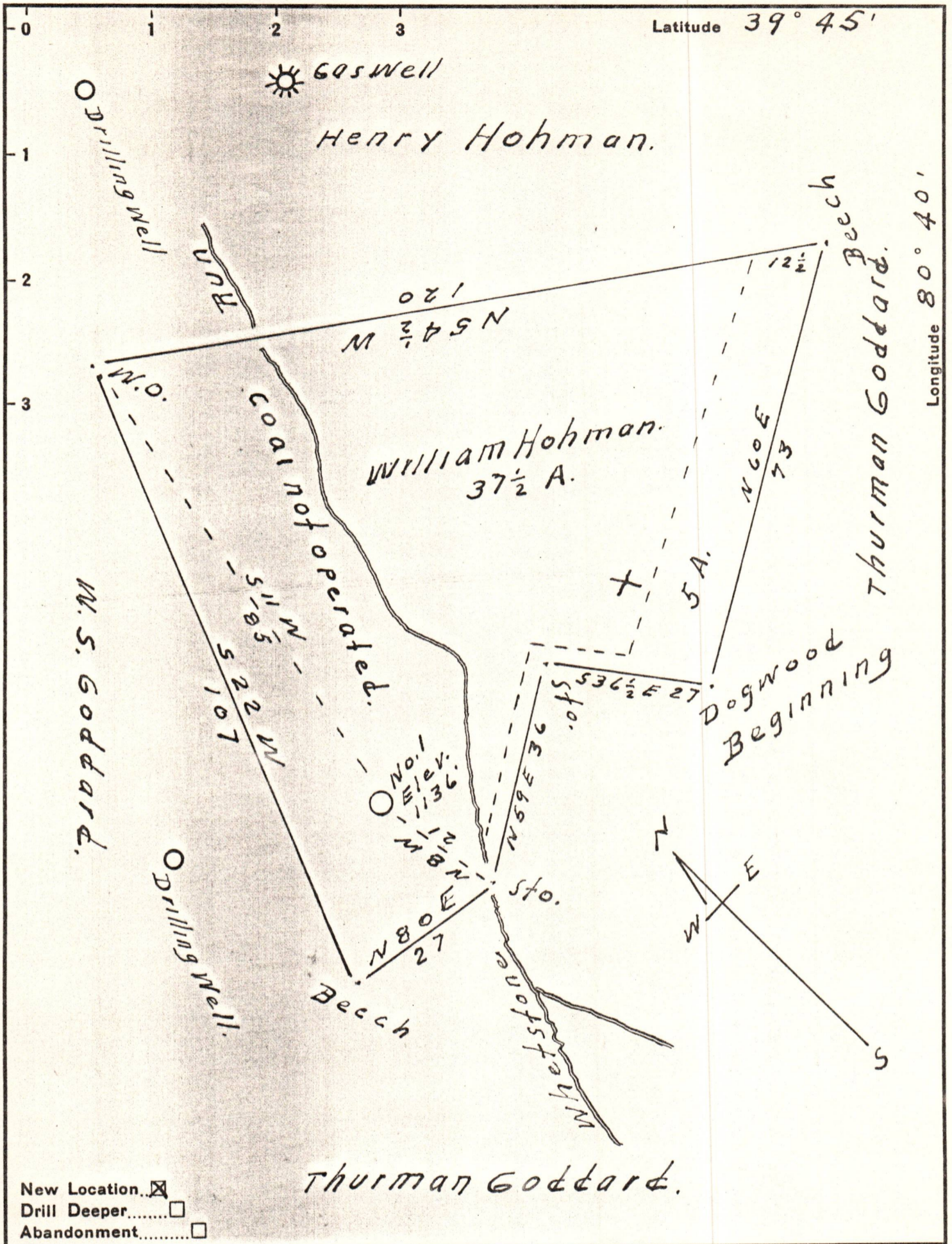
