2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill with clay to 2000' - 30' below 5-3/16" casing

Neat Cement 2000' - 1980'

5' crushed stone on cement plug - sealing hole completely below 5-3/16" casing

As 5-3/16" casing is lifted

Fill with clay to 1850'

Neat Cement 1850' - 1840'

5' crushed stone on cement - sealing off salt water at 1940'

Pull balance of 5-3/16" casing and

Pull 6-5/8" casing - if possible

If not possible to pull 6-5/8" casing

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1440' - 30' below bottom of 6-5/8"

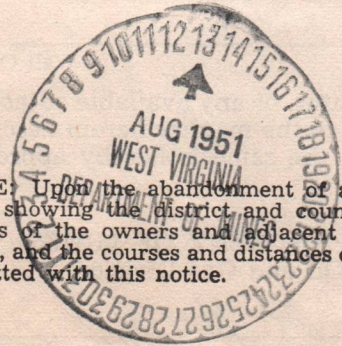

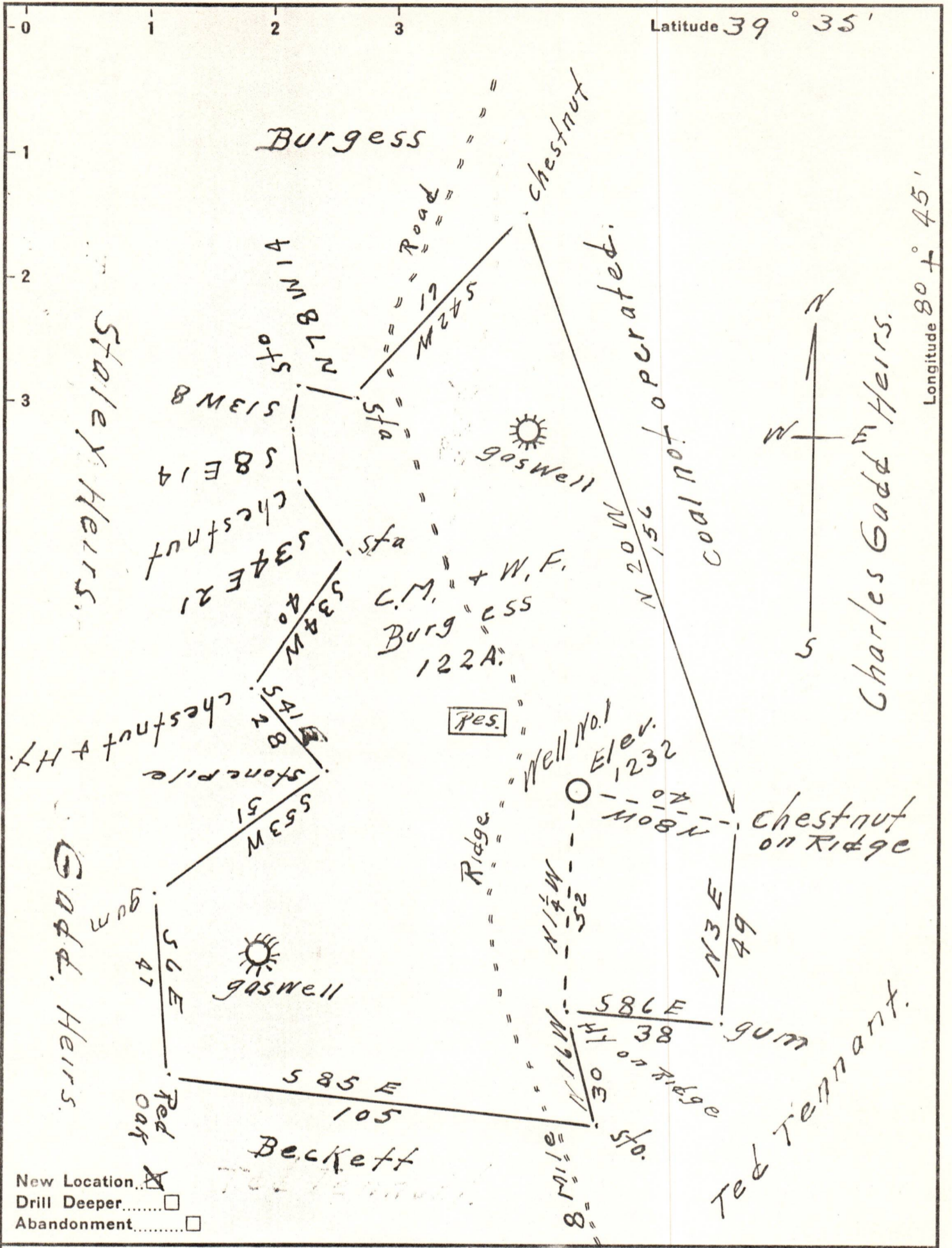

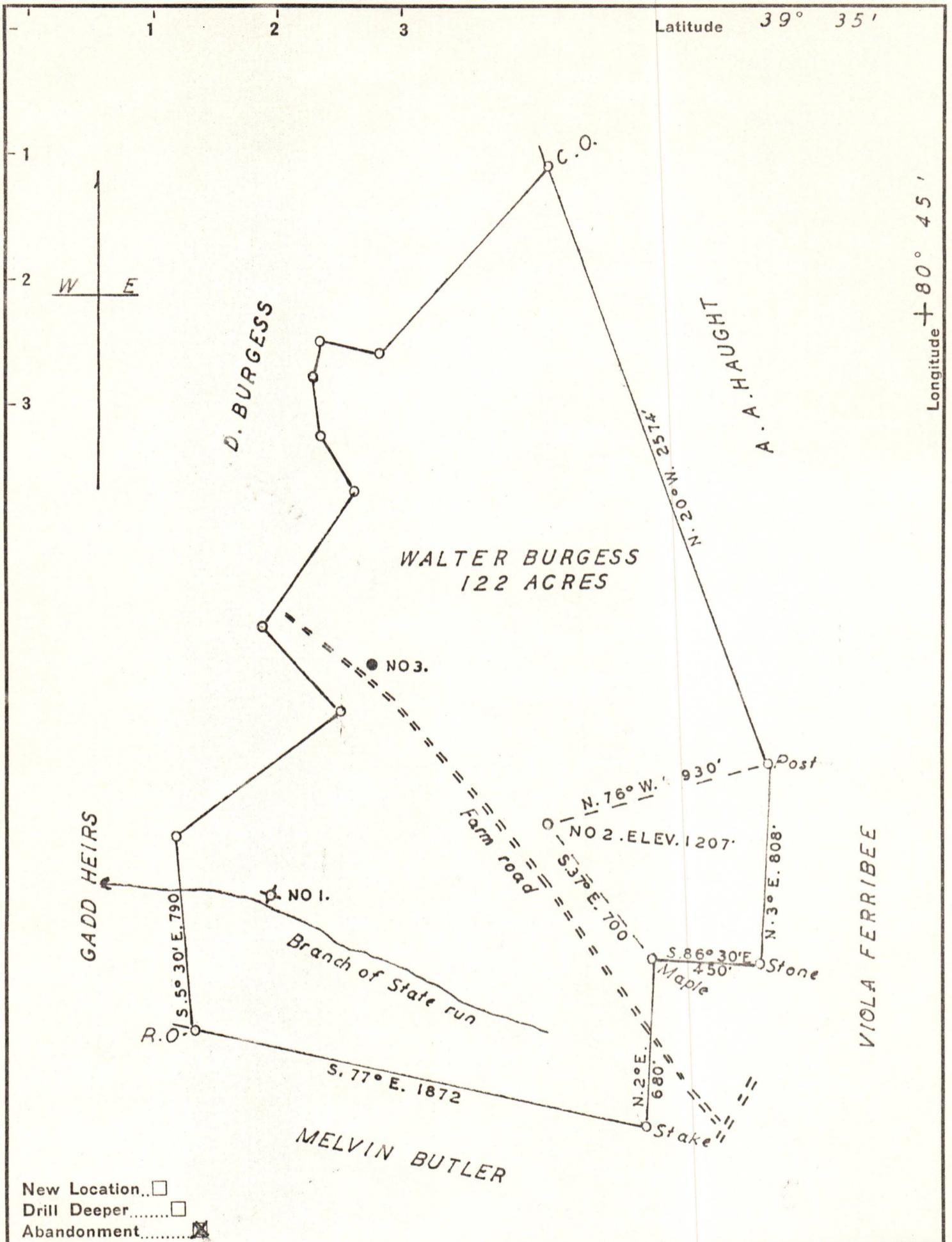
